General job description

The Encampment Store (TES) at Valley Forge National Historical Park is a non-profit partner of the National Park Service. POSITION DESCRIPTION

Trolley Tour Driver

This hourly paid position of Trolley Driver is located within Valley Forge National Historical Park and reports to the management of The Encampment Store. The individual filling this position will be responsible for driving and maintaining the trolley, owned by The Encampment Store.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Daily General Operations

Trolley Tour

- picking up the trolley each morning of trolley tour operations from the Park's maintenance area;
- reporting to the Visitors Center no later than 10:30 a.m. with trolley ready to host visitors;
- returning the trolley at the conclusion of each day of trolley tour operations to the Park's maintenance area;
- ensuring the trolley is stored in a manner which ensures the safety of the trolley and it's interior;
- aid in seating of ADA to include removal of seat to accommodate wheelchair(s)
- driving the trolley in a safe and responsible manner, abiding by all road rules (posted and unposted) and working with the tour guide in maintaining a safe speed to allow for the utmost safety of all guides and passengers;
- maintain ongoing communications with the tour guides to ensure the timing of all tours fall within the timeframes as defined;
- working in unison with tour guides to provide an excellent experience for all visitors;
- maintaining the highest level of customer service to all visitors to the park;
- driver will not give tours of the park.

General Trolley Maintenance

- maintain cleanliness of trolley to include: daily sweeping of the floor, daily trash removal, ensuring windows are closed/roll-up is down at the conclusion of each day;
- Complete sanitizing of trolley between tours;
- maintaining gasoline levels to ensure trolley is ready to be used each day;
- managing basic trolley mechanical upkeep, i.e. tire pressure, windshield washer fluid, oil, fuel, etc;
- reporting of any trolley and/or road issues that may cause dangerous conditions for the trolley driver/guides/guests or the trolley to Encampment Store manager(s).

Park Knowledge – Helpful but not essential

- have knowledge of and ability to answer questions about elementary information about Valley Forge National Historical Park and the surrounding area;
- understanding of the general history of Valley Forge National Historical Park and its history.

• Current Class B-CDL certification

- Passenger Endorsement certification
- Completion and passing of a background check (a plus if PA Department of Education background check has already been completed)
- Knowledge of trolleys/buses and ability to drive them
- Ability to lift 50 lbs.
- 20/20 vision or corrected to 20/20 vision
- Positive attitude
- Enjoy working with the public
- Ability to work weekends and holidays
- Ability to sit for extended periods of time
- Ability to work during summer weather conditions
- Knowledge of the American Revolution is a plus but not essential!
