Ukrainian Heritage Museum

Manor College

Ukrainian Heritage Museum – Jenkintown

Manor College in Jenkintown has an on-campus museum dedicated to preserving Ukrainian artifacts and culture. The Ukrainian Heritage Museum is part of the Ukrainian Heritage Studies Center (UHSC), which was founded in 1977 to preserve, promote, and perpetuate Ukrainian culture and traditions through educational and cultural programs. In addition to a folk-art collection, the UHSC maintains an extensive Ukrainian library and archives as well as The Maria Mazur Gallery, an exquisite, handmade pysanky gallery. A pysanka is a Ukrainian Easter egg, decorated with traditional Ukrainian folk designs using a wax-resist method.

The museum is open to the public by appointment by calling 215-885-2360.

Ursinus College

The Philip and Muriel Berman Museum of Art - Collegeville

Notable art collector and former chairman of the Philadelphia Museum of Art, Philip Berman, graciously built a strong arts presence alongside his wife at his alma mater, Ursinus College. Ursinus is now home to the Berman Museum, an internationally-recognized, impressive collection of fine art. Focused collections include American 19th and 20th century paintings, prints, and sculpture, which are utilized to illustrate historical trends in art, literature, science and political and social history.

Sculpture Tour - Collegeville

The outdoor sculpture collection of the Berman Museum is comprised of more than 75 contemporary artworks spread over the grounds of Ursinus College, forming a unique perceptual and physical gateway to the campus at large. Much of the collection was gifted to the College by Berman and his wife, Muriel. The couple immensely valued the work of artist Lynn Chadwick and were proud to hold more works by her in their Ursinus collection than any other institution in North America.

Located in Blue Bell and Pottstown, MCCC's galleries showcase thought-provoking art exhibitions, lectures, and programs throughout the academic year. All are free and open to the public.

Lively Arts Series - Blue Bell

For over 30 years Montco's Lively Arts Series has brought an array of extraordinary talents to the heart of Montgomery County, allowing audiences to experience established and emerging artists alike. Whether you're a fan of theater, music, dance, film or comedy, the Lively Arts Series has something for you. Performances, along with the Film Series, are held in the Science Center Theater, an intimate venue located on the Central Campus in Blue Bell.

The Sound Recording Technology (SRT) Studio - Blue Bell

The SRT Studio is the only facility of its caliber open to the public for use in the region. The SRT Studio was designed by the Walters-Storyk Design Group – the best in the business, with design credits including Electric Lady Studios for Jimi Hendrix, Jay-Z Studios, Jazz at the Lincoln Center, and Alicia Keys' Oven Studios. The director of the Sound Recording Technology Program at the MCCC, David Ivory, is a gold and multi-platinum, Grammy-nominated engineer and producer, who from time to time offers master classes that are open to the public.

The Culinary Arts Institute - Lansdale

Whether you want to take a cooking class for fun or earn a culinary certificate or associate degree and start a career, The Culinary Arts Institute (CAI) has something for every taste and pursuit. Opened in 2013, the Lansdale-based CAI provides hands-on instruction in four modern, professional kitchens including a restaurant demonstration kitchen, pastry kitchen, and cold food kitchen or garde manger. MONTGOMERY COUNTY CONCERT VENUE
CELEBRATES FIVE YEAR ANNIVERSARY

The City of Brotherly Love and the greater Philadelphia area have been a haven for touring musicians for decades. And Montgomery County is no exception; here we have an abundance of unique venues that host incredible local and touring acts year-round.

Just three miles outside of Philadelphia lies Ardmore, one of the Main Line's most bustling towns and home to the legendary Ardmore Music Hall (AMH).

The venue officially opened under that name in 2013 and has since hosted acts ranging from George Clinton & P-Funk to The Hooters, Snarky Puppy, and Macy Gray.

In addition to the overall quality of the acts, the sound can reach every corner of the room thanks to the venue's outstanding acoustics.

Throughout the year, Ardmore welcomes many local and touring acts. A mix of high profile and up-and-coming artists all have equal opportunities to perform at AMH.

The Hall just celebrated its five-year anniversary on September 20th with roots and Americana-based newgrass jam band, Railroad Earth.

Following the Hall's Anniversary show, WXPB welcomed singer/songwriter Pete Yorn for his solo, acoustic You & Me Tour.

Yorn is best known for his gold-selling album *musicforthemorningafter*, released in 2001, featuring the singles "Life on a Chain," "Strange Condition," and "Just Another." Yorn has since released six other full-length EP's, including *musicforthemorningafter's* follow-ups, *Day I Forgot* (2003) and *Nightcrawler* (2006).

AMH also provides bands with a place for regularly scheduled shows. Cover bands such as Splintered Sunlight, a Grateful Dead tribute band based out of Philadelphia, have set up multiple shows throughout the remainder of 2018.

There are plenty of opportunities to catch a glimpse of the stage. AMH has three different areas for audiences to watch a performance: standing room, general admission seating, and a second-story balcony. Both floors feature individual bars, so you can grab a drink anywhere inside.

Ardmore Music Hall offers its patrons so much more than just a space to see a show. It is a place where the magic of music radiates from every corner and stays with audiences long after the final song.

BRYN MAWR FILM INSTITUTE

It could have been renamed “The Phoenix,” seeing how the Bryn Mawr Film Institute (BMFI) has risen from near extinction to become a vibrant film and educational center.

Originally built as The Seville in 1926, the once grand movie palace boasted a sky-lit atrium, ornate chandeliers, and detailed plasterwork that invited movie-goers to enjoy an immersive viewing experience. But by the 1950s, the renamed Bryn Mawr Theater had lost much of its luster. The atrium sky light was darkened by acoustic tiles, the original marquee was replaced and, in 1978, the grand auditorium was twinned. In the 1990s, multiplexes were luring away patrons and the Bryn Mawr continued its downward skid – sticky floors, poor projection, and leaky ceilings included. By 2001, the theater was bankrupt.

That’s when Juliet Goodfriend, a Main Line local and Bryn Mawr College trustee, heard that the venerable old theater was about to be sold and gutted for a gym franchise. She spearheaded a fundraising campaign to save it.

“She decided to learn about the movie business and got a nonprofit loan. She did what someone with a passion will do,” says Executive Director Samuel Scott of Bryn Mawr, the former BMFI Chair of the Board of Directors who assumed Goodfriend’s spot in 2017 when the two switched

roles. Goodfriend’s mission for the renamed Bryn Mawr Film Institute was to restore the building and launch educational programming to get grant funding.

In varying phases over more than a decade, the lobby was refurbished, new equipment was installed, HVAC and electrical systems were modernized, both theaters were renovated, and a new, vintage-style marquee glowed like a beacon along Lancaster Avenue. The atrium skylight was restored, bathing the space in natural light. An elevator and classrooms were added as well as two more screening rooms.

When digital movies became mandatory for theaters by 2013, it spelled doom for many small, independent theaters nationwide. The cost to switch from 35 mm projectors to ones equipped for the new VHS-sized Digital Cinema Packages or DCPs ran between \$80,000 and \$150,000 per screen.

Goodfriend and the board launched the “Donate for Digital” campaign and members, organizations, and even actor

Sir Ben Kingsley pitched in to raise the \$500,000 needed for BMFI’s new digital technology. The new projectors are adjacent to a 35 mm one so that original films can still be run.

Today, the theater is thriving, with over 9,000 members. “We are the leading suburban, nonprofit movie theater in the country,” says Scott from a second-floor meeting space overlooking the atrium. “We draw from many ZIP Codes. A huge part of what we do is our educational programs.”

What you won’t find at BMFI are most multiplex blockbusters. What you will find are first-run, independent, and alternative films that draw some 4,000 patrons per week for the screenings as well as for the range of unique, educational programs and special film/food/drink/travel events.

“Our mission is two-fold,” says Scott, a retired executive with a film background. “We present a great venue to show these films of merit and the other part is [building] community.”

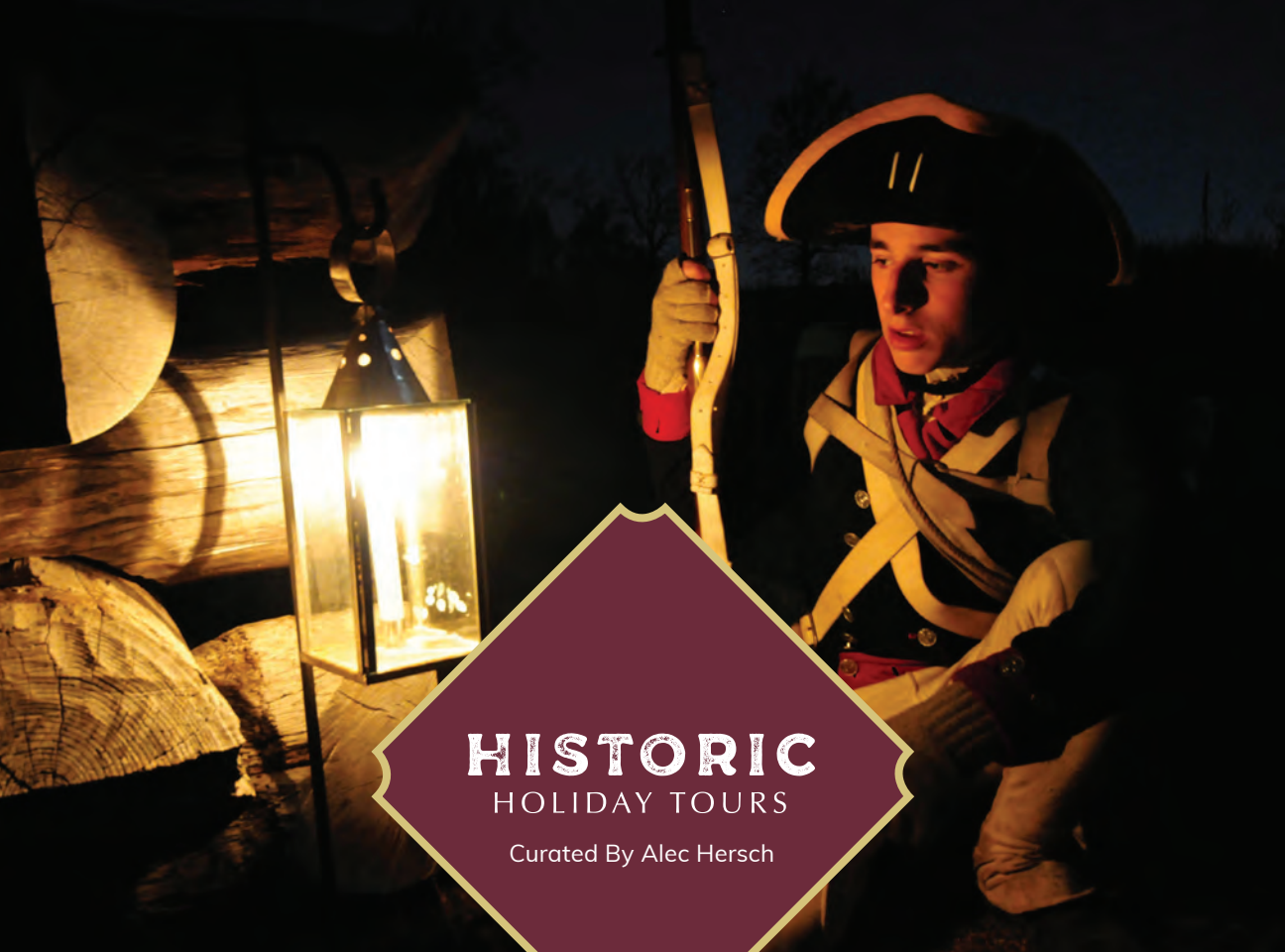
Film buffs in Montgomery County are lucky to have the BMFI, as well as similar art houses like the Ambler and the Hiway theaters. Membership discounts are reciprocal at the other theaters, Scott says.

“Movies are in a real state of flux right now, especially among younger audiences,” Scott readily admits of changing screening habits that has viewers staying home to watch films or viewing them on personal devices. But, he adds, “people still enjoy getting together in the dark to cry together, to laugh together. That shared experience is what dictates our mission.”

Like the magical Phoenix, BMFI will continue rising above challenges in the film industry. For the enthusiastic Scott, his staff, and the board, “it’s a labor of love.”

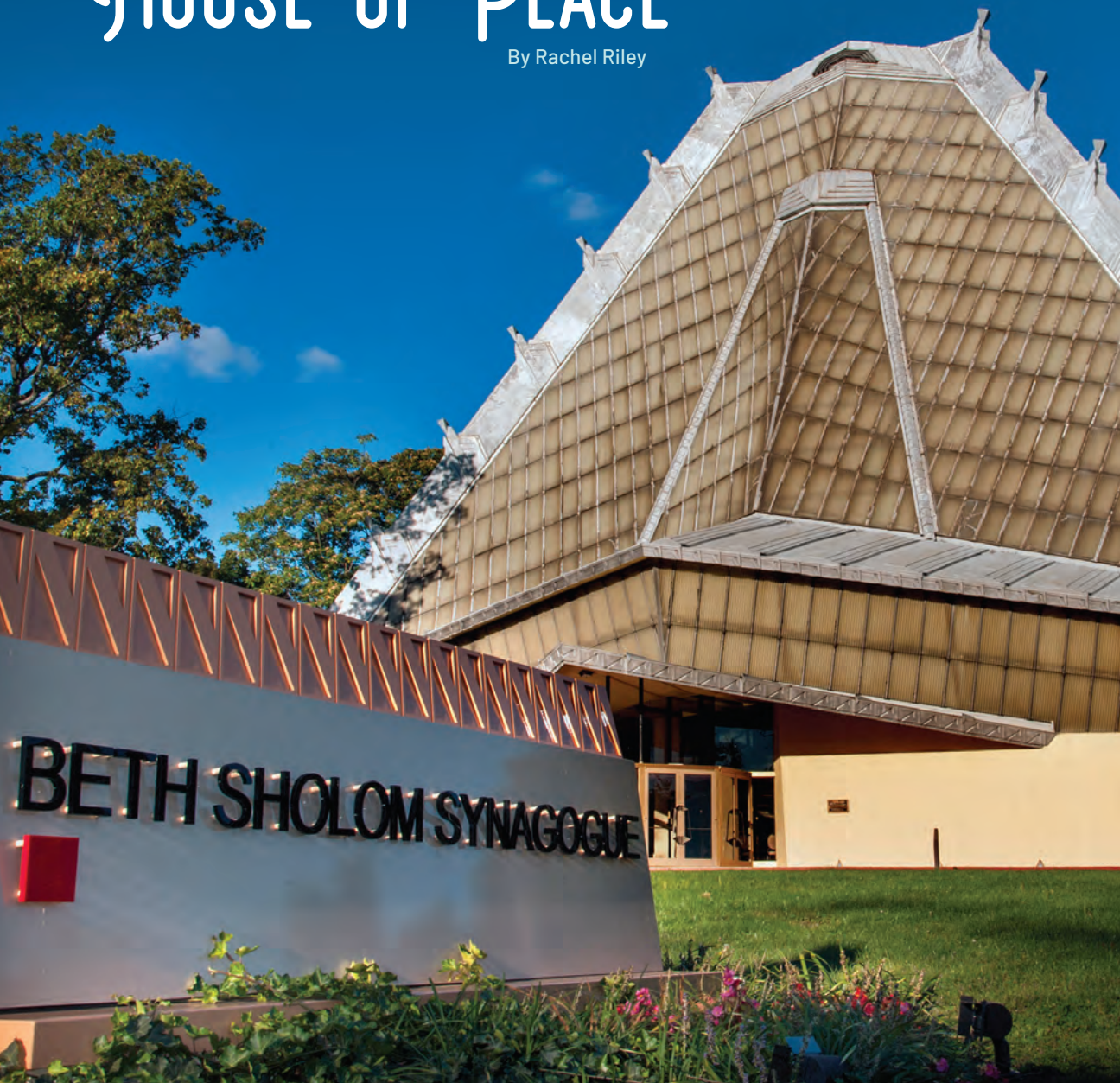

DISCOVER MONTCO'S HOUSE OF PEACE

Considered by critics to be the "most expressive" design in the career of famed American architect Frank Lloyd Wright, the iconic Beth Sholom Synagogue in Elkins Park is not only a National Historic Landmark, but also a culmination of the architect's vision and continued evolution.

Of the more than 1,000 structures Wright planned over 70 years, the place of worship with an active congregation on Old York Road is the only synagogue he designed.

Built in 1954, Beth Sholom is Hebrew for "House of Peace," and an important work of American architecture. That's why people from all over the United States and 68 countries have passed through its doors.

Visitors can take a guided tour led by volunteer docents several days a week, watch a documentary film about the building, and explore the visitor center with a multitude of exhibits about the building, architect, and congregation.

When Rabbi Mortimer J. Cohen approached Wright in 1953 to create the synagogue, Wright wanted to give congregants the sensation that they were resting in the hands of God.

In fact, each element of Wright's design was carefully crafted with a contemporary approach to Jewish faith, history, and religious practice. The Mayan Revival style building is layered with symbolism from the mountain-like silhouette suggesting the ascent to Mount Sinai, to representations of Menorahs, and even the stone tablets given to Moses.

Beth Sholom's more than 1,000 seats are horseshoe-shaped on a gentle slope for the best view. Suspended from a 160-ton steel tripod frame, the main structure creates an open space, free from internal supports. The pyramidal roof consists of a double layer of sanded white glass that fills the inside with natural light, day or night.

Dedicated in September 1959, five months after Wright's death, his design has been described as a distinctively American architectural idiom for a Jewish house of worship.

Abington Art Center – Alverthorpe Manor Jenkintown

Cairnwood Estate – Bryn Athyn Historic District Bryn Athyn

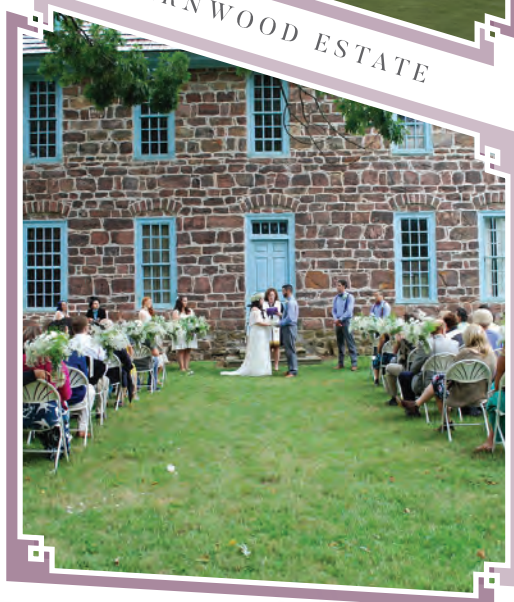
Meticulously detailed, Cairnwood Estate was constructed in the Gilded Age, blending Roman architecture with French Renaissance design. Completed in 1895, this French chateau-esque estate will give anyone that fairytale feeling. From expansive lawns, flowering gardens, grand staircases, and view-filled balconies, any couple will have a picturesque celebration. Tour Cairnwood during their weekly open house on Wednesday evenings from 6pm-8pm.

Graeme Park Horsham

The colonial home at Graeme Park was constructed in 1722 for Provincial Governor of Pennsylvania Sir William Keith and is now known as The Keith House. With natural springs and expansive greens, the park is fit for any wedding style. Whether you're walking down the aisle in heels or sandals the 42 acres of grounds, the Keith House, and the 1830s barn create an historic and unique scene.

Highlands Mansion & Gardens Fort Washington

Built in 1796, The Highlands is a two-century old Georgian-style mansion featuring 15-foot ceilings, a two-acre formal garden, and is surrounded by 44 acres of rolling hills. The historic site can accommodate 120-150 people for an indoor or outdoor ceremony and reception. The land has a bank barn, springhouse, greenhouse, smoke house, and a Gothic gardener's cottage perfect for any wedding photoshoot.

John James Audubon Center at Mill Grove Audubon

Surrounded by 175 acres of stunning natural views, the John James Audubon Center at Mill Grove makes for a one-of-a-kind wedding venue. Stroll through the apple orchard and sweeping meadows to find the picture-perfect background of your dreams. Enjoy a reception within the 18th-century barn house or the all-wood, free-spirited pavilion, fit for either a dinner for 50 guests or a reception for 250. Fun fact: this was the first American home of renowned artist, author, and naturalist, John James Audubon.

Normandy Farm Hotel & Conference Center Blue Bell

Dance under the cathedral ceilings of Normandy Farm in Blue Bell. The venue's historic roots establish a luxurious, rustic feeling. With a white interior and exposed wood highlights, celebrate with up to 400 guests. The enchanting location will transport you into a storybook as you stroll through the manicured grounds, secluded outdoor terraces, and dine on exceptional cuisine created by renowned chefs. There's even a contemporary art gallery in the resort's conference center.
