### **MILESTONE ANNIVERSARIES**

### 2023 marks an exciting year in Washington County for five local institutions celebrating milestone anniversaries.

The oldest known site of human habitation in North America, ironically, is set to celebrate the youngest of destination anniversaries in 2023. History enthusiasts are in for a treat at **Meadowcroft Rockshelter & Historic Village**, which is highlighted by 19,000 years of artifacts uncovered onsite, and three recreated historic villages that demonstrate life in the Ohio Valley through the centuries.

In 1973, a team of archaeologists began excavation of the Meadowcroft Rockshelter. This year, on June 18, the 50th anniversary of this date, visitors can enjoy an exclusive Insider Tour with James M. Adovasio, Ph.D., who achieved international acclaim with his archaeological excavation of the Rockshelter. Dr. Adovasio will present a lecture and lead a special tour of the site.

Additional Insider Tours will be held in July, August and October. Online reservations are required in advance.

The Pennsylvania Trolley Museum has come a long way in 60 years. Starting from humble beginnings when it opened to the public in June 1963 with an old railroad car as a gift shop and one trolley barn, the Museum now boasts three buildings to explore and a collection of 50 trolleys, half of which are beautifully restored and in operation. A visit to the Museum includes a four-mile round trip on one of the antique trolleys, a tour of the Trolley Display Building, self-guided exploration of exhibits, and so much more.

The Pennsylvania Trolley Museum commemorates its 60th anniversary with the opening of a brand-new, state-of-

the-art 21,000 square foot Welcome & Education Center later this year. The building will include new exhibit areas, including a trolley operator simulator and interactive STEM exhibits. The new facility will also feature three multipurpose rooms, a dedicated classroom, a larger museum store, new playground and park area, as well as a gazebo perfect for outdoor events. A new brick-lined street where the trolleys operate, as well as increased parking space, is an added bonus.

2023 also marks 60 years of harness racing at Hollywood Casino at The Meadows, a tradition in the region. While technology has come a long way, the core values of racing have stayed the same. Though the races can be accessed around the world, standing at the racetrack hearing the crunch of the gravel as the horses run by or talking to the winning driver after a race has the same feel that it had in 1963.

The casino will commemorate this milestone with a featured family-friendly night at the racetrack in June, as well as a series of vignettes highlighting 60 years of racing in 60 seconds. A video booth will also be available at the track where guests can share their memories.

The development of the casino, now known as Hollywood Casino at The Meadows, in 2009, made the venue a pivotal destination point in Washington County. The newest addition to the property is the Barstool Sportsbook which features a complete view of the track.

The performing arts community came alive in Washington County in 1949 when

Little Lake Theatre founder, Will Disney, transformed a red barn at the edge of Canonsburg Lake into a theatre-in-theround and began casting productions. Three quarters of a century later, that barn is still used for prop storage, rehearsals and summer camps, but the actual productions take place in a larger building that has housed hundreds of shows through the years. This summer, Little Lake Theatre celebrates their 75th anniversary by paying homage to the rich history that has made Little Lake what it is today. With shows like Popcorn Falls and White Christmas in the 2023 line up, each production was carefully selected to reflect the anniversary in some way.

Expect to see familiar faces as Little Lake alumni return to the stage.

A highlight at the close of every summer in Washington County is the Washington County Agricultural Fair. This year the fair will be bringing something extra special as it celebrates its 225th anniversary, making it the longest running fair in the state. Expect to see parades, concerts, a memorial plaza dedicated to the history of the fair and other activities, in addition to the traditional fair entertainment, food and fun.

The focus of the anniversary will be agriculture, which is always at the core of the Washington County Agricultural Fair. With over 2,600 exhibits in ten barns and five exhibit halls, the fair brings together the community and truly showcases what the region has to offer. Be sure to make the trip to the Washington County Agricultural Fair August 12 – 19 for a week of family fun.

### **PUTTING THE "DO" IN DOWNTOWN**

A visit to Washington County is not complete without a stop to the vibrant downtowns in the county, each with an individual flair.



#### WASHINGTON

With historic sites like the Bradford House Museum, Whiskey Rebellion Education and Visitor Center and the LeMoyne House, downtown Washington is rich and alive with history. But do not just visit for the history; downtown Washington is also known for their great food. Southern Yanks Smokehouse was named Best BBQ in the Burgh by Pittsburgh Magazine in 2022. The Union Grill and Presidents Pub are also Washington favorite lunch and dinner spots.

Combining history with a whole lot of fun, May 6 marks the inaugural "Running of the Wools" in downtown Washington. This family-friendly event will highlight Washington's prominence as the top exporter of wool in the 19th Century and feature sheep races through the streets of downtown Washington, as well as host a full day of sheep-filled activities including a children's area featuring "lambies in

pajamies," kitchen clash, breakfast crawl, educational activities like sheep shearing and many other engaging exhibitions. The fun carries into Sunday, May 7 with **Free Museum Day**, which offers free admission to six local museums.

#### **CANONSBURG**

A town known for its celebrations, Canonsburg is a beloved destination point in Washington County. Visit Pike Street on select Saturdays during the summer for **Alleyway Saturday**, themed family-friendly events designed to bring the community together. From concerts to bingo to community flea markets, Alleyway Saturday always offers an experience for visitors.

With the second largest parade in Pennsylvania, capped off by a magnificent fireworks display, Canonsburg is the place to be on July 4th.

Nationally-ranked on the list of the best American Oktoberfests, the **Pennsylvania Bavarian Oktoberfest** takes place in Canonsburg in September and welcomes over 60,000 people throughout the three-day festival. This authentic Bavarian event features food trucks, vendors, live bands performing traditional German music, and of course German beers

Cap off your year at **Canonsburg's Old-Fashioned Christmas** celebration in December. Recognized by VisitPA.com as one of Pennsylvania's most "Hallmark movie-esque" locations in the state, you can enjoy a parade, tree lighting,

food and craft vendors. No visit to Canonsburg's Old-Fashioned Christmas is complete without spending time with Santa and posing for a family photo in front of the signature 1952 Ford truck, the centerpiece of the celebration.

#### **MONONGAHELA**

Community is the lifeblood of downtown Monongahela. With over 20 community organizations and 17 churches, chances are you will encounter some sort of celebration, event or parade when you visit downtown Monongahela. A weekly farmers market, live music, pet events and a 5K run throughout the warmer months, in addition to a growing retail sector complete with gift, clothing and other shops, as well as a charming ice cream/candy shop and newly opened winery featuring live entertainment most weekends, make downtown Monongahela a vibrant stop on your summer bucket list.

The Monongahela Aquatorium, an entertainment venue that juts out into the Monongahela River, is the only large amphitheater of its kind in the region and is the perfect destination point for summer fun. Grab a seat by the river, bring your own chair or blanket, or dock your boat in the "Mon" to catch a show on the semi-hexagonal stage. Make a point to visit this venue for their summer concert series, food truck festival and other events, and be sure to catch Angelo II's magnificent inflatable holiday decorations that light up the town leading up to Easter, Halloween, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.

Take in the culture and history of Washington County by spending time at one of many notable museums.

#### **Bradford House Museum and Whiskey Rebellion Education and Visitor Center**

A visit to downtown Washington is not complete without a stop at the awardwinning Bradford House Museum and Whiskey Rebellion Education and Visitor Center. A new highlight at the museum this year is an exhibit board focused on the defenses on the frontier, specifically the roles women played in this unique time in history. Smell the mouthwatering aromas and take in the hearth cooking demonstrations in the kitchen cabin the last Saturday of every month for an immersive feel of what life in the 18th Century was really like. If you are looking to create a special event, book a whiskey tasting or a private 18th Century style dinner in David Bradford's dining room prepared by a local, top-notch chef.

### Meadowcroft Rockshelter & Historic Village

Travel back to prehistory with a hands-on, experiential tour of the Meadowcroft Rockshelter & Historic Village in Avella. See the internationally renowned archaeological gem which has provided evidence of 19,000 years of a human presence in our region and experience rural life over the

past 500 years through each exhibit. Explore a wigwam and test your aim with an atlatl at the 16th Century Eastern Woodland Indian Village. Walk through an 18th Century log cabin and open-sided trading post to learn about the challenges Native people and European settlers faced as these cultures came together. Watch a blacksmith forge red-hot iron or take a lesson in a one-room schoolhouse at the site's 19th Century Historic Village.

2023 marks the 50th anniversary of the excavation at Meadowcroft. This milestone will be celebrated with additional programming and two separate days of baseball games featuring teams from the Vintage Base Ball Association playing by rules of the 1860s

#### LeMoyne House

The LeMoyne House is a Historic National Landmark and famed stop of the Underground Railroad in downtown Washington. Tour this stately stonehouse and hear the important stories of Dr. LeMoyne and the free African American population in Western Pennsylvania who risked their personal freedom to take a stand against slavery.

A facility dedicated to research that will house collections not currently

on display at the LeMoyne House opens this summer. A new research library will give visitors interested in genealogy and family history or students completing research projects access to more than 100,000 documents to conduct thorough research.

#### **Duncan & Miller Glass Museum**

Many do not realize that glass manufacturing dominated Western Pennsylvania industry from the Civil War era through the 20th Century. The history and heritage of this era, but most importantly, the beauty of the glass, is captured at the Duncan & Miller Glass Museum, located in an ADA accessible building on Ridge Avenue in Washington.

Guided tours give visitors an in-depth look at those ordinary people who made extraordinary glass. A favorite area of the museum is the How It Is Made Room which focuses on the original tools that were used, as well as the processes utilized to create Duncan & Miller glass. New this spring will be a 1930s parlor and kitchen exhibit that will display furniture and glassware found in the average kitchen during this time period.

### **GET YOUR TAIL ON THE TRAIL**

#### Get out and get moving on the trails in Washington County this summer!

The main line of the Montour Trail, which spans 47 miles from Coraopolis to Clairton, is flat and easy to navigate for hikers, bikers and anyone who wants to spend time in the outdoors. Developed along the bed of the Montour Railroad, revitalized former railroad structures create a visually stimulating trail experience and are an ideal complement to the natural beauty of the shady, wooded landscape. The 760-foot-long viaduct in McDonald stretches over a valley and provides breathtaking views. Another rehabilitated railroad structure is the Chartiers Creek High Bridge, which is the third longest bridge on the Montour Trail. With three tunnels, also former railroad structures, the Montour Trail is known as one of the best tunnel trails in Pennsylvania.

Be sure to stop at **The Tandem Connection** bike and running shop at the Montour trailhead in Hendersonville to take a break, grab a slice of pizza and enjoy some ice cream before you finish your day on the trail.

The Montour Trail crosses the Panhandle Trail, another gem in the county's trail system in McDonald, an official Pennsylvania "Trail Town." While at the crossroads, visit the red brick **McDonald Trail Station and History** Center. A docent is on-site on the weekends to assist visitors as they tour the History Center featuring McDonald and surrounding areas from the early 1770s to the 1960s. The Trail Station also hosts a large farmers market every Saturday from July through the end of September and is also a big draw to both locals and visitors to the community.

If you are feeling adventurous, stop by **Pedego Electric Bikes**, located approximately 100 yards from the McDonald Trail Station and History Center, to rent or purchase an electric bike. When it is time for an ice cream break, look no further than **M.A.'s Ice Cream Shop**. Located just a few blocks from the trail in McDonald, M.A.'s Ice Cream Shop is known for their huge ice cream scoops and delicious flavors. There are plenty of other places to grab a bite or a beverage just off the trail as well.

A featured event that the trail hosts every October is the **Halloween Luminary Trail Walk**, which begins at the McDonald Trail Station. Bonfires

and luminaries light the way on this spooky walk along the Panhandle Trail as costumed volunteers distribute candy.

Claysville's National Pike Trail, one of the newest trails in Washington County, is a nearly two-mile trail excellent for hiking, birding and enjoying the peace and quiet of nature while getting some exercise. Follow a pre-Civil War railroad line through two arch tunnels along scenic terrain from the eastern edge of Claysville to Timber Lake Road near Sunset Beach. The walking path on the trail alternates from grass, dirt and gravel, and leads to a picnic area and grassy field perfect for a snack or lunch break before completing the trail.

To help locate these charming icons of our past, the following three tours have been compiled according to the abundance and proximity of each covered bridge. Plan a single outing or multiple excursions with these directions, which are based upon moderate road conditions and may not be the most direct routes. Please know that many of these bridges are located on narrow roads and in remote settings. Pack a lunch, bring a camera, and fuel up your vehicle to enjoy this scenic scavenger hunt throughout the beautiful countryside. Travel at your own risk.\*



From Washington, PA – approx. 13 mi: Take I-70 East to Exit 27. At stop sign, turn left and follow underneath I-70 for approx. 1 mi to stop sign. Turn right on Rt 136 East for approx. 4 mi and turn left on Chapet Hill Rd into Mingo Creek County Park. Follow downhill and at stop sign, turn left on Mingo Creek Rd. Follow past Park Office to bridge on left. **Easy Drive**

From Ebenezer Bridge – approx. 2 mi: Return east on Mingo Creek Rd (with the Park Office on your left). Follow approx. 2 mi to Mansion Hill Rd. Bridge on right. **Easy Drive**

Turn right on School Rd and follow approx. .5 mi, bearing right uphill on Ridge Rd. Follow .2 mi and turn right on Shortcut Rd to bridge. **Moderate Drive**

Turn right on Vanceville Rd and follow approx. 2 mi. Turn left on Scott Rd and follow straight at first stop sign. Turn left on Roberts Rd and follow approx. 1 mi. Turn left on Leatherman Bridge Rd and follow approx. 5 mi past Dague Hollow Rd to bridge. **Moderate Drive**

#### 18 Krepps Bridge

From Washington, PA – approx. 14 mi: Take I-70 Exit 17 to Rt 18 North. Follow approx. 9 mi to Rt 50 East. Travel through Hickory, PA, past the VFD and turn left on Wabash Ave toward Cherry Valley. Travel under overpass and bear right on Water Dam Rd. Follow approx. 3 mi to bridge at left on Covered Bridge Rd. **Easy Drive**

Follow approx. 1 mi and turn right on Noblestown Rd toward McDonald. Continue straight on Johns Ave. for approx. 1.5 mi to left on Rt 980 North. Turn right into McDonald Trail Station parking lot; bridge ahead on Panhandle Trail. **Easy Drive**

- Previously located atop the Lawton Bridge in Cross Creek County Park from 1978-2002 as part of a flood control program

- Rebuilt in its current location in 2011 by the Washington County Planning Commission

#### **20** Lyle Bridge

From Wilson Mill Bridge – approx. 13.5 mi: Take Rt 980 North and follow approx. 6.5 mi to left on Rt 22 West. Follow approx. 3.5 mi and take the Bavington Exit. At stop sign, turn right, then left on Old Steubenville Rd. Follow approx. 1 mi and make hairpin right turn on Kramer Rd at Kramer's Greenhouse. Continue following Kramer Rd for approx. 3.5 mi to bridge.

From Washington, PA – approx. 18 mi: Take Rt 18 North to Rt 844. Follow approx. 11.5 mi and turn right just past Breezy Heights Tavern on Rt 231 North. Follow 1.5 mi and turn left on Rt 50 West. Follow approx. 2 mi and turn right on Fallen Timber Rd. Follow approx. 1.5 mi and turn left on Meadowcroft Rd. Proceed approx. 1 mi to entrance of Meadowcroft Rockshelter & Historic Village at right. Bridge located within Village, several hundred yards from the Visitors Center; not visible from the parking lot. Admission Charged. Call 724-587-3412 or visit heinzhistorycenter.org/meadowcroft for operating hours. **Moderate Drive**


- Relocated to the museum in 1962 from across Toms Run in Gilmore Twp, Greene County, PA at the request of Meadowcroft founder Albert Miller when he learned it would be replaced with a modern bridge
- Complete rehabilitation in 2016 to repair Kingpost truss and return to original appearance
- Only covered bridge in the county not original to Washington County
- Features a different portal design than all others in Washington County
- Interior framing reveals original "Ask for Dilles Liniment" advertisement
- Annual Covered Bridge Festival site since its inception in 1971

#### FACTS TO KEEP YOU COVERED

- The primary reason for covering bridges was to protect the structure from the environment
- All of these covered bridges were listed on the National Register of Historic Places on June 22, 1979.
- Pennsylvania has 197 covered bridges still standing statewide.
- Approximately 20 Kingpost truss covered bridges still stand in the United States, including eight in Washington County.
- The exterior of all but one of Washington County's 23 covered bridges are painted red, taken from a formula derived from a natural insect-proof oxide in the local soil.
