Pantages Theater

Opened in 1918 and is often regarded as the most beautiful in the national chain of Pantages theaters. Today it is the oldest of the Pantages Theaters still in operation. Attend live productions, concerts, symphonies, ballets and more.

Rialto Theater

Hailed as “the ultimate photoplay house,” the Beaux-Arts-style Rialto opened in 1918. Tacoma’s Rialto was part of a national movie house chain with ornate plaster decoration and replicas of cupids that can still be seen today. Attend regular concerts by Northwest Sinfonietta, Tacoma Symphony Orchestra, and the Tacoma Youth Symphony.

The newest of the Tacoma Arts Live theaters, Theater on the Square opened in 1993. The 302-seat theater and rehearsal hall sits adjacent to the Pantages. Catch films, entertainers, puppet shows and other performances.

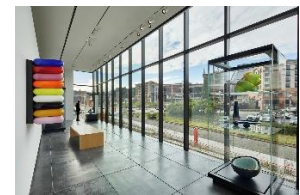
