







LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

It's a great time to live, work and play in this fantastic, electric, little-big city we call home – *Huntsville, Alabama*. So many great things are happening and I'm excited to be a part of the change and future growth.

The Von Braun Center (VBC) is a great venue for hosting a variety of events. This past fiscal year we hosted over 550 events with over 800,000 people walking through our doors. To highlight a few of our events from 2017 we will start with our two largest conferences. AUSA Global Force Symposium returned for the 4th consecutive year and the Space & Missile Defense Symposium returned for the 17th consecutive year. We are very thankful to have the opportunity to work with both AUSA and SMD.

This year the VBC hosted the **Small Market Meetings Conference**, which is the industry's first conference designed specifically for meeting professionals who seek smaller destinations and venues. The impact of this conference will benefit Huntsville for many years. We also hosted **TBEX North America** in May – the largest conference and networking event for travel bloggers. *Thank you to the Huntsville/Madison County Convention & Visitors Bureau for making it possible.*

The VBC hosted one of the final shows of the **Ringling Brothers** and Barnum & Bailey Circus before its end in 2017. The show was led by the first-ever female ringmaster and featured talented parkour runners, BMX-riders, Danquir High Wire Troupe, the Human Cannon Ball and of course the animals. We, like many of you, were very sad to hear of its closing.

Basketball came to the VBC this year by way of the Rocket City Classic. The **Crimson Tide** played Arkansas State in a sold out Propst Arena. We are already looking forward to next year!

Another new event this year was the **Von Brewski Beer Festival**. The winter beer festival was part of Huntsville's Beer Week and brought in over 1,500 beer enthusiasts to sample beer not only from Huntsville brewers but from brewers all over the country. The date is already set for next year and we are planning for an even bigger and better event!

As many of you may know, the VBC is also home to two hockey teams. The **University of Alabama Huntsville Chargers** have been playing hockey at the VBC for 35 plus years. We are proud to have UAH as one of our premier partners. The **Huntsville HAVOC** is a professional hockey team playing in the SPHL. We have an outstanding partnership with the HAVOC and I believe we are in our 15th year. *Thank you to Huntsville's hockey community*.

Another great honor the VBC experienced this year was hosting the **President of the United States**. *It's not every day you have a sitting President visit your venue!* Our team, along with the help of some political leaders, Senator Luther Strange's office, White House staff and the City of Huntsville we were able to successfully host the President of the United States with only four days of planning and lots of hard work. It was a privilege and an honor to be involved, not only for me, but for the entire staff. I was given the opportunity to greet the President and share with him the news of a record breaking crowd.

Now to share exciting news about the future of the VBC... we are expanding!!! The Huntsville City Council approved a hotel tax increase of 2% plus \$1 per room night in July. The hotel tax increase was earmarked for tourism, with \$42 million going toward the expansion and renovation of the VBC.

The first phase of the expansion is a **new music hall** located at the corner of Clinton Avenue and Monroe Street and plans are to break ground in early spring of 2018. The new music hall with an estimated capacity of 1,200 will have a VBC operated food & beverage component. There will also be a beautiful roof top bar with a great view of downtown. *We are expecting this to be the place to be before and after events*!!!

The second phase of the expansion is the addition of a new state of the art **35,000 square foot ballroom**, 14,000 square feet of multi-purpose meeting rooms, a concourse that will seamlessly connect to the existing South Hall concourse and an underground parking garage that will connect to our current garage. The new ballroom will be the largest most vibrant state of the art room of its kind in Huntsville and possibly in the state. We anticipate to break ground in 2019-2020. When the expansion is completed North Hall will receive a much needed and long overdue renovation. *I invite you to visit our website for more information on the expansion*.

We are so excited about the expansion and renovation projects. Consultant studies by two different companies indicate the expansion will lead to increased demand and more event activity with a significant economic impact for Huntsville. We believe our investment for the future will entice a convention center hotel development. We strongly believe a convention center hotel is needed and we would like to see one located on Clinton Avenue adjoining the VBC.

I would like to say a special thank you to the **staff of the VBC**. Our staff gets the job done and I'm extremely proud of them. We have 65 full time and several hundred part-time employees that either work directly for the VBC or with a service contractor. The Senior Management Team is made up of 8 members (myself included) with over 200 combined years of service among us.

Of course, our number one asset is **YOU**, our patrons. *Thank you for a great year and we look forward to the upcoming new year.*


The VBC Management Team is committed to facilitating and promoting the vision of Huntsville.



On July 13, 2017 the Huntsville City Council approved the funding necessary for the Von Braun Center to expand. The funding will be generated by a 2% lodging tax and \$1 per room night surcharge. The expansion brings new business opportunity for the Von Braun Center, more entertainment to the patrons of Huntsville, as well as a polished fresh look to downtown Huntsville. The additional 113,000 square feet expansion will provide to the already 483,000 square foot VBC will attract larger conferences as well as provide needed additional space and amenities for current clients and patrons. The project will be completed in two phases. The first phase will be the Music Hall and Food & Beverage component. The second will be the convention space and necessary renovations. Construction for the Music Hall is to start Spring of 2018. The convention space and renovations are expected to begin within two years. This component will include an additional ballroom/multi-purpose space, more meeting rooms, a large kitchen equipped for serving a high number of plated meals, additional parking and needed renovations to the existing facility.



The 2017-18 season of **Huntsville Havoc** looks to continue the tradition of the fast-paced, hard-hitting, family entertainment. The 14th season will not disappoint as head coach Glenn Detulleo and the team take on SPHL rivals Fayetteville Marksmen, Knoxville Ice Bears, Evansville Thunderbolts, Mississippi RiverKings, Pensacola Ice Flyers, Peoria Rivermen, Macon Mayhem, Roanoke Rail Yard Dogs and the Birmingham Bulls. With two back to back seasons of breaking the league attendance record, can the Havoc make it 3 years in a row of record setting attendance?



The University of Alabama in Huntsville hockey team is looking forward to the fifth season in the prestigious Western Collegiate Hockey Association. The Chargers will welcome seven schools to the Von Braun Center for the upcoming season with featured promotions and giveaways at each home game.


The Von Braun Center diverted 162.12 tons or 324,230 lbs. of trash from the local landfill by transporting our trash to the Waste to Energy facility via our waste provider Republic Services. By sending our trash to the Waste to Energy facility, we were able to achieve an average diversion rate of 79.4% for the year.

Energy Consumption Reduction Goal


