

VIRGINIA BEACH BOARDWALK

The Virginia Beach Boardwalk, at the Oceanfront, is a 28-foot wide marvel that stretches three miles from 2nd to 40th Street and features a separate bike path, ideal for strolling, rollerblading and biking. Entertainment is offered nightly during the summer months and four oceanfront stages at 7th, 17th, and 24th and 31st Streets provide live musical acts. Along the boardwalk, there's a variety of quaint outdoor restaurants and vendors offering bike and surrey rentals. Nautical sculptures adorn many of the side streets which lead to Atlantic Avenue. While there, don't forget to swing by and see King Neptune - a twenty-four foot, twelve-ton bronze statue that stands at the gateway to Neptune Festival Park on 31st Street. This is perhaps one of the most popular photo opportunities in the resort area.

RIDE TO BREAKFAST

(0.7 miles, about 8 minutes)

1. Depart from your hotel on the boardwalk and ride on the bike path heading south.
2. Continue on to Rudee Loop and cross Pacific Avenue at 4th Street.
3. Bike under the bridge and enjoy King Neptune's Mural.
4. Follow bike path and grab breakfast at one of our local restaurants (Big Sam, Rudee's or Rockefeller's Restaurant).

Big Sam's is a quaint, casual restaurant right on Rudee Inlet next to the Virginia Beach Fishing Center. They specialize in seafood, but breakfast specials are available before 9 am.

RIDE TO SEASHORE CATHEDRAL MURAL AND NEW REALM BREWING

(4.9 miles, about 26 minutes)

1. Head back east on Winton-Salem and cross Pacific Avenue.
2. Take a right on Pacific Avenue and bike on the multi-use path over Rudee Inlet Bridge.
3. Take a right after the bridge, at the light using the cross path and continue biking on the multi-use path on General Booth (stop to see the Seashore Cathedral Mural).
4. Continue on General Booth until the intersection of Oceana Blvd.
5. Use the cross path on your left and continue biking on the east side of General Booth where the boardwalk is wider.
6. Cross General Booth at the intersection of Hubbel and continue biking on the west side of General Booth where the sidewalk is wider. New Realm Brewery will be located on your right.

RIDE TO SEASHORE CATHEDRAL MURAL AND NEW REALM BREWING

(4.9 miles, about 26 minutes)

1. Head back east on Winton-Salem and cross Pacific Avenue.
2. Take a right on Pacific Avenue and bike on the multi-use path over Rudee Inlet Bridge.
3. Take a right after the bridge, at the light using the cross path and continue biking on the multi-use path on General Booth (stop to see the Seashore Cathedral Mural).
4. Continue on General Booth until the intersection of Oceana Blvd.
5. Use the cross path on your left and continue biking on the east side of General Booth where the boardwalk is wider.
6. Cross General Booth at the intersection of Hubbel and continue biking on the west side of General Booth where the sidewalk is wider. New Realm Brewery will be located on your right.

RIDE TO SEASHORE CATHEDRAL MURAL AND NEW REALM BREWING

(4.9 miles, about 26 minutes)

1. Head back east on Winton-Salem and cross Pacific Avenue.

2. Take a right on Pacific Avenue and bike on the multi-use path over Rudee Inlet Bridge.

3. Take a right after the bridge, at the light using the cross path and continue biking on the multi-use path on General Booth (stop to see the Seashore Cathedral Mural).

4. Continue on General Booth until the intersection of Oceana Blvd.

5. Use the cross path on your left and continue biking on the east side of General Booth where the boardwalk is wider.

6. Cross General Booth at the intersection of Hubbel and continue biking on the west side of General Booth where the sidewalk is wider. New Realm Brewery will be located on your right.

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SEASHORE CATHEDRAL MURAL

Stop on your way to New Realm Brewing to see Italian street artist, Pepe Gaka's, "Seashore Cathedral" mural. Located along the Oceanfront's Rudee Inlet, the work is a series of murals that utilize his geometric style to flawlessly create the impression of stained glass under the Rudee Inlet Bridge. Each column features detailed vignettes that represent different aspects of the area that make Virginia Beach unique, including several scenes representing our coastal culture.

CONTINUE RIDING TO NEW REALM BREWING

1. Continue biking on the multi-use path on General Booth.
2. Continue on General Booth until the intersection of Oceana Blvd.
3. Use the cross path on your left and continue biking on the east side of General Booth where the boardwalk is wider.
4. Cross General Booth at the intersection of Hubbel and continue biking on the west side of General Booth where the sidewalk is wider. New Realm Brewery will be located on your right.

Head outside to the 44,000 sq. ft. outdoor beer garden to enjoy lawn games, bocce ball, fire pits, live music and an outdoor bar which allows quick access to all your New Realm favorites on draft.

RIDE TO YOUNG VETERANS BREWING COMPANY AND REAVER BEACH BREWING CO.

(3.6 miles, about 20 minutes)

1. Head back on General Booth.
2. Take a right on London Bridge.
3. Take a left on Dam Neck.
4. Take a right on Horse Pasture for a potential stop at Young Veterans Brewing Company.
5. Otherwise continue onto Dam Neck and take a right on Taylor Farm Road for a stop at Beaver Beach Brewing Company.

RIDE TO BACK BAY BREWING CO., ZEKE'S & GINGO'S TAQUERIA

(8.5 miles, about 45 minutes)

1. Head back on Dam Neck where you will take a left onto it.
2. Cross General Booth and take a left to ride on the east side of General Booth.
3. At the intersection of Oceana Blvd., cross General Booth and continue biking on the west side of General Booth.
4. Take a left at Birdneck Road.
5. Cross Norfolk Avenue and take a left on Norfolk Avenue's multi-use path.
6. Potential stop at Zeke's VB for a green juice, poke bowl or some healthy treats, Back Bay Brewing Company for a cold brew or Gingo's Taqueria for some traditional Mexican and Tex Mex food.

1. Head back on Dam Neck where you will take a left onto it.
2. Cross General Booth and take a left to ride on the east side of General Booth.
3. At the intersection of Oceana Blvd., cross General Booth and continue biking on the west side of General Booth.
4. Take a left at Birdneck Road.
5. Cross Norfolk Avenue and take a left on Norfolk Avenue's multi-use path.
6. Potential stop at Zeke's VB for a green juice, poke bowl or some healthy treats, Back Bay Brewing Company for a cold brew or Gingo's Taqueria for some traditional Mexican and Tex Mex food.

Back Bay's False Cape Ale is a full bodied red ale. With a dark copper color and well rounded malt base; a bit sweet, with a lightly hopped tea-like flavor, and an even, dextrinous body. False Cape Ale is easy to please. Look for well-rounded and balanced flavors and a pleasant, toasted malt character. A drying finish comes from Cascade dry-hopping.

RIDE TO VIBE CREATIVE DISTRICT

(0.8 miles, about 7 minutes)

1. Hop back on Norfolk avenue heading west.
2. Take a right on Parks Avenue.
3. Take a right on Virginia Beach Boulevard.
4. Take a left on Cypress Avenue and bike through the ViBe Creative District and enjoy murals, local artisans and multiple coffee shops and locally owned restaurants.

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4. Take a left on Cypress Avenue and bike through the ViBe Creative District and enjoy murals, local artisans and multiple coffee shops and locally owned restaurants.

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
RIDE BACK TO THE BOARDWALK

VIBE CREATIVE DISTRICT
