EXECUTIVE/PERSONNEL COMMITTEE MEETING AGENDA – OPEN SESSION Thursday, December 8, 2022 | 10:30AM Washburn County Visitor Center | 122 N. River Street | Spooner, WI 54801

- 1. Meeting was called to order at 10:34AM by Sue Churchill
- 2. Roll Call: Sue Churchill, Nikki Janisin, Joe McGrath, Jill Dunlavy, Kaitlin Hanson, Lindsay Barnes
- 3. **Approve Current Agenda:** Dunlavy made a motion to approve the agenda as written, seconded by McGrath. Motion carried.
- 4. **Employee Reviews:** All reviews have been completed and both full-time staff members are eligible for raises. Kaitlin reviewed the goals set for both team members for 2023. McGrath asked Room Tax Collection to be added as a goal for the Executive Director for 2023.
- 5. Employee Benefits: Dunlavy made a motion to forward the following recommendation to WCTA Board of Directors, to approve the bronze plan presented by Spencer Miller of Holden Insurance and create a Health Savings Account with contributions from Washburn County Tourism Association (WCTA) of \$2,000 annually per qualified employee, with a 70%, 30% split on monthly premiums WCTA to cover 70%, 30% covered by the employee. Employees to be eligible for this benefit pending their 90 Day review. Seconded by McGrath. Motion carried.
- 6. Dunlavy made a motion to convene is closed session pursuant to 18.95 (1) (C), WI statutes, which if discussed in public would likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person, referred to in such data, seconded by Janisin. Motion carried.
- Janisin made a motion to reconvene in open session and act on items from closed session, seconded by Dunlavy. Motion carried.
 - a. Dunlavy made a motion to increase Kaitlin's annual salary by \$750 per her three-month review and approve two additional days of PTO per her 2022 annual review. Seconded by McGrath. Motion carried.
 - b. Dunlavy made a motion to increase Lindsay's annual salary by \$500 per her three-month review. Seconded by McGrath. Motion carried.
 - c. Dunlavy made a motion to give Kaitlin a \$200 end of year 'Thank You' gift and to give Lindsay a \$50 end of year 'Thank You' gift, all in Spooner Chamber Dollars. Seconded by Janisin. Motion carried.
- 8. Motion to adjourn was made by Dunlavy, seconded by McGrath. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 12:07PM
