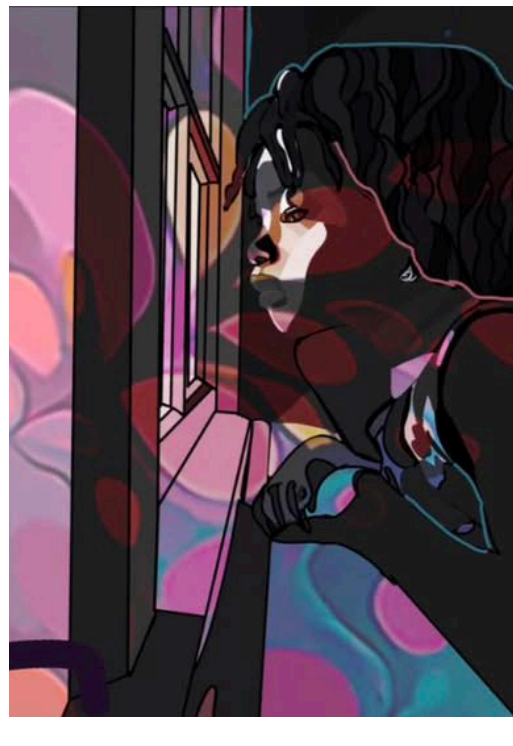
COME FROM AWAY: THE MUSICAL
