

Lakeview Amphitheater Parking: [INGRESS](#) | [EGRESS](#)

Things to immediately note:

- Parking lots open three (3) hours before listed concert times.
- Exit 6 from I-690/NY-695 **will remain closed** for show dates that do not coincide with the New York State Fair. You **MUST** use Exit 7 from I-690 to access the Lakeview Amphitheater from the highway.
- The 'Orange Lot' is the main parking lot for shows at the Lakeview Amphitheater. When warranted, the 'Brown Lot' will also be utilized with shuttling available. Please follow directional signage and instructions from Law Enforcement, Security and/or Parking Team Members to expedite ingress & egress.
- You will EXIT Orange Lot parking areas the same way you entered; there is no thru-traffic for event parking in the Orange Lot. If directed to park in the Brown Lot, you will exit to the west. Parking Team Members, Law Enforcement and signage will be there to direct you accordingly.
- Tailgating is strictly prohibited.
- Overnight parking is not permitted.
- There are no hookups for campers within the Lakeview Amphitheater parking lots.

Event day driving directions, both to and from the Lakeview Amphitheater, and parking information are provided below. Please drive safely and allow ample time to reach your destination. We hope you enjoy the concert!

LAKEVIEW AMPHITHEATER Parking Information:

Parking Hours and Information:

Amphitheater parking lots open three (3) hours before listed concert times and close two (2) hours after the concert. No exceptions will be made for early arrival or for guests who already have parking permits. All spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis. All vehicles that do not park in a designated parking space or that do not follow the instructions of Parking Team Members are subject to being ticketed and/or being towed. No paneled or windowless vans or trucks will be permitted in any parking lots. Please note that all prices listed are for single spaces for the purpose of parking one vehicle. No reserving of spaces is allowed and guests will not be allowed to purchase additional spaces. The Lakeview Amphitheater will implement the one car, one space policy for parking cars. Thank you for your cooperation with our Parking Team Members and Sheriff's Department to make your experience safe and enjoyable.

Parking Lot Rates:

- Accessible Parking for Guests with Disabilities: \$10.00
- Limousines: \$30.00 (Additional information below)
- R/V Parking (no hook ups/services): \$40.00 (Additional information below)
- Buses: \$40.00 (Additional information below)
- Premier Parking available - rates vary per show; purchase in advance via Ticketmaster.com

Limousine & Bus Parking:

Limousine/bus parking is located along the south-western portion of the driveway leading to the shuttle drop off circle at the main gate (see map for specific location). This location is filled on a first-come, first-served basis. There are no reserved spots.

Limousines & buses arriving after all available spots are filled will be directed to parking elsewhere, as determined by Parking Team Members – this location may be outside of the Orange Lot entirely. A limousine is to have a license plate that reads "Livery" in order to park in the designated limousine parking spaces. SUV Limousines, Party Buses, vehicles more than 25 feet in length and other oversized vehicles designed to carry more than 14 passengers may be directed to park elsewhere, as determined by the Parking Team Members per event.

This lot will close one (1) hour after the each concert. At this time any remaining limousines/buses in the lot will be required to exit the parking lot. Please notify your passengers and inform them to make appropriate plans to ensure their limousine/bus does not leave without them. Some delays can be expected entering and leaving the lot due to traffic.

R/V Parking:

R/V parking will be determined on a show-by-show basis for the time being. Parking Team Members will direct R/Vs to the proper location to park within the applicable parking lots (based on show size). R/V hookups and additional services are not available within Lakeview Amphitheater parking lots. R/Vs parked within the Lakeview Amphitheater parking lots will not be permitted to expand sides or set up camp. Please keep in mind tailgating is not permitted.

Parking Code of Conduct:

The parking lots at the Lakeview Amphitheater are for the convenience and enjoyment of all amphitheater guests. Tailgating is not permitted in any parking lots. Oversized vehicles will not be permitted to park in lots designated for passenger vehicles.

Every effort is made to create a guest-friendly environment that is safe for all to enjoy. Our valued guests play a large role in this. In order to maintain a safe and fun environment, the Lakeview Amphitheater asks that all concert attendees follow directions given by all staff including Syracuse Parking Services, SMG Management, Law Enforcement and Security Personnel. They are there to assist you and make parking safe and convenient for everyone. In the event of a parking lot emergency please call 9-1-1.

The Onondaga County Sheriff's Department, Town of Geddes Police, New York State Police, Onondaga County Park Rangers and Westcott Security all play a vital role in securing the Lakeview Amphitheater. Any of these parties may patrol the parking lots at random to ensure that those who do not adhere to the parking guidelines and/or participate in activities that create an unsafe environment will be held responsible. This includes arrest, ejection, and/or having their parking and ticket purchasing privileges revoked. Thank you for your cooperation.

Tailgating:

Tailgating is not permitted in amphitheater parking lots. Vehicles may occupy ONLY ONE parking space. Additional spaces are not available for purchase for the purpose of tailgating. Additional restrictions may apply. Disorderly guests are subject to ejection from the parking lot premises, revocation of tickets, and criminal prosecution.

Shuttles:

FROM THE BROWN LOT: For large events that utilize the Orange AND Brown lots for parking, Centro will operate shuttles for guests in the Brown Lot to transport them up to the front circle/main gate of the Lakeview Amphitheater. Brown Lot shuttles will pick guests up and drop them back off in the Pink Lot.

FROM DOWNTOWN SYRACUSE: Centro runs an express service from the Centro Transit hub (downtown Syracuse) to the front circle/main gate of the Lakeview Amphitheater beginning approximately two hours before each event and ending approximately one hour after the conclusion of each event. Exact departure times may vary, please check Centro's website for detailed information. Regular Centro fares will apply and all Centro passes and transfers will be accepted for this service.

Event Day Driving Directions - Ingress

From the West - Buffalo / Rochester Area

Take the New York State Thruway (I-90 East) to Exit 39. Merge onto I-690 EAST. Take Exit 7 for Fairgrounds/Amphitheater. Follow directional signage and traffic personnel. **You may be immediately parked in the BROWN LOT for larger shows**

From the West - I-695/Auburn Area

Follow NY-5 toward Syracuse. Use left two lanes to merge onto NY-695N exit toward I-690/Fairgrounds/Syracuse. Use the middle lane to merge onto I-690E toward Fairgrounds/Syracuse. Take Exit 7 for Fairgrounds/Amphitheater. Follow directional signage and traffic personnel. **You may be immediately parked in the BROWN LOT for larger shows**

From the East - Albany / Utica Area

Take the New York State Thruway (I-90 West) to Exit 34A. Merge onto Rte 481 South then merge onto I-690 W. Take Exit 7 for Fairgrounds/Amphitheater. Follow directional signage and traffic personnel.

From the North - Watertown Area

Take I-81 South into Syracuse to Exit 22-Bear Street [298 to 690W]. Turn right onto Bear Street W (Rte. 298). Follow signs to merge onto I-690 WEST. Take Exit 7 for Fairgrounds/Amphitheater. Follow directional signage and traffic personnel.

From the South - Binghamton /Cortland Area

Take Interstate 81 North into Syracuse. After Exit 18 for Harrison/Adams Street, follow signs to merge onto I-690 W. Take Exit 7 for Fairgrounds/Amphitheater. Follow directional signage and traffic personnel.

From the New York City / Downstate Area

Take the best route to Binghamton, NY. Then take I-81 North into Syracuse. After Exit 18 for Harrison/Adams Street, follow signs to merge onto I-690 W. Take Exit 7 for Fairgrounds/Amphitheater. Follow directional signage and traffic personnel.

-OR-

Take the best route to Albany, NY. Then take the New York State Thruway (I-90W) to Exit 34A. Merge onto Rte 481 South then merge onto I-690 W. Take Exit 7 for Fairgrounds/Amphitheater. Follow directional signage and traffic personnel.

Event Day Driving Directions - Egress

From the ORANGE LOT

ALL traffic will exit the Orange Lot by retracing their entrance route through the lot. Parking Team Members and directional signage will be in place to assist in this process. PLEASE be sure to stay in your respective lane and exit accordingly – the safety of all, especially pedestrians, relies on adherence to these exiting procedures.

Once vehicles have reached the entrance/exit of the Orange Lot, vehicles will be directed to the right toward State Fair Boulevard by Law Enforcement Officers. All traffic will turn right onto State Fair Boulevard to then turn right and merge onto I-690. Vehicles traveling to the WEST should remain in the left most lane; vehicles traveling to the EAST, NORTH AND SOUTH should remain in the right most lanes to expedite exiting onto the highway.

To the West - Buffalo / Rochester Area

Once (out of or) past the Brown Lot on State Fair Boulevard, keep right to take I-690 W/NY-695 to I-90/NY-5. Keep left at the fork, follow signs for Interstate 690 W/Interstate 90 and merge onto I-690W. Continue onto NY-690N. Take exit 1 to merge onto I-90W (partial toll road) toward Rochester/Buffalo.

To the West – I-695/Auburn Area

Once (out of or) past the Brown Lot on State Fair Boulevard, keep right to take I-690 W/NY-695 to I-90/NY-5. Use the right lane to take the I-690W/NY-695 E ramp to I-90/NY-5/Auburn/Syracuse. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for New York 695/New York 5/Auburn. Continue onto NY-695S. Use the right 2 lanes to merge onto NY-5W toward Auburn.

To the East - Albany / Utica Area

Follow I-690 E. Use the left lane to take the I-481N exit toward Interstate 90/New York State Thruway. Merge onto I-481N. Take Exit 6 to merge onto I-90E (partial toll road) toward Utica/Albany.

To the North - Watertown Area

Follow I-690 E. Take exit 8 for Hiawatha Blvd. Use any lane to turn left onto Hiawatha Blvd W. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto I-81N ramp to Interstate 90. Merge onto I-81N toward Watertown.

To the South - Binghamton /Cortland Area

Follow I-690 E. Take the I-81S exit toward Binghamton. Merge onto I-81S toward Binghamton.

To the New York City / Downstate Area

Follow I-690 E. Take the I-81S exit toward Binghamton. Merge onto I-81S toward Binghamton. Continue on I-81S into Binghamton. Take the best/preferred route to New York City.

-OR-

Follow I-690 E. Use the left lane to take the I-481N exit toward Interstate 90/New York State Thruway. Merge onto I-481N. Take Exit 6 to merge onto I-90E (partial toll road) toward Utica/Albany. In Albany, keep right to continue onto Governor Thomas E Dewey Thruway/New York State Thruway – follow signs for I-87S/New York/Boston. Continue onto I-87S toward New York City.
