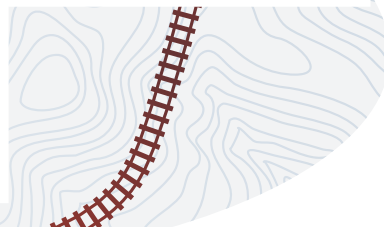

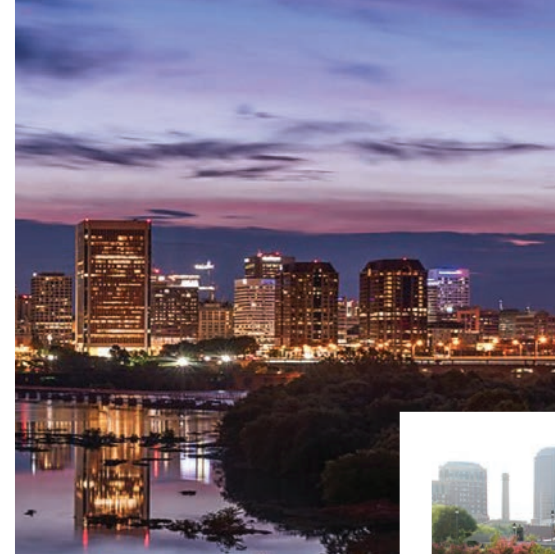

### TOP ATTRACTIONS

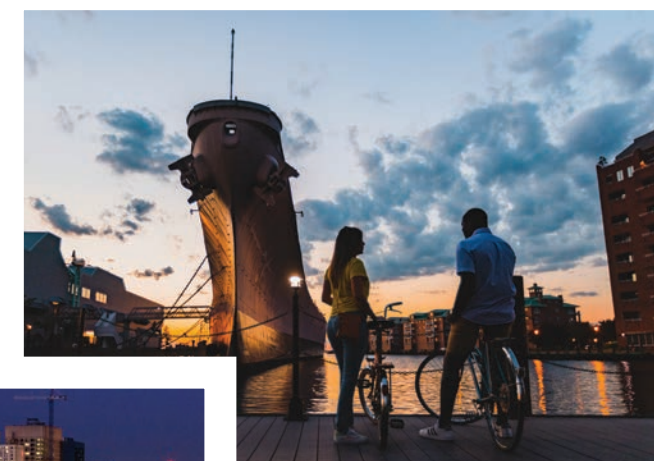
- The James River—urban white water rafting
