

# Old Town TEMECULA

A trip to Temecula Valley Southern California Wine Country isn't complete without a stroll in historic Old Town. Come experience the rich heritage and contagious energy of this downtown foodie district with its restaurants, charming shops, and vibrant nightlife.



## PUBLIC ART

Two beautiful art pieces in Old Town pay tribute to our heritage, one is the centerpiece of the neighborhood, a Luiseño basket-artistry inspired fountain. Water flows from granite walls into a mosaic-tile fountain bowl that resembles the exceptional weave and textural design of Luiseño grass-woven baskets. The other is "The Emigrant Trail" mosaic mural hanging on the outside wall of the Civic Center. This beautiful rendering depicts the early trails across California that made their way through Temecula. Two outdoor murals decorate the sides of buildings on Sixth Street and Fourth Street. These make for great photo opportunities.


## About OLD TOWN

Old Town is home to a historical museum, Temecula Valley Museum; and a Children's Museum, Pennypickle's Workshop.

Temecula Valley Museum accurately portrays the stories of Temecula Valley's past and present through dynamic, fun, and exciting exhibits.

Pennypickle's Workshop, Temecula Children's Museum, is Professor Pennypickle's home, all 7,500 square feet of it, cluttered with hands-on inventions, gadgets, and experiments for kids of all ages to discover and play.

Special events in Old Town occur every season, celebrating the arts, the heritage, and the seasons.



# WINE COUNTRY *Overview*

Temecula Valley Southern California Wine Country spans more than 33,000 acres—the largest viticultural area in Southern California—yet is one of the state's best-kept secrets. The region is now home to nearly 50 wineries, from boutique to large-production, rustic to modern. Wine Country sees over 1.5 million visitors annually.


