- MUNICIPAL PARKING GARAGES:**
Oceanfront: 9th St. between Atlantic and Pacific Ave., 25th St. between Pacific and Arctic Ave., 30th St. between Atlantic and Pacific Ave.
- TOWN CENTER PARKING:**
FREE parking in garages and on-street spaces; however, some have a 15-minute to two-hour time restriction (strictly enforced).
- Hop on the VB Wave,** a seasonal hybrid-electric trolley, to travel along Atlantic Avenue or pick up the connecting route south to the Virginia Aquarium and nearby campgrounds or north to First Landing State Park.
