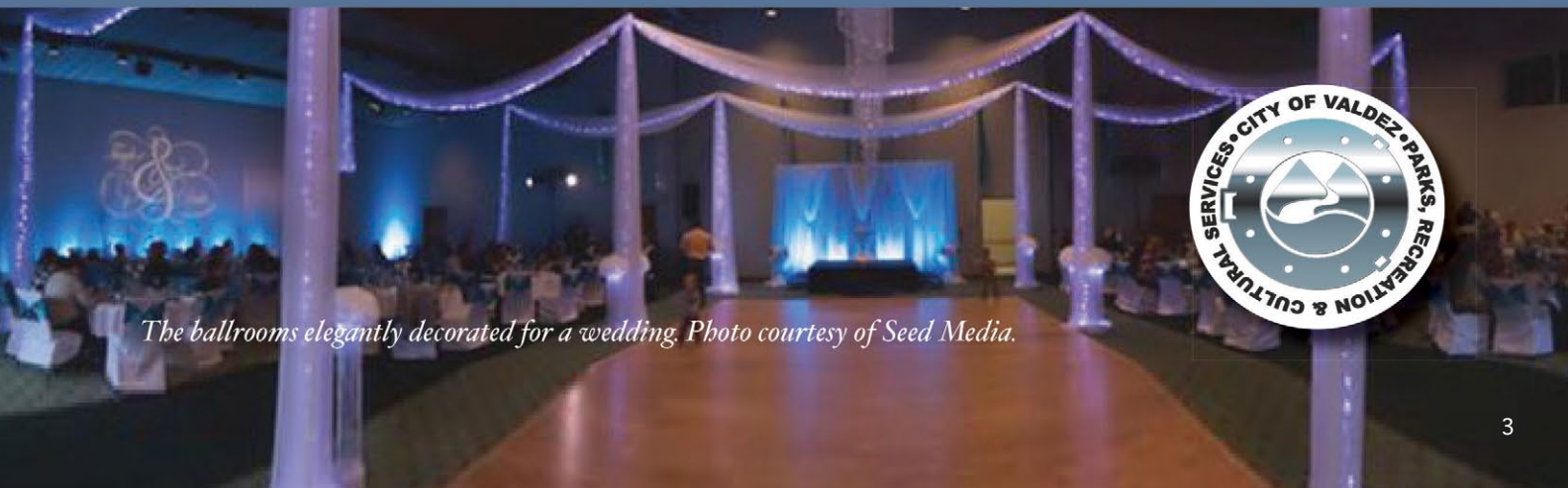

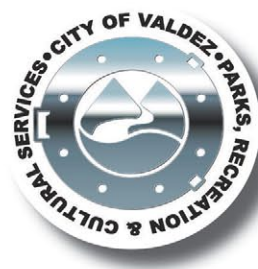

THINGS TO DO IN VALDEZ

JOURNEY THROUGH THOMPSON PASS

The Richardson Highway winds through beautiful Thompson Pass on the way to Valdez. Stop at Worthington Glacier; one of Alaska's most accessible glaciers.

VISIT KEYSTONE CANYON'S BREATHTAKING WATERFALLS

Gorgeous waterfalls cascade from the Keystone Canyon walls as you enter the gateway to Valdez. Take a hike along the Goat Trail located on the west end of the Bridal Veil parking area.

EXPLORE THE PRINCE WILLIAM SOUND

Home to glaciers, whales, porpoise, sea life, towering Chugach Mountains and a variety of sea birds. Situated in the midst of the Chugach National Forest, the Prince William Sound region is the northern most temperate rain forest in the U.S. The towns and villages of Chenega Bay, Cordova, Tatitlek, Whittier and Valdez can be found along the 2,700 miles of coastline.

Excursion vessels, rental boats, charters and kayaks depart daily from the small boat harbor in downtown Valdez. Or, charter a helicopter to see the spectacular sights.

SEE OUR AMAZING GLACIERS

Valdez is home to many accessible glaciers. You can hike, bike, boat or take a helicopter to explore any of our awe-inspiring glaciers.

TAKE A HIKE

Valdez boasts some of the most scenic and historic trails in Alaska, ranging from various lengths and difficulty levels.

Featured in "World's Best Hikes," by Bear Grylls on

Nationalgeographic.com, the 1.3 mile long John Hunter Memorial Trail begins in a beautiful coastal spruce forest, merges with the Alyeska Pipeline Maintenance Road and eventually leads to Solomon Lake and its two dams.

GO FISHING

Valdez is a premier fishing destination, offering all species of salmon and some of the most accessible halibut fishing in Alaska. Take part in our fishing derbies to potentially win big money and fun prizes.

CHECK OUT OUR MUSEUMS

The Valdez Museum and Remembering Old Valdez Exhibit tells the story of the incredible history and culture of Valdez—from the gold rush to present day. The Maxine & Jesse Whitney Museum holds a rare collection of Alaska Native artifacts and animal mounts.

VALDEZ FAST FACTS

LOCATION

Northeast section of Prince William Sound, surrounded by the Chugach Mountains, the tallest coastal mountains in North America. The Chugach Mountains rise from sea level to an elevation of 7,000 feet and are the most heavily glaciated mountains in the Northwest.

Imagine being near

the face of calving glaciers watching huge chunks of ice fall into the ocean as the rumbling crack of breaking ice fills the air. Whether you charter a helicopter, take a boat, kayak, or hike, Valdez has many accessible, breathtaking glaciers to explore. Some of the main glaciers include...

COLUMBIA GLACIER is the second largest tidewater glacier in North America and the largest in Prince William Sound. Navigate through chunks of glacial ice on wildlife cruises or kayak day trips, or take a helicopter ride to see the wonders of Columbia Glacier.

MEARES GLACIER is very unique. While most glaciers throughout the world are retreating, Meares Glacier is one of the only advancing tidewater glaciers in North America. It is located at the head of the Unakwik Inlet in Prince William Sound. Hop aboard a day boat cruise and get a quarter mile from the face of Meares Glacier. See an abundance of whales and other wildlife along the way.

SHOUP GLACIER is tucked away in Shoup Bay and is accessible by boat, kayak, and helicopter or on foot. Experienced hikers can take the 8.5-mile hike to Shoup Bay for fabulous views and an amazing kittiwake rookery. Please check on current conditions of trail before hiking.

VALDEZ GLACIER is located on the outskirts of Valdez and is full of amazing history. Known as the All American Route, gold seekers traveled over the glacier into the interior of Alaska during the Gold Rush of 1898. In the summer, Valdez Glacier can be accessed by kayak with one of our experienced local adventure companies. At certain times during the winter, you can hike, ski or snowmobile to the face of the glacier.

Prepare to be Amazed



WORTHINGTON GLACIER is one of the most accessible glaciers in Alaska. Located in Thompson Pass, just off the Richardson Highway, this glacier is a must-see if you're driving in or out of Valdez. Watch for the turnout area to the glacier, park your vehicle, and then walk up to the glacier for an up-close experience.

THE NATURAL BEAUTY and breathtaking wildlife in Valdez creates the perfect playground for abundant activities and adventure throughout the year. Valdez is home to the Prince William Sound — a mix of tidewater glaciers, rainforests, and mountains. Wild animals, birds and nature flourish here. Come visit Valdez and experience your own Alaskan adventure.

Alaska's Adventure Corridor



All roads lead to Valdez.

DRIVE: Proclaimed as one of “America’s Most Scenic Roads” and known to Alaskans as the “Adventure Corridor,” the drive to Valdez from Fairbanks, Tok, and Anchorage provides breathtaking views of glaciers, waterfalls, towering mountains and incredible scenery. The picturesque Glenn Highway and Richardson Highway converge

along the nation’s largest national park — the Wrangell-St. Elias — holding nine of the 16 tallest peaks in the U.S.

Whether driving from Anchorage, Tok, or Fairbanks, the community of Glennallen provides gas, food and lodging needs before continuing on to the Richardson Highway. Watch for the sign to Worthington

Glacier, one of Alaska’s most accessible glaciers, when driving through the breathtaking Thompson Pass.

Be ready to pull over and take in the majesty of the awe-inspiring Keystone Canyon, where cascading waterfalls greet you from towering canyon walls just before entering Valdez.

FLY: Take a short 45-minute flight from Anchorage. Daily flights offer spectacular views of the coastal Chugach Mountains, vast glacial ice fields and the beautiful Prince William Sound.

TAKE THE FERRY: With frequent service in the summer, The Alaska Marine Highway is an exciting and beautiful way to travel to Valdez and experience the majestic Prince William Sound. The Marine Highway offers service throughout the year to all three major coastal Prince William Sound communities. Expand your itinerary by including a visit to Cordova.

Local Hiking Trails

Valdez boasts some of the most scenic and historic trails in Alaska. Ranging from various lengths and difficulty levels, our trails are sure to please most everyone.

Dock Point Trail, a one-mile round trip hike located next to the small boat harbor, offers a beautiful view overlooking the Port of Valdez and the Alyeska Oil Terminal. Or, choose the more difficult Shoup Bay Trail that leads to the breathtaking Shoup Bay Glacier. See an amazing Kittiwake Rookery along the way (please check on conditions of this trail before hiking).

Mineral Creek Canyon is an extremely popular, six-mile gravel road that gradually winds its way through a majestic mountain canyon with magnificent cascading waterfalls virtually everywhere you look. Hike in as far as you like or go all the way to the end of the trail and see an abandoned gold-stamp mill.

The John Hunter Memorial Trail begins in a beautiful coastal spruce forest and steadily becomes steeper before merging with the Alyeska Pipeline Maintenance Road. This trail offers spectacular views of the Port of Valdez, mountains, glaciers and more. You know you're at the end of the trail when you reach Solomon Lake and its' two dams.

Land of Waterfalls

For all you thrill seekers looking for waterfalls, Valdez, Alaska has some of the most breathtaking waterfalls in the world. With more than 27 feet of average snow fall during the winter, Valdez becomes The Land of Waterfalls when the snow melts in the spring and summer time. Countless waterfalls cascade down almost every mountain side in Valdez.

When driving into Valdez, you will pass through Keystone Canyon; a place of spectacular waterfalls, magnificent geology and fascinating history. Horsetail Falls and Bridal Veil Falls cascade over towering canyon walls, greeting travelers from above. Keystone Canyon is located at miles 14 through 17 on the Richardson Highway.

There are various ways to get up close to these spectacular waterfalls: drive through the Keystone Canyon and park at one of the pull-outs to take beautiful photos; raft or kayak the Lowe River which runs directly in front of Bridal Veil Falls; or hike through the 1.8-mile Keystone Canyon Pack Trail that puts hikers above the Bridal Veil Falls and Keystone Canyon for a breathtaking birds-eye view. Ice climb the magnificent frozen waterfalls in the winter time.

Once you've entered the town of Valdez, hike one of our many trails where spectacular waterfalls can be enjoyed.

Nature and Wildlife

Wildlife is abundant and natural beauty exudes in Valdez and the surrounding area. Both black and brown bears live here, and are frequently seen wandering about eating their fill of fish and berries. Watch for eagles, terns, ptarmigan, puffins and many other birds. The Prince William Sound is full of amazing wildlife and incredible scenery. It's common to spot seals, sea lions, Dall porpoise, puffins, humpback whales and Orcas in this picturesque area. Pack your camera and your binoculars and come visit Valdez to see all the wildness and beauty of Alaska—all in one place.

of year-round activities to do in Valdez, one of the prettiest places in Alaska. If you're looking to escape into the respite of Mother Nature, Valdez is the place to be. Valdez is home to many glaciers that can be accessed by boat cruises, vehicles, walking, helicopter, snowmobiles, snowshoeing, and kayaks, depending on the time of year. See the beautiful Columbia, Meares, Worthington, Shoup, or Valdez glaciers. Tours accommodate all ages and skill levels.

During spring and summer time, day-long or extended boat tours of Prince William Sound will take you to some of the best vantage points for viewing mountains, glaciers, and wildlife. Orca and humpback whales, sea otters, sea lions, birds, porpoise and many other animals make their home in the Prince William Sound. Excursion vessels depart from the Small Boat Harbor for sightseeing and wildlife viewing.

Kayaking is another way to explore the Sound up close and personal. There are various professional kayak

outfitters in Valdez, trained and ready to give you a wonderful experience.

Raft the Lowe River through the magnificent Keystone Canyon, where cascading waterfalls tower above. Helicopter tours offer astonishing views of wildlife, glaciers, and incredible scenery: a magnificent way to experience the beauty of Valdez and the surrounding area. If you really want to get away from civilization all together, fly-outs and drop-offs are possible to remote locations via helicopter or small planes.

Consider staying at one of our incredible wilderness lodges. Choose from panoramic waterfront views of the Prince William Sound, or overlook beautiful Robe Lake near the Keystone Canyon. Wintertime brings tons of snow and creates a perfect playground for winter sports, such as heli skiing, snowboarding, snowshoeing, ice climbing, snowmobiling and more. Regardless of what time of year you're planning to visit Valdez, the beauty of Mother Nature will captivate you.

SPORT FISHING

THE PRINCE WILLIAM SOUND in Valdez is a premier fishing destination. Open year round, our waters are home to all species of salmon, rockfish, lingcod, and some of the most accessible halibut in Alaska. You can drop a line from shore, take your own boat or take a charter into deeper seas. Either way, you're likely to catch enough fish to eat for dinner or fill up your freezer.

Valdez is home to the oldest fish derbies in Alaska, awarding thousands of dollars in prize money each year. Young and old, all skill levels, the thrill of reeling in a record-breaking fish will keep you coming back for more.

FISH HATCHERY

SOLOMON GULCH HATCHERY presents a unique opportunity to observe salmon as they return to spawn. The hatchery is located across the port on Dayville Road en route to Allison Point. Completed in February 1983 to ensure sufficient numbers of salmon return each year, the facility is licensed to incubate, rear and release 230 million pink salmon, and 2 million coho. With a concerted effort from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game and the City of Valdez, the Solomon Gulch Hatchery annually imprints and releases 105,000 king smolts from the Fish and Game Fort Richardson Hatchery.

The Valdez Fisheries Development Association (VFDA) goals are to produce an annual return of 10 million pink salmon, 100,000 coho and 10,000 king salmon. The best time to view salmon at the hatchery is July through September.

Bears, eagles, sea gulls and sea otters can be found feeding on the fish. Fishing is prohibited within 300 feet of the premises. Please respect all wildlife, especially maintaining a safe distance from any bears in the area. Bears are wild animals and can be dangerous.

Take the self-guided walking tour along the fish ladder and view how the hatchery spawns the fish. The self-guided walkway is open daily, 8 a.m. to 7 p.m., from May to October.

Valdez is one of the snow capitals of the world

WITH A long-standing reputation for great snow, more than 300 inches is measured annually in the city and 600 to 900 inches in nearby Thompson Pass. From beginner to expert, there is something for everyone.

Valdez and the surrounding Chugach Mountains create a perfect landscape for backcountry skiing, heli-skiing, snowboarding, snowmobiling and ice climbing. There are various cross-country skiing trails in and around Valdez, too.

Access the backcountry on foot, snowmobile, by helicopter or snowcat for some of the most amazing big-mountain skiing and snowboarding in the world. Local Valdez guides and outfitters help create the dream winter vacation with single or multi-day packages.

Our beautiful waterfalls and glaciers act as pathways to adventure for ice climbers and hikers. Whatever challenge you are looking for, whether top-roping or multi-pitch lead climbing, there are dozens of routes around Valdez that will suit your needs.

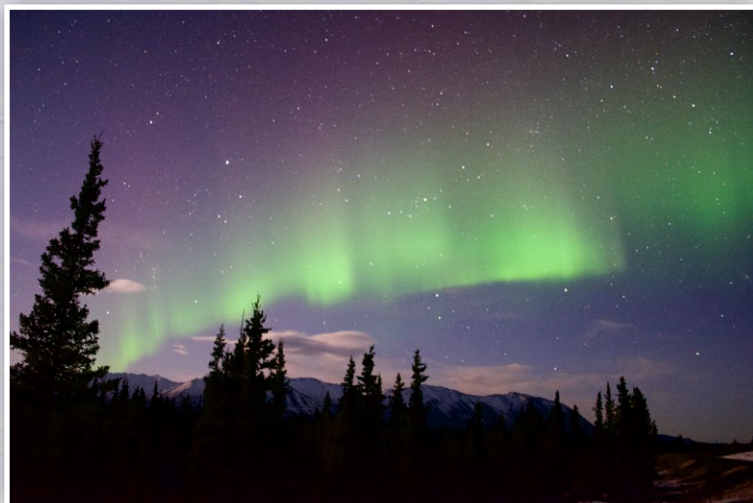

Outstanding snow events

NOT ONLY IS VALDEZ one of the top destinations in the world for backcountry snow sports, it's also home to some outstanding snow events — all set in gorgeous spectator-friendly settings.

THE MOUNTAIN MAN HILLCLIMB, held in Thompson Pass, is a qualifying event for the Snowmobile Hill Climb World Championships held annually in Jackson Hole, Wyoming.

THE MAYORS CUP is a 150-mile cross-country snowmachine race set on a 25-mile loop around Hogsback and the Valdez Glacier Flats.

TAILGATE ALASKA is the foremost backcountry freeride event which hosts the World Freeriding Championship.

VALDEZ QANIQ CHALLENGE is a 35-kilometer two-day cross country ski event, with a \$10,000 purse for winners.

SNOWKITE FESTIVAL at Thompson Pass: Speedriding and paragliding athletes from around the world demonstrate acrobatic skills and compete for prizes. Snowkite instructional training available and demos for spectators.

VALDEZ ICE CLIMBING FESTIVAL takes place Presidents Day weekend.

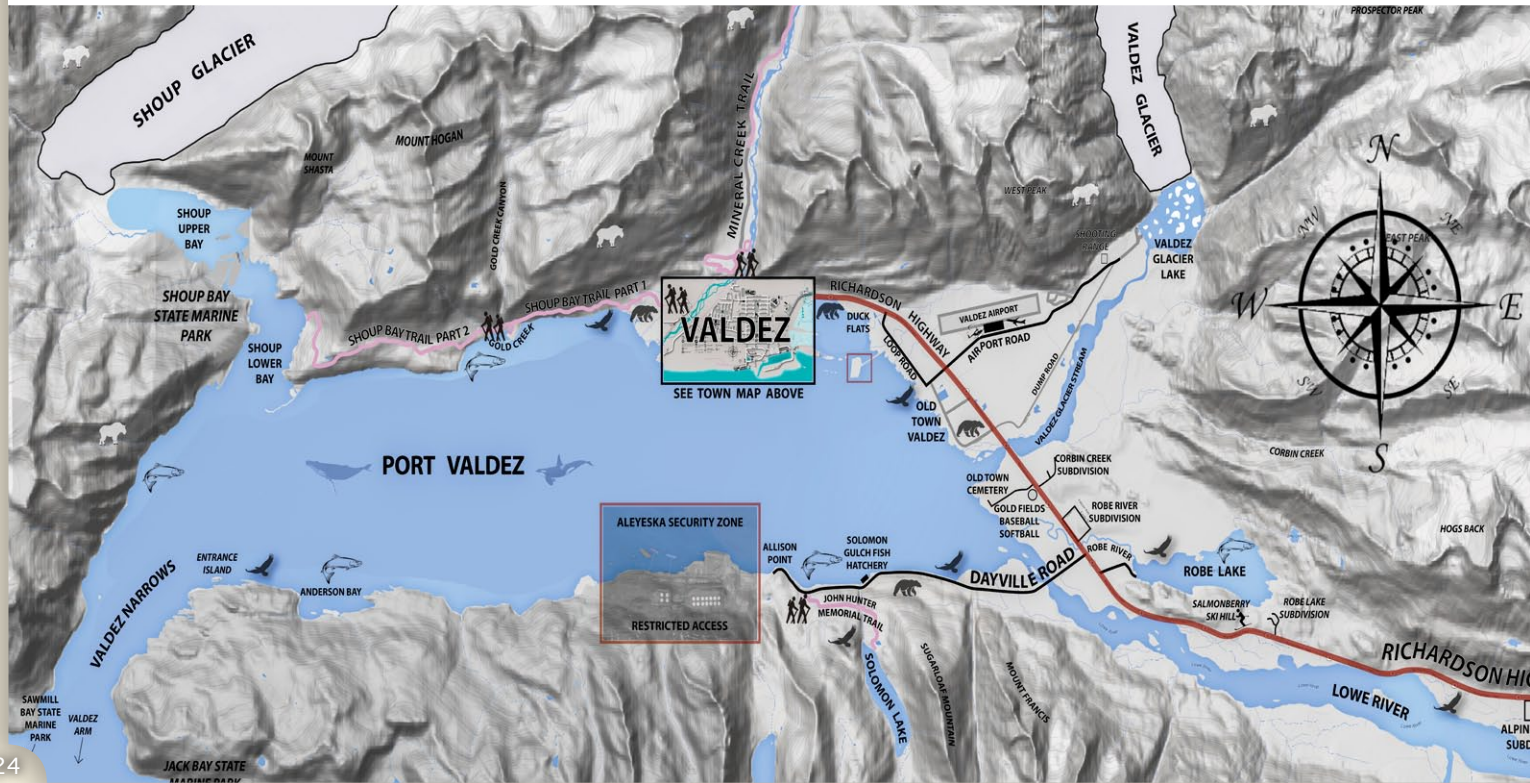
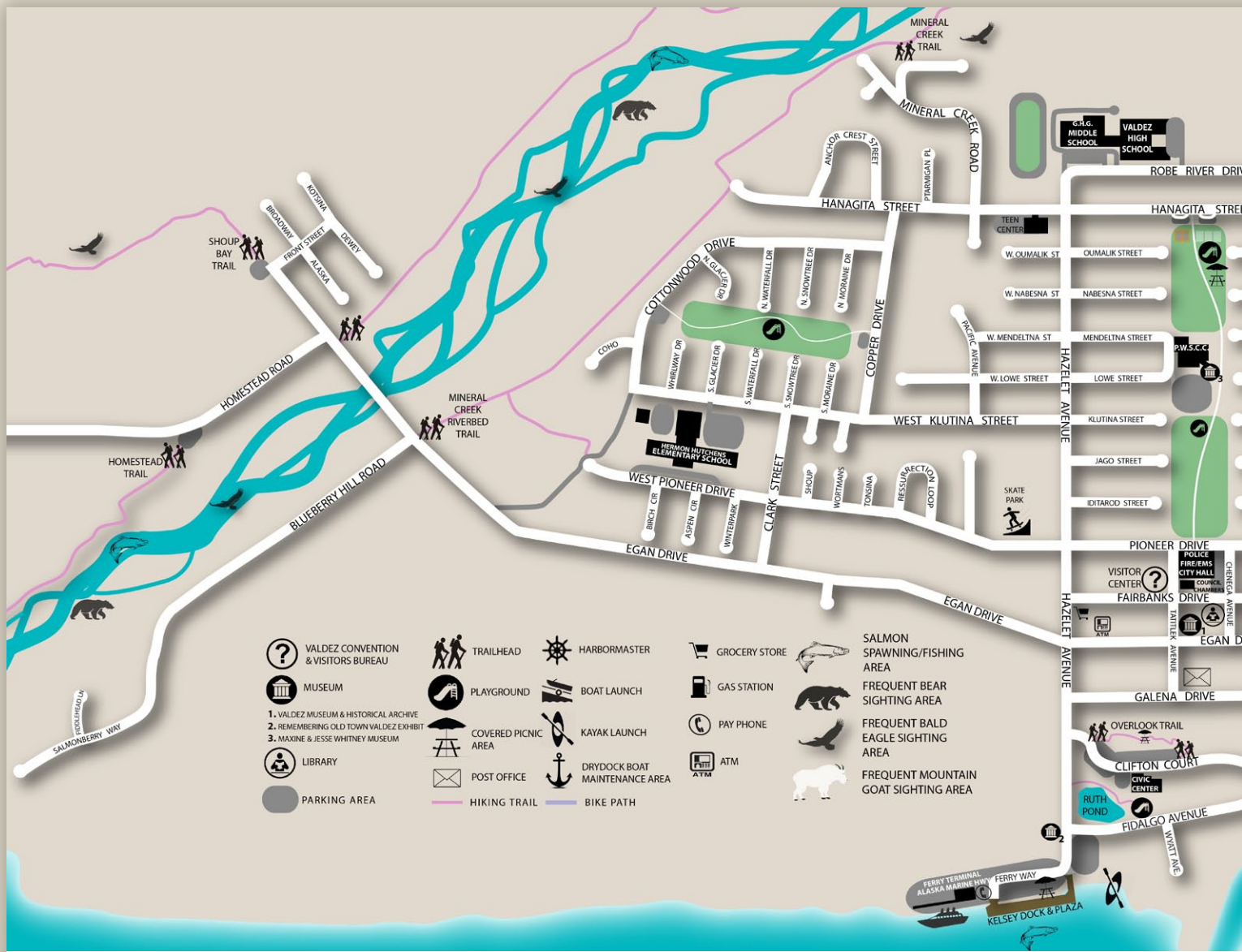

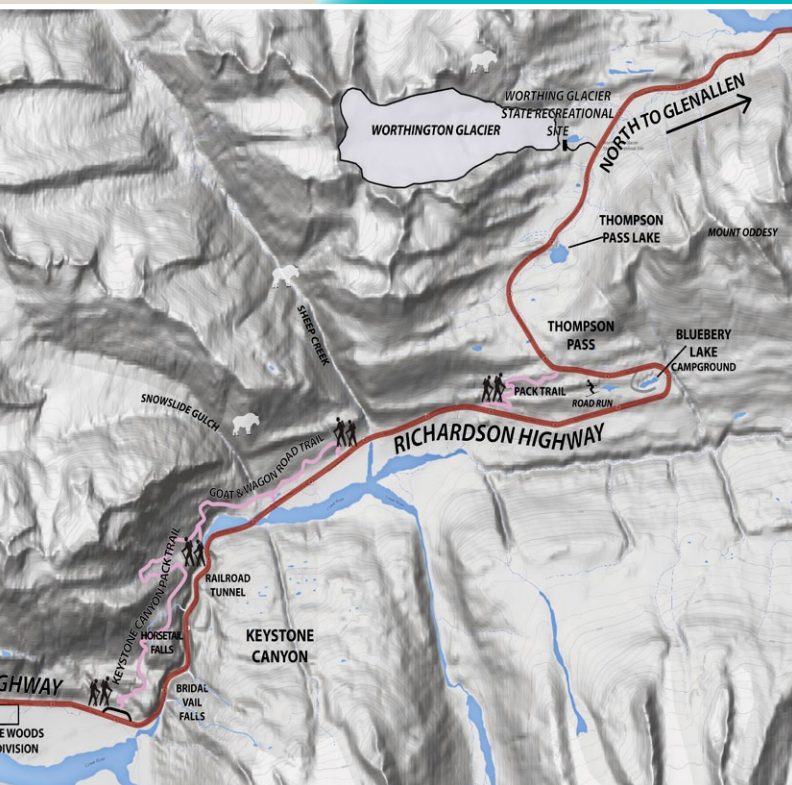

HOW TO DRESS

Alaska weather is very unpredictable. One should always dress in layers, and have a good waterproof, or water-resistant jacket. When near the water dress warmly, even in nice weather.



Be Bear Aware

BROWN BEARS AND BLACK BEARS FLOURISH in Valdez due to the abundant fish and plentiful berries for them to eat. Every year, countless people come here to witness the bears up close and personal. However, because of avoidable human behavior, it is increasingly common that bears are shot and killed unnecessarily.

Below are some things you should know about bears and what you can do to protect yourself and our increasingly rare bear population.

FIRST AND FOREMOST:

- It is illegal to feed bears or to harass them in any way. You can be ticketed and fined for feeding bears.
- Bears are wild animals, even the ones who seem friendly. Do not get close!

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT BEARS AND THEIR BEHAVIOR:

- Bears have about six months to feed before hibernating for the winter. Most of their food is consumed in the late summer and fall, leaving precious little time to store up enough nutrients to last them all year. Please leave plenty of space for bears to get to their crucial feeding grounds.
- Momma bears with cubs are especially dangerous because they will defend their cubs if they get nervous or feel threatened.
- Bears frequently use roads and trails to get from place to place. They hang out near thick underbrush, berry bushes, rivers and other waterways. Don't set up camp too close to these areas. Look for signs of bears, and stay away.

HOW CAN YOU PROTECT YOURSELF?

- Stay away: Bears can run as fast as horses. Always make sure that you stay a safe distance from bears – even the ones who seem friendly. Bears are wild animals. Use a long lens when photographing so you can stay a safe distance away from the bear, or better yet, photograph and observe bears from your vehicle. If you get too close, they may feel threatened and become aggressive.
- Never feed a bear. It's illegal and it can endanger your own life and the bear's. When bears acclimate to humans and

human foods, they're more likely to go to areas where people congregate in an effort to get that food. This becomes dangerous for people, and the bear often will be killed.

- No bear is friendly. People mistake "friendly" bears as nonthreatening. However, bears are wild animals and can attack at any moment.
- Keep your camp clean. Clean camps are less likely to attract bears. The most important rule is to always store food and hygiene products like toothpaste away from your tent. Bears have a keen sense of smell. Therefore, campers should keep all edibles in ice chests or air-tight storage containers in vehicles when not in use. Or, hang food containers from a rope strung high between two trees. Always pick up your trash and food remnants.
- Don't surprise a bear: Bears can become aggressive and are more likely to attack you if they are taken by surprise. Sing loudly, talk out loud, carry a bell or whistle when walking on trails, in the woods or anywhere where bears might be. Travel in pairs or groups of people when possible. Multiple people are louder than just one person.
- Never get between a bear and its food source. For instance, if you see a bear going toward the water to feed, don't go near the water or the bear to get a good picture. Observe the bear from a distance or slowly leave the area. Otherwise, you risk scaring the bear away from its needed meal, or alarming the bear and putting yourself in mortal danger.
- Keep dogs on leashes when you're walking or hiking. Wandering dogs can

attract the attention of bears and lure them toward people.

- If you see a bear up close, remain calm, slowly move away from the bear but don't turn your back on it. Make noise and wave your arms, letting the bear know that you are a human and not food.
- If you see a bear from a distance, give it space and leave it alone. Do not try to approach the bear; never get out of your car and go near a bear if you see one along a road.
- If a bear attacks you, try to make noise and scare it away. If that doesn't work, cover your head, tuck yourself into a ball on the ground and play dead. Bears usually leave once they believe you are no longer a threat to them.
- Biologists experienced in bear behavior say problems between bears and humans can be virtually eliminated when people arm themselves with knowledge and respect for bears and their habitat.
