# MUSEUM MAGIC

Looking for a unique, unforgettable space to host an event or treat your guests to a bit of sightseeing? You've come to the right place. Within minutes of your meetings, you'll find an astounding array of must-sees and can't-misses.



It starts in Tacoma's famous Museum District and the **Chihuly Bridge of Glass**, a 500-foot-long pedestrian walkway adorned with thousands of creations by renowned glass artist Dale Chihuly. Across the span, you'll find the famed **Museum of Glass**, a showcase for extraordinary glasswork from around the world, but also home to the West Coast's largest working hot shop, where you can watch visiting artists shape their pieces.



Continuing your cultural adventure, you'll discover the **Tacoma Art Museum**, where works of Renoir, Degas, and Pissarro share space with those of Northwest artists and early American Modernists. Adjacent to the Bridge is the **Washington State History Museum**, with its rotating exhibits of Americana (including amazing model train displays), and a short ways away, you'll find the one-time steamship stopover, **Foss Waterway Seaport**. If cars are your thing, just up the road are **LeMay - America's Car Museum** and its sister attraction, the **LeMay Collections at Marymount**, showcasing everything from the earliest Model T's to the latest speedway supercars. Or you can experience what it was like to live in the 1850s at the **Fort Nisqually Living History Museum**.



And the fun doesn't stop at the city limits. Explore further into Pierce County and discover the history of the area's indigenous tribes and first corporations at the **DuPont Historical Museum**, the maritime magic of Gig Harbor at the **Harbor History Museum**, and the majesty of the stately **Mecker Mansion** in Puyallup.





# CELEBRATE SEASIDE

There's no better place to salute a successful year or treat your attendees to a little R&R than on the waterfront. From your downtown meetings, the Tacoma waterfront is only a few minutes' walk and you'll find an endless array of activities and eateries.

Take a stroll or jog down the **Ruston Way Waterfront** for great views of Mt. Rainier and the Cascade and Olympic mountain ranges. If adventure feeds your soul, rent a kayak, paddleboard, or boat and get out on the water. Mix your Northwest visit with a taste of Italy on board an authentic Venetian gondola at **Gig Harbor Gondola**. Or take a hike to **Sequalitchew Beach** in DuPont, where if you're fortunate, you might just spot an orca or humpback whale.

If fresh water is more your style, take your party to Lakewood and **American Lake** for boating, water skiing, tubing, sailing, swimming, and fishing or drop a line in the **Puyallup River** (or any of the countless rivers between Tacoma and Mt. Rainier) and hook yourself a salmon.

Maybe you'd prefer that someone wrangles your dinner for you. If so, the **Tacoma Waterfront** is restaurant after restaurant after restaurant of freshly caught seafood, wood-fired pizzas, astounding steaks, and whatever else your hunger calls for.

# TRANSPORTATION

## TACOMA LINK LIGHT RAIL:

Getting around downtown Tacoma is simple with Tacoma Link light rail, transporting you and your attendees between twelve stops: the Tacoma Dome, South 25th Street, Union Station, Greater Tacoma Convention Center, South 11th Street, and the Theater District, Old City Hall, S. 4th St., Stadium District, Tacoma General, 6th Ave., Hilltop District and St. Joseph. Tacoma Link light rail operates in the downtown corridor 365 days a year and parking is free in the six-story Tacoma Link light rail garage located next to the Tacoma Dome Station. It takes approximately 23 minutes to travel from one end of the line to the other.

## BUSES/SOUNDER TRAIN:

Two bus systems, Sound Transit and Pierce Transit, service Pierce County. The Sound Transit bus routes travel through Bonney Lake, DuPont, Gig Harbor, Lakewood, Puyallup, SeaTac, Sumner, Tacoma, and University Place. The Sounder train runs between Lakewood and Seattle, stopping in Puyallup, Tacoma, Sumner, and other cities during weekday morning and afternoon commutes and for special weekend events.

## GROUND TRANSPORTATION FROM SEA-TAC AIRPORT

Car rental companies offer 24/7 shuttle service between the airport and off-site car rental facilities. Shuttles pick up passengers outside of baggage claim at the north and south ends of the main terminal. Taxis and ride sharing with companies like Uber and Lyft can be found on the third floor of the airport parking garage.

# OPT OUTDOORS

## GREEN IS GOOD

While Tacoma has less annual rainfall than cities like Chicago, New York, and Orlando, there's no shortage of green spaces for you to find some fresh air. You're looking to hold a company picnic in the park? Planning an active outing for clients and colleagues? Loosening up your swing for a few holes with the boss? It's time for Tacoma.

## CHAMBERS BAY GOLF COURSE

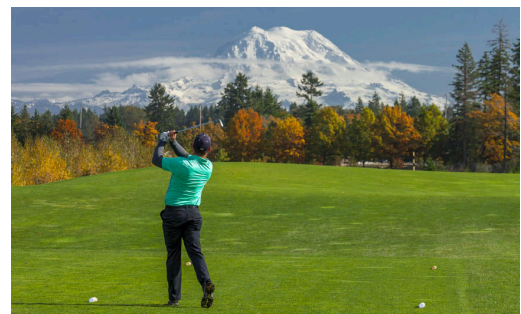
There's no better way to impress your golf-obsessed guests than on one of the world's most acclaimed courses. Home to the 2015 U.S. Open, Chambers Bay is a public course designed by Robert Trent Jones, where you can watch the ships sail by while playing in the footsteps of Woods, Mickelson, and Spieth.

## POINT DEFIANCE PARK

It'd be easier to tell you what Point Defiance doesn't have. The 760-acre park is home to Owen Beach where you'll take to the water for kayaking and paddleboarding. Rose and dahlia gardens and a Japanese Garden - complete with an authentic pagoda - make for a floral background. The Point Defiance Zoo & Aquarium lets you get up close to animals of land and sea. And the old-growth forestland provides cover for deer, foxes, and other fauna.

## THE HOME COURSE

Just 20 minutes from the Greater Tacoma Convention Center, The Home Course in DuPont was built on the site of Washington's first golf course, built in the 1830s. Easily walkable and with panoramic views of Puget Sound and the Olympic Mountains, it's the ideal loop for a relaxing day on the fairways.





## NEARBY NOSHES

You don't have to go far to toast your attendees in style. From ribeyes to ramen, sushi to just-plucked-from-the-water steelhead, there're endless decadent dining options to delight your guests and many are just a short walk from your hotel.

Try the award-winning Chowder Sampler at **Duke's Seafood** or the Grilled Idaho Trout at **Wildfin American Grill**. Bite into the Poutine Burger at **Stack 571** or the Dungeness Crab Mac & Cheese at **The Fish Peddler**. Take in the best view of the city while you dine on Almond Crusted Sea Scallops at **Stanley & Seafort's**. And whatever you do, don't miss out on the exquisite dishes at **Indita Mia**, where they use only high-quality ingredients and exclusively Waygu beef - just a short walk from the Convention Center, right on the Thea Foss Waterway.

Looking for a quick bite? You're in luck. Take a few minutes' walk north of the Convention Center and you'll find pizza, poke, cupcakes, coffee, sushi, and sandwiches (including insanely good grinders at **Abella Pizzeria**), or head south for Italian, Mexican, and Thai.

When dinner's done and you want to sit back and celebrate, stop in at **7 Seas Brewery and Taproom**, **Doyle's Public House**, or **Rock the Dock Bar & Grill**. And be sure to put Tiki bars with phenomenal cocktails on your agenda and make your way to one of the best - **Devil's Reef**.

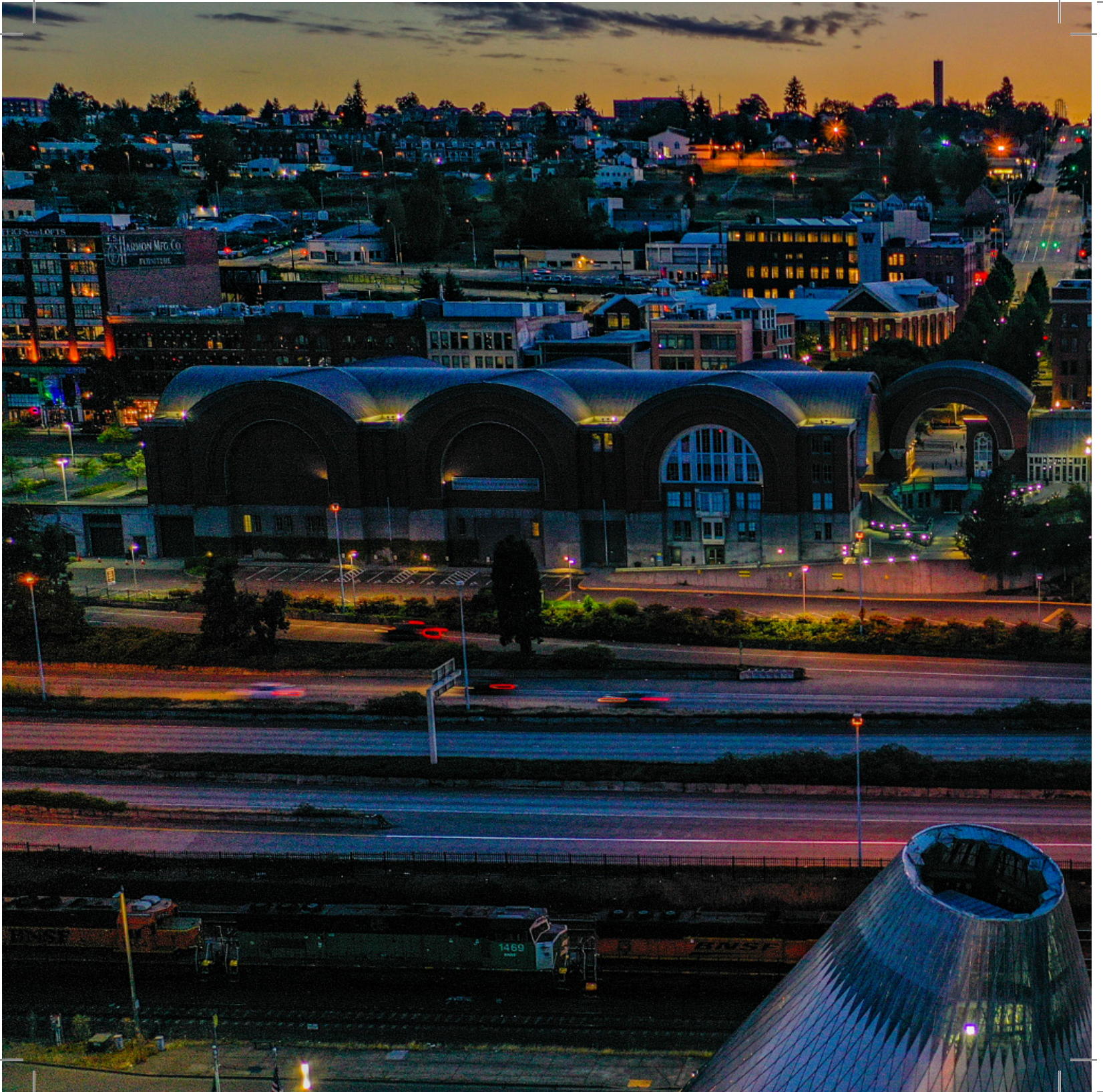
