WASHINGTON WILD THINGS CELEBRATE 20TH ANNIVERSARY SEASON

Set to host 2022 Frontier League All-Star Game

As baseball fans in Washington County, we have a lot to be excited about looking forward, and a lot to be thankful for looking back. After all, baseball is in our DNA, and this season is shaping up to be one for the ages.

Visible from Interstate 70, Wild Things Park is home to the Washington Wild Things, a professional baseball team that plays in the MLB-partnered Frontier League. In 2022, the Wild Things are celebrating their 20th season of baseball in the longest-running independent baseball league in history with a host of celebrations, fun and great baseball.

You will not want to miss opening night, Friday, May 13. The celebration kicks off with a pre-game ceremony as the organization welcomes back some of the dignitaries and executives that were on the field on Opening Night of the 2002 season. Former Director of Baseball Operations and Pittsburgh Pirates pitcher Kent Tekulve will be in attendance.

Since that inaugural season in 2002, the team has won seven division championships and has been to four Frontier League Championship Series within their numerous playoff appearances, amassing a club record of 949-849 along the way. The task at hand this season is reaching 1,000 wins. It will take a 51-plus-win season to do it this year, but with an average of 49.9 wins over the last 19 seasons they are right on pace to become the fourth team in Frontier League history to reach the plateau.

Over the years, Washington has had 45 player's contracts purchased by affiliated teams with four instances of former Wild Things reaching the pinnacle of the journey: Major League Baseball.

From a fan's perspective, there is no better evening than an evening spent at the ballpark. You will find kids playing catch with a Wild Things player before the game from the front row, or you will see players stopping to talk to fans and friends along the first-base line wall after the game. Fans line up in droves from behind the home plate net down the third base line to the picnic area waiting for the ever-popular \$1 milk and cookies promotion. For adults, these may seem like little things, but they help to make the nights of the youngest fans and add to the tradition that is the experience of a Wild Things game.

As always, the Wild Things have a fantastic line up of promotions set for the year, including: Nickelodeon Night, Jimmy Buffett Night, Star Wars Night, Harry Potter Night, Christmas and Halloween in July, Disney Night, Irish Heritage Night, Italian Heritage Night, Superhero Night and many more. Fireworks Fridays are also a must see. If you have kids 12 and under, they can sign up for a free Kids Membership. The Kids Membership provides free admission and a free kids' meal for all Sunday home games. All Sunday games begin at 5:35 p.m.

Adding to the jam-packed schedule of events surrounding the 20th Anniversary Season, the Wild Things are set to host the **2022 Frontier** League All-Star Game. Festivities begin with the Three Rivers Celebrity Softball Game Saturday, July 16 at Wild Things Park. The event benefits The Heyward House: the Cameron Heyward Foundation. The celebration continues Sunday, July 17 with IWC Wrestling; followed by the Eli Young Band and Lakeview in concert on Tuesday, July 19.

Wednesday, July 20, the biggest stars of the Frontier League will compete in the 2022 Frontier League All-Star Game. The stars of the East Division, which consists of the Evansville Otters, Florence Y'alls, Gateway Grizzlies, Joliet Slammers, Lake Erie Crushers, Schaumburg Boomers, Windy City ThunderBolts and the Wild Things, will battle the stars of the West Division, made up by the Empire State Greys, New Jersey Jackals, New York Boulders, Ottawa Titans, Québec Capitales, Sussex County Miners, Tri-City ValleyCats and the Trois-Rivières Aigles. Gates will open at 6:00 p.m. with the first pitch scheduled for 7:05 p.m.

COVERED BRIDGE FESTIVAL

The EQT Washington and Greene Counties' Covered Bridge Festival commemorates and highlights the historical significance of the 23 covered bridges in the region, while providing a weekend of family fun.

Covered bridges provide the perfect backdrop for this early autumn tradition. The unofficial kickoff to the fall festival season, the EQT Washington and Greene Counties' Covered Bridge Festival is the place to find handmade arts and crafts, entertainment, and of course, food booths. Whether you are traveling with a group of friends or bringing the family, the EQT Washington and Greene Counties' Covered Bridge Festival offers something for everyone.

A festival that spans the region. Unlike most festivals, the EQT Washington and Greene Counties' Covered Bridge Festival has multiple festival locations at ten different covered bridge sites - eight in Washington County and two in Greene County. You will find that each covered bridge site has its own unique sense of flare featuring vendors and organizations from both the community and beyond the region.

A shopper's delight. The largest festival locations lie within Mingo Creek County Park at the Ebenezer and Henry Bridge sites, each typically drawing more than 100 craft vendors. Start your holiday shopping early at the marketplace where you will find vendors selling everything from handmade furniture to jewelry and even pet treats. If shopping isn't your thing, the festive atmosphere and delicious food selections will draw you in. Be sure to enjoy a funnel cake, have some BBQ or purchase a bottle from a local winery. **Fun for the entire family**. The EQT Washington and Greene Counties' Covered Bridge Festival is not just about shopping and food. You can find fun activities to keep your children entertained at almost every site. The Krepps Bridge site features a Kid Zone with inflatables, a zip line, character visits and other activities, while the McClurg Bridge site offers three play lots for children. Most sites also offer a full lineup of musical entertainment and some host horse-drawn carriage rides and antigue/classic car shows.

Experience the history. For those who enjoy history, various festival sites will help you take a step back in time. The Brownlee Bridge site, among others, features historical reenactments and demonstrations such as chainsaw carving, live blacksmithing and/or period-style cooking. Take a tour of local historic structures at the Hughes and Wyit Sprowls Bridge sites, and experience 19,000 years of history at the Pine Bank Bridge site located within the Meadowcroft Rockshelter and Historic Village.

2022 marks the 51st Anniversary of the EQT Washington and Greene Counties' Covered Bridge Festival and will take place on September 17 and 18. Though it may be a challenge to visit every site, each one promises to be a fun and enjoyable destination.

THE WHISKEY REBELLION

History comes to life in Washington County



Lovers of history know that Washington County was home to the Whiskey Rebellion, a revolt against a federal excise tax on whiskey in 1794. George Washington, Alexander Hamilton and other prominent historical figures played key roles during this important piece of American History.

You can experience what life was like in the time of the Whiskey Rebellion by visiting the Bradford House Museum and the Whiskey Rebellion Education and Visitor Center located in the heart of downtown Washington, and by attending the Whiskey Rebellion Festival in July. All three work in conjunction to commemorate and celebrate this historical time

Built in 1788, the Bradford House

Museum is a National Historic Landmark and was the home of David Bradford, a leader of the Whiskey Rebellion. Visitors can take an 18th century docent-led tour and enjoy the customs and traditions from that time period first-hand. New exhibits prepared for the 2022 season include the addition of panels featuring David and Elizabeth, the all-new Farm & Home exhibit, and a revamped exhibit on the second famous Bradford House

inhabitant, author/journalist Rebecca Harding Davis.

To promote education of 18th century life with our younger residents, the Bradford House will host a Hands on History Day Camp in August for children in grades four, five and six. During the five-day program, campers will be fully immersed in 18th century living through activities, crafts, games, food, clothing and lessons.

Directly across the street from the Bradford House is the Whiskey Rebellion Education and Visitor Center, which is an extension of the Bradford House Museum and furthers the mission of educating and promoting the history of the Whiskey Rebellion and 18th century life. Embark on a self-guided tour through history and see the largest collection of artifacts from the Whiskey Rebellion time period, including an art display, period exhibits and a distilling display. The latest additions to the Whiskey Rebellion Education and Visitor Center include a collection of limited-edition woodcut prints by local artist J. Howard lams, five 1794 federal military vouchers and receipts, and three books belonging to Rev. John Corbly, including the Bible that he was carrying at the time of his family's massacre in 1782. A new facility, the Whiskey Rebellion Education and Visitor Center opened its doors in March of 2021 and is fully accessible.

The Whiskey Rebellion Festival wraps family fun and a celebration of the significance of the Whiskey Rebellion into a two-day festival in July. The festival opens on Friday, July 8 with an outdoor performance by the Washington Symphony Orchestra in downtown Washington. The ever-popular Whiskey Walk will also take place on July 8. During the Whiskey Walk, local shops on Main Street will partner with Pennsylvania distillers to offer samplings of different styles and types of distilled spirits. A ticket is required to participate in this event.

Main Street closes on Saturday, July 9 to make way for a true step back in time with historic reenactments, period exhibitions, family fun, frontier art, heritage music and food.

In addition to historical demonstrations by blacksmiths and tinsmiths, actors will perform several vignettes exploring the story of the Whiskey Rebellion in street theater productions throughout the day.

A children's area like no other, the Little Rebel Heritage Area located behind the Bradford House Museum gives children the opportunity to experience the chores that frontier children were expected to do and visit a frontier classroom where they can write with a guill pen and practice lessons on slates. Children can also try 18th century games like rolling hoops, cup and ball, hopscotch and walking on stilts.

If you enjoy unique, hand-made items, visit the mercantile area behind Strawberry Alley which features vendors who create and make items using techniques or materials available during the late 1700s.

No festival is complete without good food. Food trucks will be lined up on the lower level of the Main Street Pavilion, and be sure to stop by Blue Eagle Tavern to cap off your day with your favorite spirit.

To help locate these charming icons of our past, the following three tours have been compiled according to the abundance and proximity of each covered bridge. Plan a single outing or multiple excursions with these directions, which are based upon moderate road conditions and may not be the most direct routes. Please know that many of these bridges are located on narrow roads and in remote settings. 


FACTS TO KEEP YOU COVERED

- The primary reason for covering bridges was to protect the structure from the environment.
- All of these covered bridges were listed on the National Register of Historic Places on June 22, 1979.
- Pennsylvania has 197 covered bridges still standing statewide.
- Approximately 20 Kingpost truss covered bridges still stand in the United States, including eight in Washington County.
- The exterior of all but one of Washington County's 23 covered bridges are painted red, taken from a formula derived from a natural insect-proof oxide in the local soil.
