For something special in Virginia Beach, unique experiences await that showcase the area's distinct character and laid-back vibes. Make your way along the Virginia Beach Beer Trail and sample amazing craft beers from local breweries or walk the colorful Mural Tour in the artsy ViBe Creative District to check out eye-catching outdoor artwork. For a memorable culinary experience, savor a taste of freshly picked fruit from a nearby farm or dine on flavorful oysters straight from the sea. No matter your interests, there are countless ways to enjoy this favorite beach destination.

OUTDOOR ADVENTURES

A haven for outdoor enthusiasts, Virginia Beach offers a scenic blend of inland waterways, nature parks, hiking trails, bike paths, and cozy campgrounds. Among popular parks to explore is First Landing State Park, the most-visited state park in Virginia, where you can explore miles of lush trails and pristine beaches on Chesapeake Bay. For an immersive outdoor experience, the Back Bay National Wildlife Refuge is ideal for birdwatching and other wildlife spotting. And don't miss False Cape State Park, with six miles of unspoiled beach and trails for kayaking, hiking, and biking amid a pristine coastal habitat.

BEST BEACHES

Boasting the longest pleasure beach in the world, Virginia Beach is a vibrant coastal community that's ideally situated where the Chesapeake Bay meets the Atlantic Ocean. Its 35 miles of shoreline offer relaxing beach days, water sports and fishing trips. Choose from the Oceanfront, complete with hotels, dining, and entertainment along the lively 3-mile-long Boardwalk. Sandbridge Beach is a secluded beach hideaway perfect for enjoying nature, and Chesapeake Bay, or Chic's Beach as it's known locally, provides calm waters for swimming and dolphin spotting.
