Golf Tacoma and Pierce County to find wildly varied landscapes that offer rolling Scottish-style links, epic views and courses set along indigenous evergreen forests, saltwater shores and fresh water lakes. Pierce County has more than 20 courses that range from phenomenal public links to pristine golf clubs. Pierce County is a hot spot for pros and amateurs.

CHAMBERS BAY GOLF COURSE

University Place

This is a course where golf isn't just a game—it's a championship experience. You can follow in the footsteps of champions at Chambers Bay Golf Course, which hosted the 2015 U.S. Open. The course is a stunning tribute to the historic links of Scotland. This pure links golf course is surrounded by views of the Puget Sound and is encircled by trails that create more than a three-mile scenic loop through Chambers Creek Properties. Chambers Bay was named by *Golfweek Magazine* as number two for "America's Best Municipal Courses." Chambers Bay hosted the 2015 U.S. Open and the 2010 U.S. Amateur, and will host the 2019 U.S. Amateur Four-Ball Championship.

THE HOME COURSE

DuPont

Looking for affordable and exceptional golf? The Home Course was recognized by *Golfweek Magazine* as the number two "Best Public Course in Washington." This walkable course has panoramic views of the Puget Sound, Olympic Mountains and Mount Rainier. Enjoy historical features throughout the course such as buried bunker remnants from the explosive manufacturing era. Rolling fairways and contoured greens with minimal water and trees give golfers a challenge similar to Chambers Bay.

MEADOW PARK GOLF COURSE

Tacoma

Lined with magnificent fir and oak trees, Meadow Park Golf Course offers something for everyone. The course includes an 18-hole championship course, executive 9-hole, two putting courses and a driving range. Spend the afternoon at the grill or relaxing on the patio overlooking the putting greens.

EAGLE'S PRIDE GOLF COURSE

Joint Base Lewis-McChord

Nestled in the shadow of iconic Mount Rainier, Eagles Pride Golf Course provides a 27-hole summer course that converts to an 18-hole course during the winter. The championship course is located convenient to Tacoma, Lakewood, DuPont and Joint Base Lewis-McChord.

**CHAMPIONSHIP GOLFING AT
CHAMBERS BAY GOLF COURSE**

U.S. Amateur: Aug. 23-29, 2010

- Was the second time the U.S. Amateur was held in Washington state, the last time was in 1952 at Seattle Golf Club.
- Is the oldest national championship conducted by the USGA and is among the most prestigious championships in the world.
- Approximately 400 volunteers supported the 2010 U.S. Amateur.

U.S. Open: June 18-21, 2015

- Was the third municipal course to host the Open and the first in the Pacific Northwest.
- For the first time ever, the National Open was played on fine fescue grasses, including the putting greens.

**U.S. Amateur Four-Ball Championship:
May 23-30, 2019**

- Chambers Bay will become the first municipal course to host the U.S. Amateur Four-Ball Championship in May 2019.
- Only Chambers Bay, Olympic Club, Winged Foot, and Pinehurst will have hosted a U.S. Amateur, U.S. Open, and U.S. Four-Ball Championship.
