Clark County Health Update

From Russell Brent to Everyone: Dr. Melnick case rates are skyrocketing. State rate 1000 cases per 100k population. Omicron up to 84% of cases compared to 50% the prior week. Hospitalizations are increasing too. 25% of Clark County ICU beds covid. Hospital workforce is also an issue. Support around testing. State will be distributing at home tests and masks. Will work thru LHJ. mid to late Jan. Encouraging news on effectiveness of vax. Omicron will continue to strain health care system.

From Russell Brent to Everyone:

Anthony Anton... Gov Office ...Omicron skyrocketing and not close to cresting. CEO of hospital assoc. is concerned about upcoming capacity. Cloth masks are not as effective with Omicron. Disposables and N95 KN95. Omicron is rewriting the rules. Dr Melnick uses KN95. Encourage our industry to use disposal mask. Testing is putting an additional strain on HC system. Hospital capacity is what Anthony is watching closely as the important indicator of possible rule changes. Booster is encouraged. Vax has proven to lessen the impact/illness if infected. History has shown that vaccines have required boosters to maintain effectiveness. Home testing. Anyone with symptoms should stay home. If exposed get tested.
