



Program Overview:

Beginning February 1, 2026, the Tulsa Office of Film, Music, Arts & Culture (Tulsa FMAC) will allocate up to \$400,000 in incentive funds to support film and television productions within the Tulsa region. This fund will be available for the 2026 calendar year and is subject to annual review.

Key Program Guidelines:

- Total Available Funds:**
A total of \$400,000 will be made available for distribution beginning February 1, 2026.
- Annual Program Review:**
The incentive fund and program guidelines will be reviewed annually by the Tulsa FMAC Film Incentive Committee.
- Application Process & Approval:**
The fund is available on a quarterly basis and a review/approval of the production project by senior Tulsa FMAC staff and Film Incentive Committee.
The Tulsa Regional Chamber, Tulsa Regional Tourism, and Tulsa FMAC reserve the sole discretion to approve or deny any application at any time.
- Disbursement of Funds:**
Incentive funds will be disbursed only upon project completion and submission of an independent audit verifying eligible expenditures.
- Maximum Aggregate Distribution:**
For the period of February 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026, the total maximum incentive program payout shall not exceed \$400,000.
- Qualified productions will be capped at a maximum of \$50,000 to \$75,000.**

Other Guidelines:

- Use of Funds:**
Any incentive funds not awarded or disbursed within the designated calendar year will be rolled over into the following year.
- Fixed Fund Cap:**
The total amount of funds available each year is capped and will not be increased.
