Washington County is home to 23 historic covered bridges, the second most of any county in Pennsylvania. To help locate these charming icons of our past, the following three tours have been compiled according to the abundance and proximity of each covered bridge. Plan a single outing or multiple excursions with these directions, which are based upon moderate road conditions and may not be the most direct routes. Please know that many of these bridges are located on very narrow roads and in remote settings. Pack a lunch, bring a camera, and fuel up your vehicle to enjoy this scenic scavenger hunt throughout the beautiful countryside. Travel at your own risk.\*

## THE SOUTHWEST TOUR

### 1 Hughes Bridge

From Washington, PA – approx. 10 mi: Take I-79 South to Exit 23. At stop sign, turn left on Ten Mile Rd and travel underneath I-79. Make first left on Montgomery Run Rd towards Amwell Twp Park. Bridge on right at .4 mile.

## FACTS TO KEEP YOU COVERED

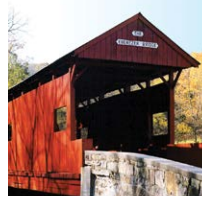
- The primary reason for covering bridges was to protect the structure from the environment.
- All of these covered bridges were listed on the National Register of Historic Places on June 22, 1979.
- Pennsylvania has 197 covered bridges still standing statewide.
- Approximately 20 Kingpost truss covered bridges still stand in the United States, including eight in Washington County.
- The exterior of all but one of Washington County's 23 covered bridges are painted red, taken from a formula derived from a natural insect-proof oxide in the local soil.

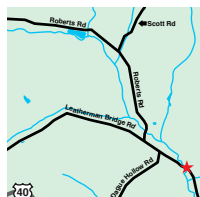

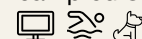

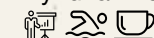
