A LANDMARK PLACE

One of the most important legal rulings in our nation's history is rooted in Topeka. The 1954 U.S. Supreme Court decision in *Brown vs. Board of Education* declared "separate but equal" unconstitutional and ended segregation of public schools, spurring national desegregation. Explore the historic Monroe School on your own or on a free ranger-led tour, departing at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m., or by request. A junior ranger program is available. A visitor favorite is the hands-on experience in the kindergarten classroom. It features books, chalk and a piano.
