Letter From The Executive Director

It is hard to believe that 2019 is almost here and the Von Braun Center is celebrating the completion of another year! I am very proud to share in 2018 I celebrated my 40th year with the Von Braun Center. As the saying goes...time flies when you are having fun!

Our team at the Von Braun Center continues to perform at an exceedingly high level. This past year we hosted over 500 events with over 775,000 patrons walking through the doors. We are very thankful for our annual events, such as, AUSA Global Force Symposium, Space & Missile Defense Symposium, International Symposium on Child Abuse, Huntsville Hospital Foundation, Huntsville Havoc, NEACA Craft Show, Huntsville Symphony Orchestra Guild Debutante Ball and many, many more. It is for you, "our customer", that we continue to strive to provide an exceptional experience and a successful event. Thank you!

One particular event stands out as being the one that set the pace for this year - hosting the President of the United States. I received a call from Madison County Commission Chairman Dale Strong, which was immediately followed by a representative of the White House. I was told President Donald Trump was planning a trip to Huntsville and they wanted to use Propst Arena to hold a political rally. I must admit it was very surreal receiving a call from the White House. We had four days to strategically plan for the President to attend and speak at a political rally for Senator Luther Strange. Although the White House Advance Team was great to work with - extremely detailed and organized - this was the biggest challenge of the year for our staff. How often do you have the opportunity to host a sitting President? That evening at approximately 6:30 P.M. I was given the opportunity to greet the President and share with him the news of a record-breaking crowd.

This year the Von Braun Center was host to the "Iron Bowl of Gymnastics" when both nationally ranked University of Alabama and Auburn University gymnastics teams competed in the "Elevate the Stage" podium-style competition. We also welcomed back the Rocket City Classic with the University of Alabama competing against Mercer University along with the

University of Alabama in Huntsville competing against Shorter University in a sold-out Propst Arena.

The Von Braun Center produces its own "Signature" events and I'm proud to say that each event continues to grow and evolve each year. In its 8th year the **Heads-n-Tails Crawfish Boil** is still going strong and bringing a crowd to enjoy good food and music. Nominated as "Downtown Event of the Year" the 2nd Annual **Von Brewski Beer Festival** brought in over 170 beers brewed by 60+ breweries from the around the world and the 5th annual **Family Fun Festival & Expo** partnered with Free2Teach with the inaugural "Pennies2Teach" competition.

The future is an exciting time for the VBC! Construction has begun on the new 1,200 seat music hall and restaurant with a roof top bar. It's business as usual! All events will go on as planned during construction, therefore we expect this project will keep us extremely busy and challenged. We anticipate this to be a 14-month project and plan to open the new music hall and restaurant in the last quarter of 2019. We have so much work to do in preparation of the grand opening!

The next big expansion project is the addition of the new multipurpose ballroom, meeting rooms, a new kitchen and renovation of the North Hall. This project is still in the design phase with plans to break ground in 2020-21 with a projected timeline of approximately two years for completion.

It is a wonderful time to be part of Huntsville and the Von Braun Center. I would like to take this opportunity to say thank you to our board of control, mayor, city council, city leaders, partners, sponsors, clients and patrons. We could not do what we do without you!




The Von Braun Center diverted 212.15 tons or 424,301 lbs. of trash from the local landfill. The average diversion rate for the year was 63.29%. This included:

- Paper, Plastic, Aluminum Cans, and Cardboard –
 61,060 lbs. or 30.53 tons
- Electronic Waste 1,323 lbs.
- Spent Fluorescent Lamps 832

In regards to energy consumption, we continue to make improvements to the facility to improve those results. Last year we reduced our Energy Utilization Index by approximately 10.82%. We have more energy conservation projects slated for the upcoming year.
