



**TIERS:**

**Tier 1:**

**UP TO 5% REBATE**

**MINIMUM \$100K – FEATURE FILMS AND TV SERIES**

**Qualifies for a rebate of up to \$50K**

**Tier 2:**

**MINIMUM \$5M – FEATURE FILM | MINIMUM \$500K TV SERIES**

**Qualifies for a rebate of up to \$75K**

- Tier 1: Minimum total qualifying expenditure of \$100,000 but less than \$5,000,000 for feature film projects; or minimum total qualifying expenditure of \$100,000 but less than \$500,000 for scripted and reality television projects
- Tier 2: Same as Tier 1 but minimum total qualifying expenditures of \$5,000,000 for feature film and \$500,000 for television projects.
- Main Production Office must be located in Tulsa Production Zone\*
- More than 50% of filming days occur within Tulsa Production Zone\*
- An applicant can qualify only once per year. Exception may be made for episodic series. An applicant will be considered the same for rebate purposes if the entity entitled to receive the rebate shares any common ownership, corporate officers or other verifiable affiliation with a previous applicant
- Must meet with the Tulsa Office of Film, Music, Arts & Culture before applying
- The Executive Director of Tulsa FMAC must be added to the distribution list during both pre-production and production phases. This includes receiving all relevant documents such as call sheets, crew lists, vendor lists, scripts, schedules, DOODs, safety memos, location notification letters, and any correspondence related to the qualifying jurisdiction.
- Must provide all necessary documentation for audit of application (including THE FINAL LEDGER AND EXHIBITS) within 90 days of the completion of production. If postproduction takes place in Tulsa Production Zone\*, this deadline shall be extended until 90 days from the completion of post-production within the Tulsa Production Zone
- Include the Tulsa Office of Film, Music, Arts & Culture logo in the end credits and acknowledge Tulsa as the filming location. If the Oklahoma Film & Music Office program is also used, the Tulsa logo and credit must appear immediately after the Oklahoma Film & Music Office logo.
- Productions are encouraged to consider Tulsa as the host city for premiere events of projects that qualify for the Tulsa Film Incentive.

**Additional Considerations:**

- Filming more than one qualifying feature film
- Filming multiple episodes on qualifying scripted TV series
- Post-production taking place at a facility in the Tulsa Production Zone\* using Tulsa Production Crew\*\*/contractors to perform work including but not limited to editing, Foley, ADR, sound editing, negative cutting, color correction and sound mixing.

- Cost of producing and recording music in the Tulsa Production Zone\* and/or licensing music created by residence within the Tulsa Production Crew Zone\*\*.
- More than 50% of the crew are residents within the Tulsa Production Crew Zone\*\*.
- More than 50% of the contracts with vendors that sell or lease products subject to Tulsa City sales tax withholding and holding a Tulsa sales tax permit are situated in Tulsa city limits.
- More than 75% of filming days occur within the Tulsa Production Zone\*.
- Contracting and purchasing with diverse businesses and vendors in Tulsa Production Zone\*.
- Qualifying for the Filmed in Oklahoma state rebate program
- Total amount of qualified expenditures for the project
- Additional factors may be considered in awarding additional incentives

\*Tulsa Production Zone = 30-mile radius from Tulsa City Hall, 175 E 2nd St S, Tulsa, OK 74103

\*\*Tulsa Production Crew Zone = 45-mile radius from Tulsa City Hall, 175 E 2<sup>nd</sup> St S, Tulsa, OK 74103

**Definition of terms:**

**Pilot / Series:** A production can qualify for the rebate as a pilot or as a series but not for both in the same calendar year.

**Minimum five episodes:** If done between two consecutive calendar years the production only counts for the calendar year in which it began. Only one season counts per calendar year.

**Local labor:** It is defined as one having their main residence, in Oklahoma, within 45-miles of Tulsa City Hall. Minimum residency is 6 months prior to the date of hire and resident must possess either a valid Oklahoma driver's license, utility bill or ITN with name and address.

**Local Expenses:** It is defined as any rental or purchase made within the Tulsa Production Zone for use in the production.
