Walk Highlights

- Easy access route to the Coastguard Lookout, overlooking Worm's Head.
- Spectacular panoramic views.
- Worm's Head – one of the most photographed sunsets in the world.
- Particularly colourful flowers in spring.
- Chough, skylark, peregrine falcons and buzzard can all be seen along this walk.
- The Vile – a unique remnant of a medieval field system.

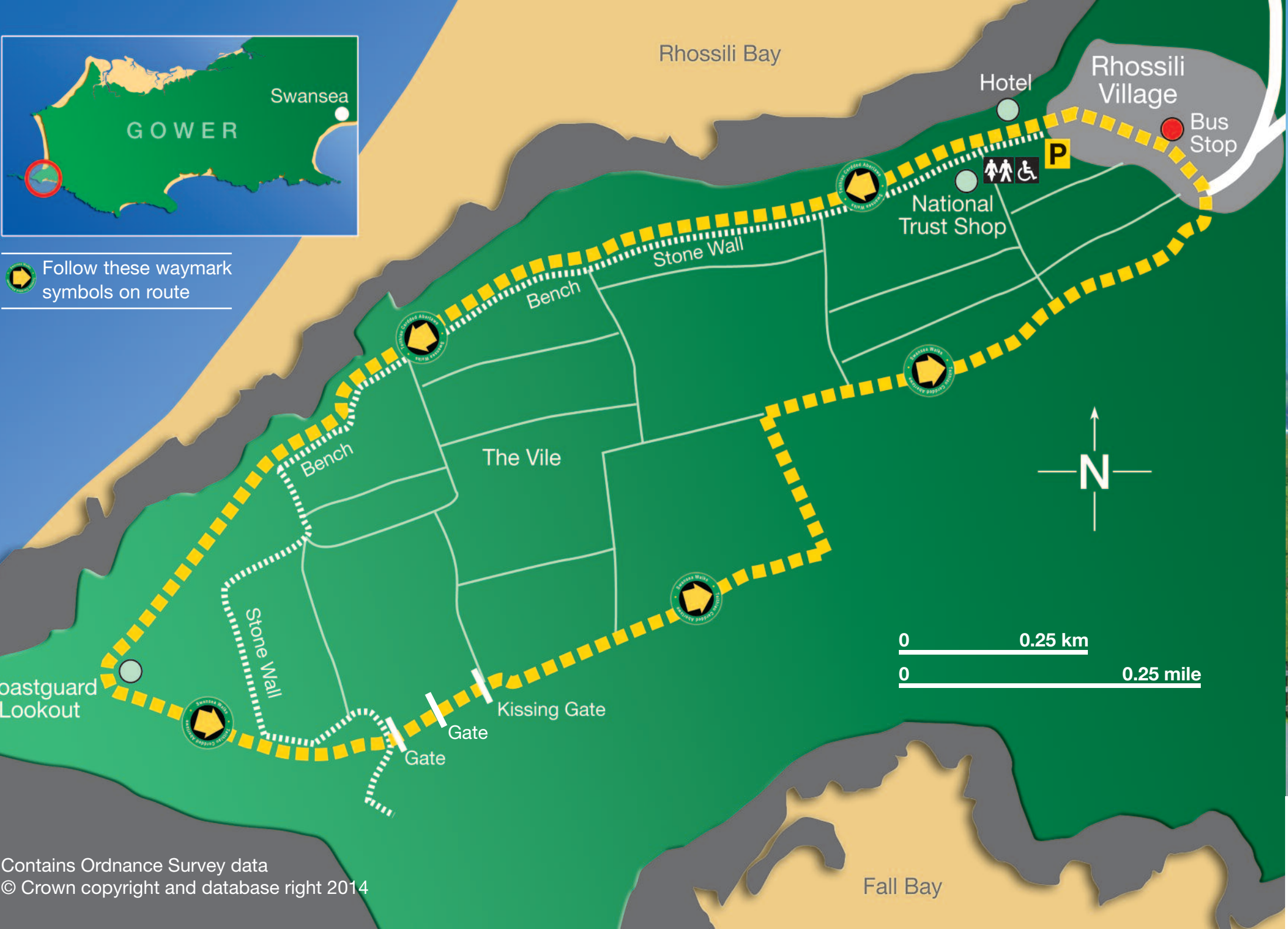
Start & Finish: Bus stop in Rhossili.
Distance/time: About 2 miles, 1 1/2 hours.
Terrain: Surface varies from firm and level, to soft and uneven. There are 2 steps, a short slope but no stiles.
Safety Information: Be aware of the cliffs along the walk. The rough causeway to Worm's Head is tidal - check information at the lookout.
Safety: Wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the conditions and season.
Refreshments: Cafés, pub and shop in Rhossili village.
Public Toilets: Main car park at Rhossili.

- Start the walk where the bus stops at the end of its route in Rhossili, and walk downhill, past the large car park and the National Trust shop and go through a gate onto a good hard track. Follow this track for about a mile until you reach the small Coastguard Lookout overlooking Worm's Head.
- From the Coastguard Lookout, turn left and follow the top of the cliffs towards the corner of a stone wall. Continue on to a small gate in the wall.
- Go through the gate, and head back inland towards Rhossili village. Follow the track

through the field, passing through another 2 gates – after about 1/4 mile the track turns left. Follow the track as it turns right and left again, finally coming out onto the road.
• The bus stop is a few yards further on, on the right.



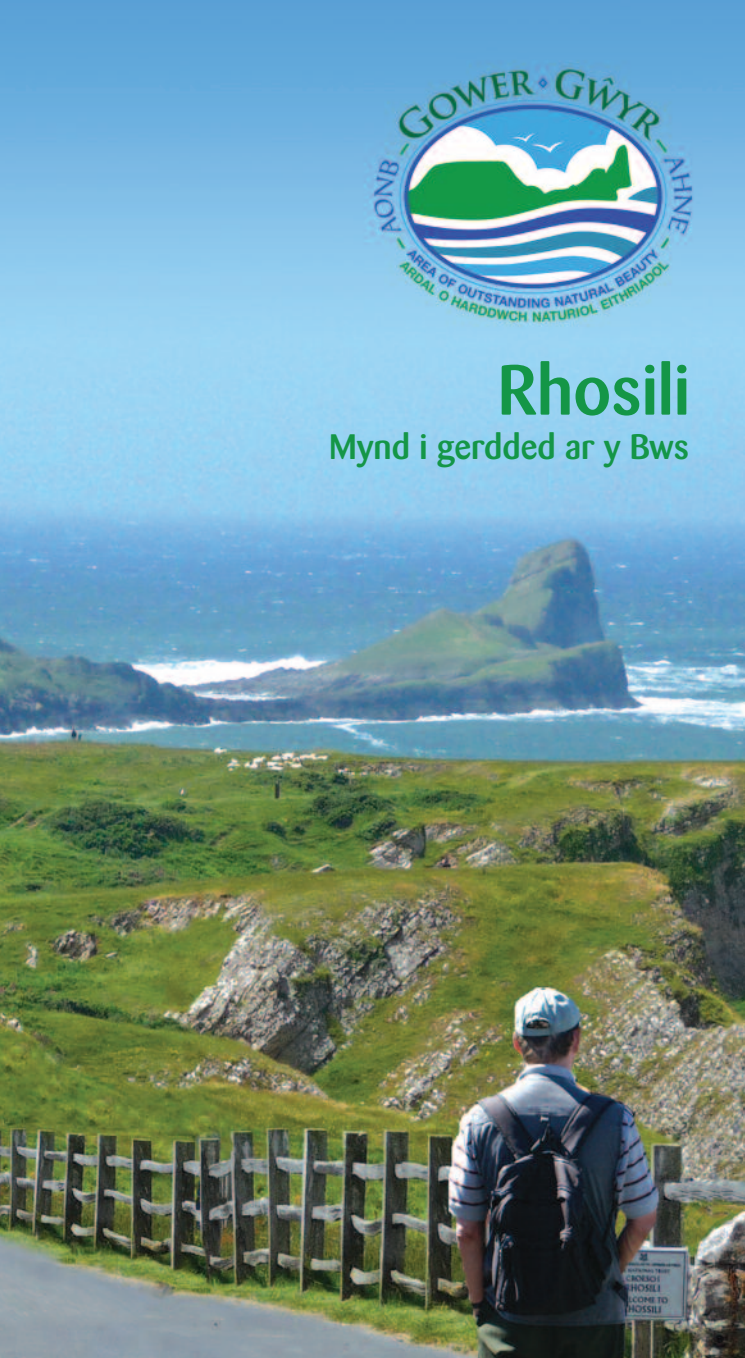

- Dechreuwch y daith lle bydd y bws yn aros ar ben ei daith yn Rhosili a cherddwch am i lawr heibio’r maes parcio mawr a siop yr Ymddiriedolaeth Genedlaethol a thrwy gât ar drac caled da. Dilynwch y trac hwn am oddeutu milltir nes cyrraedd gwylfa fach Gwylwyr y Glannau sy’n edrych dros Ben Pyrod.

- O wylfa Gwylwyr y Glannau, trowch i’r chwith a dilyn pen y clogwyni i gyfeiriad cornel wal gerrig. Ewch yn eich blaen i gât fach yn y wal.

- Ewch drwy’r gât ac anelu’n ôl i’r mewndir ac i gyfeiriad pentref Rhosili. Dilynwch y

trac drwy gae, gan fynd drwy gât arall – wedi tua 1/4 milltir, mae’r trac yn troi i’r chwith. Dilynwch y trac wrth iddo droi i’r dde ac yna i’r chwith eto, gan ddod allan yn y diwedd ar y ffordd.

- Mae’r safle bws ychydig o lathenni ymhellach ymlaen ar y dde.

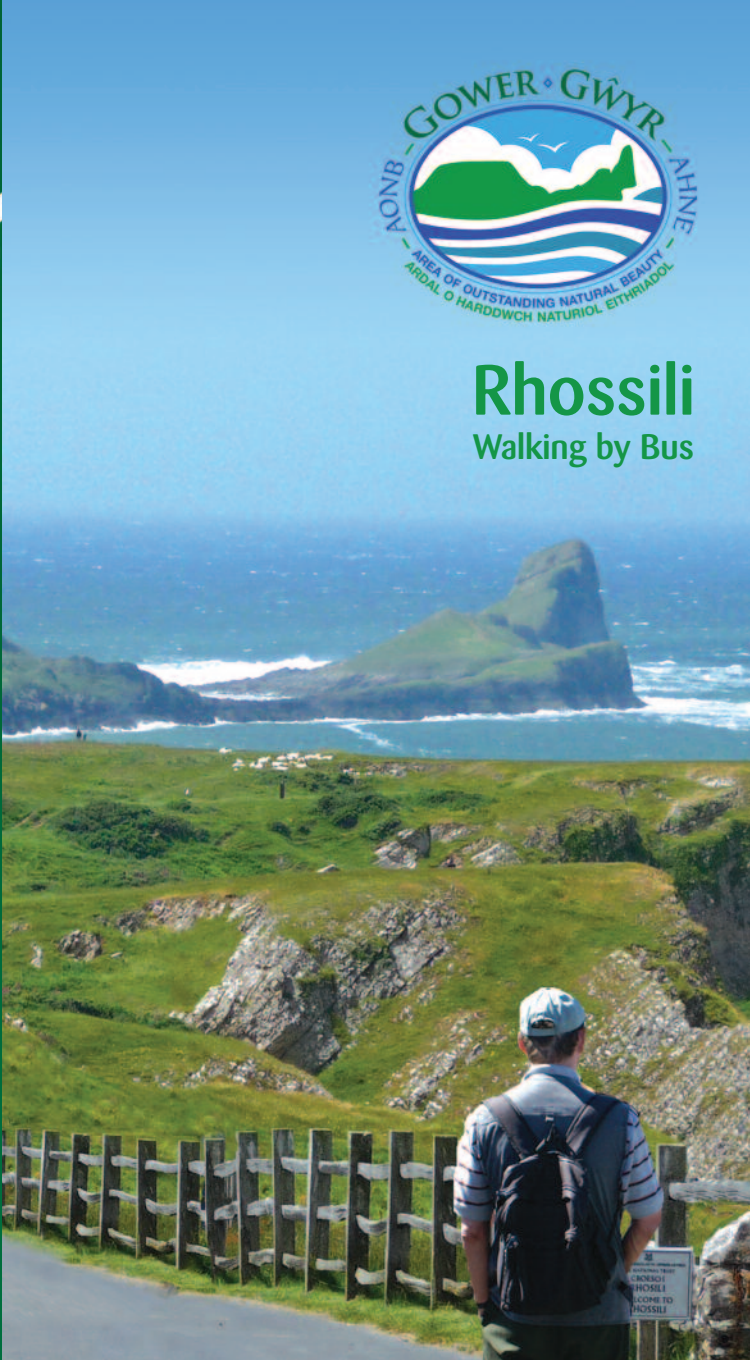
