The Valley Forge Tourism & Convention Board (VFTCB) will be collecting monetary donations for the sixth annual Valley Forge Freedom from Hunger Food Drive from September 1-30. Due to COVID-19, this year's drive will take place solely online.

The VFTCB is again partnering with the MontCo Anti-Hunger Network (MAHN) – a coalition of hunger relief organizations working together to make healthy foods available to all communities in Montgomery County.

- Donations benefit MAHN and its mission to help feed the less fortunate in Montgomery County.
- Each year, the goal has increased for donations
- Since the Freedom from Hunger Food Drive began in 2015, the VFTCB has collected more 25,000 pounds of food to feed the hungry in Montgomery County.
- The 2020 goal is 15,000 pounds of food to get to a lifetime goal of 40,000.
