

DESTINATION TORONTO'S SWEEPSTAKES TO CELEBRATE DISNEY AND PIXAR'S TURNING RED

OFFICIAL SWEEPSTAKES RULES

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. YOU MUST HAVE INTERNET ACCESS TO ENTER THIS SWEEPSTAKES.

By entering the Destination Toronto's Sweepstakes (the "Sweepstakes"), entrants agree to abide by these Official Rules. The decisions of the Sponsor with respect to all aspects of the Sweepstakes are final. The information you provide will only be used to administer the Sweepstakes in accordance with the Sponsor's privacy policy.

1. SPONSOR/SWEEPSTAKES PERIOD: This Sweepstakes is governed by these official Sweepstakes rules (the "Official Rules"). VOID WHERE PROHIBITED. The Sweepstakes is sponsored by Toronto Convention & Visitors Association (the "Sponsor"). The Sweepstakes starts at 9:00:00 AM Eastern Time ("ET") on February 22, 2022 and closes at 11:59:59 PM ET on March 27, 2022 (the "Sweepstakes Period"). All references in these rules are Eastern Time, which shall control for all purposes of this Sweepstakes.

2. ELIGIBILITY: Sweepstakes is open only to (i) legal residents of Canada (excluding Quebec) who have reached the age of majority in their province or territory of primary residence at time of entry and (ii) legal residents of the United States residing in the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia (for greater certainty, this excludes Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands and other U.S. territories and possessions) who are at least eighteen (18) years of age and the age of majority in their state of residence at the time of entry. Employees of the Sponsor, its affiliated partners, agents, distributors, their respective advertising or promotional agencies, the independent contest organization, or The Walt Disney Company (Canada) Ltd and its parent, subsidiaries and affiliates ("Disney") (such entities, collectively, the "Promotion Entities") or members of any such employee's immediate family (regardless of where they live) or persons with whom such employees reside (whether related or not) are ineligible to enter or win. "Immediate family" includes spouses or domestic partners and parents, siblings, children and their spouses and domestic partners. You must have a valid email address to participate. Entries received on-line shall be deemed to be submitted by the authorized account holder of the email address submitted at the time of entry. "Authorized account holder" is defined as the natural person who is assigned to an e-mail address by an internet access provider, on-line service provider, or other organization (e.g. business, educational institution, etc.) that is responsible for assigning e-mail addresses for the domain associated with the submitted e-mail address. Illegible and/or incomplete entries will not be accepted.

3. HOW TO ENTER: Visit destinationtoronto.com/promotion (the "Sweepstakes Website") and complete the entry form (the "Entry Form") with your full name, complete mailing address (including zip code or postal code), daytime telephone number (including area code), and a valid email address. Next, confirm that you have read and agree to these Official Rules and indicate whether you would like to receive information about future promotions and new products from the Sponsor (optional). Click submit and you will automatically receive one (1) entry (the "Entry") into the Grand Prize draw for your Country of residence (the "Applicable Grand Prize Draw") (See rule 5).

Entries must be received by the Sweepstakes Website by 11:59:59 PM ET on March 27, 2022 (the "Sweepstakes Closing Date") to be entered into the Applicable Grand Prize draw (see rule 5). There is a limit of (1) Entry per person

during the Sweepstakes Period. A person may only use one (1) email address to enter the Sweepstakes. Any person who is found to have entered in a fashion not sanctioned by these Official Rules and/or has submitted more than the number of Entries permitted by these Official Rules will be disqualified and all Entries submitted by that individual will be void. Proof of transmission (screenshots or captures, etc.) does not constitute proof of delivery. Entries generated by script, macro, robotic, programmed, or any other automated means are prohibited and will be disqualified.

4. GRAND PRIZE: There will be one (1) grand prize available to be won by U.S residents and one (1) grand prize available to be won by Canadian residents for a total of two (2) grand prizes available to be won (collectively referred to as the “**Grand Prizes**” or “**Grand Prize**”). Each Grand Prize consists of a trip for the winner and up to three (3) guests (each a “**Guest**”) to Toronto, Ontario (the “**Destination**”) consisting of Economy Class round trip airfare on Air Canada Express or Air Canada Rouge for the winner and up to three (3) Guests from a major international airport closest to the Grand Prize winner’s place of residence in their country of residence (the “**Departure Point**”) to Toronto, ON; transportation for the winner and Guests to/from the airport and the designated hotel in Toronto via the UP Express; three (3) nights’ accommodations in a 4-star (or higher) hotel in Toronto for the winner and up to three (3) Guests in one (1) room, quad occupancy (two (2) double beds), as selected by the Sponsor; and \$2,500.00 (CDN) in spending money in the form of a cheque made payable to the winner or as prepaid credit cards (at the sole discretion of the Sponsor). The maximum approximate retail value of each Grand Prize is \$10,000.00 (CDN) and will vary depending on points of departure. Any difference between such approximate retail value and the actual value of the Grand Prize as taken will not be awarded. Limit of one (1) Grand Prize per household.

Travel must be booked by February 1, 2023 and completed by 11:59:59 PM (ET) March 27, 2023 (The “**Travel Period**”). Booking is subject to availability of flights and hotel accommodation, government restrictions and regulations, hotel, airline, airport and other transportation restrictions and regulations. ***Travel is not permitted during the standard blackout periods (such as Christmas, March Break, and New years), which are subject to change without notice.*** It is the sole responsibility of the winner and their Guests to obtain all necessary travel documentation, including, without limitation, passports and visas (as applicable), and to comply with any customs and immigration requirements (as applicable). The Sponsor reserves the right to provide ground transportation in lieu of air transportation if the winner resides within two hundred (200) miles from the Destination. The Grand Prize winner and his/her Guests must be available to travel during the Travel Period and no change in travel arrangements can be made by a winner once their booking has been confirmed, otherwise the Grand Prize may be forfeited. It is recommended that the winner and their Guest obtain sufficient personal insurance prior to departure, which is the responsibility of the winner and Guest(s). The winner and Guest(s) must travel on the identical itinerary and depart/return from the same airport at the Departure Point. In the event that the winner is unable to redeem all of the Grand Prize components due to reasons beyond the control of the Sponsor, no compensation or substitute prize component will be provided and the winner will not be awarded any portion of the Grand Prize. No compensation will be made if trip is cancelled due to failure to obtain necessary travel & health documents. Further, no compensation will be made in the case that the winner or his/her Guest(s) is denied entry by Customs and Border Protection or other authority.

FOR CANADIAN RESIDENTS: As of January 11, 2022 and per the guidelines found at <https://travel.gc.ca/travel-covid/travel-restrictions/domestic-travel>, a COVID-19 test is not required to board a flight or train in Canada (subject to change), however to board a flight or train within Canada, the winner and his/her Guest(s) must (a) be fully vaccinated with accepted Covid-19 vaccines; (b) be ready at any point to show official proof of vaccination; (c) have received the second dose at least 14 full days prior to travel; (d) have no signs or symptoms of COVID-19 and (e) wear a mask. **FOR U.S RESIDENTS:** As of December 15, 2022, and per the guidelines found at <https://travel.gc.ca/travel-covid/travel-restrictions/covid-vaccinated-travellers-entering-canada>, Travellers are

eligible to enter or return to Canada if they qualify as a fully vaccinated traveller. The winner and his/her Guest(s) must (a) provide proof of a COVID-19 negative molecular test result to enter Canada OR proof of a previous positive test result taken between 15 and 180 days ago (for Guests 5 years and older) (b) be fully vaccinated with accepted Covid-19 vaccines (for Guests 5 years and older); (c) be ready at any point to show official proof of vaccination (for Guests 5 years and older); (d) have received the second dose at least 14 full days prior to travel (for Guests 5 years and older); (e) have no signs or symptoms of COVID-19 and (f) wear a mask. Any changes to the travel restrictions as set out by the U.S and/or Canadian government will be applied as necessary.

All incremental costs in using or claiming the Grand Prize not outlined in the prize description are the sole responsibility of the Grand Prize winner and their Guests including but not limited to: airport/departure taxes, security charges or other third party fees, taxes or charges connecting flights apart from the roundtrip airfare, additional ground transportation, fuel, gasoline and currency surcharges, insurance, meals & beverages, gratuities, laundry services, entertainment, excursions, transfers, merchandise, souvenirs, local and long distance telephone calls, medical, travel and cancellation insurance together with any required travel documentation, emergency evacuations and any and all personal expenses of any kind or nature. The Grand Prize winner and their Guest are also solely responsible for all costs incurred to and from the departure point as the Grand Prize originates and terminates there. NOTE: The Grand Prize winner may be required to present a valid major credit card in their name at the time of hotel check-in to cover any incidental expenses. Travel arrangements must be made through the Sponsor. No frequent flyer miles will be awarded. The following will not be permitted: Stopovers or multi-city itineraries; the use of eUpgrade credits; and Entry into the Signature Suite. The Winner & Guest(s) may be held liable to Air Canada for failure to adhere to the restrictions and conditions of travel applicable to their tickets or for the fraudulent use of those tickets.

Before being able to participate in the Grand Prize, the Guest(s) will be required to sign and return within the time stipulated by the Sponsor, a guest declaration and release form stating that, among other things, they have read and understood these Official Rules, grants all consents required, accepts to participate in the Grand Prize as offered and releases the Releasees (defined below) from any and all liability of any kind arising out of the Guest's participation and their own in the Grand Prize, including, without limitation, all travel related thereto. If a Guest is considered a minor in the applicable country of residence (the "**Minor**"), the Minor's parent or legal guardian must sign and complete the Guest declaration & release form on behalf of the Minor and their parent or legal guardian must accompany them on the trip (and count as one (1) guest if the parent or legal guardian is not the Grand Prize winner). Winner and Guests must abide by all venue policies. The Sponsor reserves the right to revoke full or partial prize from any winner or winner's guest who it and/or venue personnel deem may, in their sole discretion, be intoxicated, be a safety risk, have violated any venue policy or law, and/or may bring the Sponsor into disrepute. Entry requirements into certain restaurants, activities, or events are subject to fluctuations and dependent on the evolution of COVID-19 both in Toronto as determined by the federal, provincial, municipal or local government requirements. Each winner hereby agrees that the Sponsor shall not have any responsibility or liability towards winner and his or her Guest if they are denied entry to any Country (as applicable) as a result of COVID-19 or changes in the current situation or if they are denied entry due to failure to comply with the aforementioned requirements. The Sponsor is not responsible if the Prize is delayed, postponed or cancelled for any reason, in which event, the Grand Prize is forfeited in its entirety and no substitution will be provided, except at Sponsor's sole discretion.

The Grand Prize must be accepted as awarded without substitution, is not transferable, not for resale and has no cash surrender value. The Sponsor reserves the right, in the event that a Prize or any component of a Prize cannot be awarded as described, or becomes unavailable for any reason, to substitute another Prize or component of a Prize of equal or greater value.

5. GRAND PRIZE DRAW: A total of two (2) random Grand Prize draws (one (1) per country)(each a “**Grand Prize Draw**”) will be held in Oakville, ON at 11:00 AM EST on March 30, 2022 (the “**Draw Date**”) – one (1) Grand Prize Draw will be held from among all eligible Entrants residing in the United States to determine the one (1) U.S potential winner of a Grand Prize (the “**U.S. Potential Winner**”) (see rule 7) and one (1) Grand Prize Draw will be held from among all eligible Entrants residing in Canada to determine the one (1) Canadian potential winner of a Grand Prize (the “**Canadian Potential Winner**”) (see rule 6). Odds of being selected as a potential winner of a Grand Prize depend on the total number of Entries received for each Country during the Sweepstakes Period. Grand Prize awards are subject to verification of eligibility and compliance with these Official Rules.

6. WINNER NOTIFICATION (for Canadian Residents ONLY):

The Canadian Potential Winner will be contacted by telephone and/or email within three (3) business days of the applicable Draw Date (the “**Notification**”). To be declared a Grand Prize winner, the Canadian Potential Winner must answer correctly, without assistance of any kind, whether mechanical or otherwise, a mathematical skill-testing question. The Canadian Potential Winner will also be required to sign a Declaration and Release Form (the “**Release Form**”) confirming compliance with the Official Rules, acceptance of the Prize as awarded, without substitution, and releasing the Sponsor, its dealers, agents, affiliated and related companies, advertising and promotional agencies, the independent contest organization, Disney and their respective shareholders, directors, officers, employees, agents, dealers, representatives, successors and assigns (collectively, the “**Releasees**”) from any liability in connection with the Grand Prize or this Sweepstakes. The Release Form must be returned within five (5) business days or the Grand Prize may be forfeited. The Sponsor shall have no liability if the notification is lost, intercepted or not received by the Canadian Potential Winner for any reason including but not limited to if the Notification is returned as unclaimed or undeliverable. If the Canadian Potential Winner (a) cannot be reached by telephone and/or email within five (5) business days of the first Notification; (b) fails to correctly answer the skill testing question; or (c) fails to return the properly executed Release Form within the specified time, then he/she will be disqualified and another entrant will be randomly selected until such time as contact is made by telephone and/or email with a Canadian Potential Winner or there are no more eligible Entries for the applicable country, whichever comes first. Upon receipt of the completed Release Form and of the skill testing question correctly answered, the Grand Prize will be coordinated by the Sponsor and/or it’s representatives within 6-8 weeks.

7. WINNER NOTIFICATION (for US Residents ONLY):

The U.S Potential Winner will be notified by telephone and/or email at the Sponsor’s discretion using the contact information provided at the time of entry. If a U.S Potential Winner is determined to be less than eighteen (18) years of age or less than the age of majority in his/her state of residence or ineligible for any other reason, then the U.S Potential Winner will be disqualified and an alternate winner will be selected. The Sponsor shall have no liability if the winner notification is lost, intercepted or not received for any reason. If, despite reasonable efforts, a U.S Potential Winner does not respond within five (5) business days of the first notification attempt, or if a Prize or Prize notification is returned as unclaimed or undeliverable, such Prize will be forfeited and an alternate U.S Potential Winner will be randomly selected. If a U.S Potential Winner is found to be ineligible for, or declines the Prize for any reason prior to award, the U.S Potential Winner will be disqualified and an alternate winner will be randomly selected. To be declared a Grand Prize winner, the U.S Potential Winner will be required to complete a Declaration of Eligibility and Liability Release and, as permitted by law, a Publicity Release (a “**Declaration/Release**”), and must be returned within five (5) business days along with any other documentation that the Sponsor may require or the U.S Potential Winner will be disqualified and another entrant will be randomly selected until such time as contact is made by telephone and/or email with a U.S Potential Winner or there are no more eligible entries, whichever comes first. Upon receipt of the completed Declaration/Release, the Grand Prize will be coordinated by the Sponsor and/or it’s representatives within 6-8 weeks. The U.S. Grand Prize winner will receive an IRS-1099 for the ARV of the prize at

the end of the calendar year which the prize is awarded. Any and all taxes related to the prize shall be the sole responsibility of the winner.

8. GENERAL LIABILITY RELEASE/FORCE MAJEURE: Entrants agree that the Promotion Entities and each of their respective officers, directors and employees (A) shall not be responsible or liable for, and are hereby released from, any and all costs, injuries, losses or damages of any kind, including, without limitation, death and bodily injury, due in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, to participation in the Sweepstakes or any Sweepstakes-related activity or from entrants' acceptance, receipt, possession and/or use or misuse of any Grand Prize, and (B) have not made any warranty, representation or guarantee express or implied, in fact or in law, with respect to any Grand Prize, including, without limitation, to such Grand Prize's quality or fitness for a particular purpose. The Promotion Entities assume no responsibility for any damage to an entrant's or any other person's computer system or wireless phone which is occasioned by accessing the Website or otherwise participating in the Sweepstakes, or for any computer system, phone line, hardware, software or program malfunctions, or other errors, failures, delayed computer transmissions or network connections that are human or technical in nature. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Sponsor is not responsible for incomplete, illegible, misdirected, misprinted, late, lost, damaged, stolen entries, email or mail or Grand Prize notifications; or for lost, interrupted, inaccessible or unavailable networks, servers, satellites, Internet service providers, websites, or other connections; or for miscommunications, failed, jumbled, scrambled, delayed, or misdirected computer, telephone or cable transmissions; or for any technical malfunctions, failures, difficulties or other errors of any kind or nature; or for the incorrect or inaccurate capture of information, or the failure to capture any information. The Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who is found to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Sweepstakes or the Website, to be acting in violation of these Official Rules, or to be acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with the intent to disrupt or undermine the legitimate operation of the Sweepstakes, or to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person, and the Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages and other remedies from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. No mechanically reproduced, illegible, incomplete, forged, software-generated or other automated multiple entries will be accepted. The Sponsor reserves the right, to modify, suspend, or terminate the Sweepstakes, if they determine, in their sole discretion, that the Sweepstakes is technically impaired or corrupted or that fraud or technical problems, failures or malfunctions or other causes have destroyed or severely undermined or to any degree impaired the integrity, administration, security, proper play and/or feasibility of the Sweepstakes. In such event the Sponsor is prevented from awarding Grand Prize or continuing with the Sweepstakes as contemplated herein by any event beyond their control, including but not limited to fire, flood, natural or man-made epidemic or health of other means, earthquake, explosion, labor dispute or strike, act of God or public enemy, satellite or equipment failure, riot or civil disturbance, terrorist threat or activity, war (declared or undeclared) or any federal state/province or local government law, order, or regulation, public health crisis, order of any court or jurisdiction, or other cause not reasonably within the Sponsor's control (each a "Force Majeure" event or occurrence), then subject to any governmental approval which may be required, If the Sweepstakes is terminated or suspended before the Sweepstakes Closing Date, notice thereof will be posted on the Sweepstakes Website and the Sponsor will (if possible) select the winner in a random drawing from all eligible, non-suspect entries legitimately received as of the date of the event giving rise to the termination. Inclusion in such drawing shall be each entrant's sole and exclusive remedy under such circumstances. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these Official Rules shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. In the event that any provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable or illegal, these Official Rules shall otherwise remain in effect and shall be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or illegal provision were not contained herein. The Sponsor reserves the right to correct clerical or typographical errors in promotional materials or these rules.

9. By entering and/or accepting the Grand Prize, the winner consents to the use of his/her name, address (city and state or province) and/or photograph, without further compensation, in connection with any publicity carried

out by or on behalf of the Sponsor with respect to this Sweepstakes, except to the extent prohibited by law.

10. GOVERNING LAW-RESIDENTS OF THE UNITED STATES ONLY: This Sweepstakes shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York. Except where prohibited, each Entrant agrees that: (1) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with the Sweepstakes or any prize awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by state or federal courts situated in New York; (2) any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, but in no event attorneys' fees; (3) no punitive, incidental, special, consequential or other damages, including without limitation lost profits may be awarded (collectively, "Special Damages"); (4) they hereby waive all rights to claim Special Damages and all rights to have such damages multiplied or increased; and (5) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with the intellectual property of Disney, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the state of California and in the event of any dispute, all entrants irrevocably consent to the jurisdiction of the state and federal courts located in Los Angeles, California to resolve such disputes. New York law, without reference to New York' choice of law rules, governs the Sweepstakes and all aspects related thereto.

11. GOVERNING LAW- RESIDENTS OF CANADA ONLY: All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation, and enforceability of the Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of Entrants and the Sponsor in connection with the Sweepstakes, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of Ontario and the laws of Canada applicable, without regard to conflicts of law principles. Any attempt by a participant or any other individual to deliberately damage any website or undermine the legitimate operation of the Sweepstakes could be a violation of criminal and civil laws and should such an attempt be made, the Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. This Sweepstakes is subject to all federal, provincial, territorial and municipal laws.

12. All entries become the permanent property of the Sponsor and none will be returned.

13. The winner's list will be posted on destinationtoronto.com by April 30, 2022 and will remain available until June 1, 2022.

14. The Sponsor respects your right to privacy. Personal information collected from entrants will only be used by the Sponsor to administer the Sweepstakes and, only if consent is given at the time of entry, to provide the entrants with information regarding upcoming promotions and/or events from the Sponsor and its affiliates. By entering the Sweepstakes, all entrants consent to the manner of collection, use and disclosure of personal information as set out in the Sponsor's privacy policy, which is available at <https://www.destinationtoronto.com/privacy-policy/>.
