## TWO-DAY ITINERARY

**With just a couple of days in Vancouver before an Alaska or Hawaii sailing, cruisers can still enjoy an authentic taste of the city. This itinerary takes them from exploring historic neighbourhoods and meeting the locals over a cocktail, to venturing high into the mountains.**

## EXPERIENCE VANCOUVER PRE/POST CRUISE: DAY ONE

Start your time in Vancouver by getting a great overview to the city via **Landsea Tours & Adventures'** four-hour "Vancouver Highlights" tour. After breakfast, you'll be picked up at your hotel before being introduced to many of Vancouver's most popular attractions and sights: Stanley Park, English Bay, Granville Island, Gastown and Chinatown. You'll have the chance to stop for photos at Stanley Park's famous totem poles, a bite to eat and souvenir shopping among the locals at **Granville Island**, and a ride up to the amazing view at the **Vancouver Lookout**. If you choose to take this tour on a day you're either arriving in Vancouver or departing the city, Landsea also offers transfers to and from the cruise ship terminal and the airport.

After your tour, take a leisurely, late afternoon stroll to explore one of Vancouver's favourite neighbourhoods, Yaletown. Adjoining downtown, Yaletown is a former warehouse district that is now home to thousands of locals as well as chic boutiques, design stores, and some of the city's best restaurants. After wandering the neighbourhood and perhaps doing some people watching over a perfect cup of coffee, sit down to a superb seafood feast at Blue Water Café, or perhaps high-end Italian with a modern twist at **La Pentola**. If you're not quite ready for the evening to end, consider a post-dinner beer at **Yaletown Brewing Co.**, or experience Vancouver's thriving cocktail scene at a bar such as **Prohibition**, **The Blackbird**, or **Pourhouse**.





## EXPERIENCE VANCOUVER PRE/POST CRUISE: DAY TWO

As you'll be departing Vancouver this afternoon, check out of your hotel after breakfast and bring your luggage to the lobby. **Rockwood Adventures** will pick up both you and your bags, and take you out to experience the region's temperate rainforest environment on their "Lighthouse Park Rainforest Trek." Heading over to the North Shore, your naturalist guide will take you on an interpretive walk through West Vancouver's Lighthouse Park. You'll stop to examine the fascinating ecology of this area as you walk among old-growth forest before reaching the waves crashing against the granite outcrop and enjoying a most scenic snack.

After your morning hike, you'll be dropped off at the cruise terminal. Store your bags with CDS Priority Baggage, and walk upstairs to Canada Place for one last Vancouver adventure. Before taking to the seas, take to the air with **FlyOver Canada!** One of Vancouver's favourite attractions, the 4-D flight simulation takes you soaring across the country, complete with wind, scents and mist! After the show, head downstairs to the cruise terminal to board your ship and wave farewell to Vancouver.
