- Mostly flat and solid ground to the Coastguard Lookout, overlooking Worm's Head.
- Spectacular views in all directions.
- Grab your camera for an awe-inspiring sunset.
- Bloomin' beautiful: come and see stunning flowers in spring.
- Chough, skylark, peregrine falcons and buzzard can all be seen along this walk.
- Look out for The Vile, a medieval field system now managed for wildlife.
- In the top 10 of Wales' Best Beach and has been voted number one on numerous occasions.

**Start & Finish:** Bus stop in Rhossili.

**Distance/time:** About 2 miles (3.2 km), 1.5 hours.

**Terrain:** Surface varies from firm and level, to soft and uneven. There are two steps, a short slope but no stiles.

**Safety:** Be aware of the cliffs along the walk. The rough causeway to Worm's Head is tidal - check information displayed in front of the Coastguard Lookout. Wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the conditions and season.

**Refreshments:** Cafés, pub and shops in Rhossili village.

**Amenities:** Public toilets, changing places and outdoor showers in the National Trust car park at Rhossili (24 hrs; free). Public toilets in Swansea bus station (05:00 – 23:15; 30p charge).

● Start the walk where the bus stops at the end of its route in Rhossili, and walk downhill, past the National Trust car park and the National Trust shop and go through a gate onto a well-made, firm gravel track. Follow this track for about a mile until you reach a stretch of short, compact grass leading to the small Coastguard Lookout overlooking Worm's Head.

● From the Coastguard Lookout, turn left and with the sea on your right follow the top of the cliffs towards the corner of a stone wall. Continue on to a small gate in the wall.

● Go through the gate, and head back inland towards Rhossili village. Follow the track through the field, passing through another two gates. After about ¼ mile (0.4km) continue along the track as it turns left and then right. After about another ¼ mile (0.5km) the track turns left and after a short distance meets the main road in Rhossili.

● Turn left onto the main road and the bus stop is a few yards further on, on the right.
