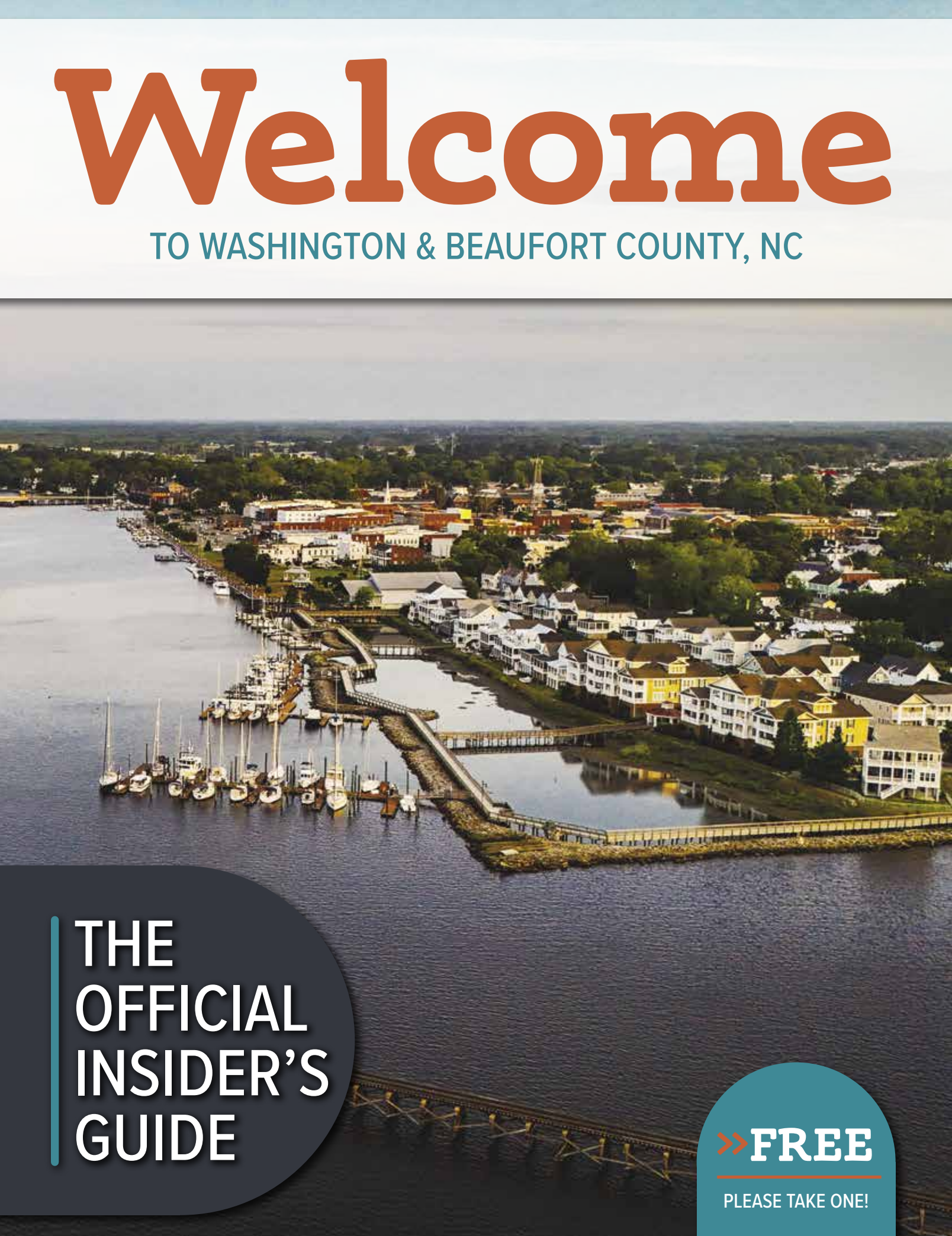

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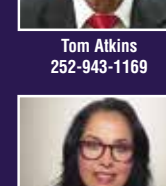

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Curiosity Starts Here

The Pamlico River has long been a source of both historical significance and environmental treasures for Eastern North Carolina. Since the earliest English settlements in the 1690s, its shores have played an important role in shaping the region's identity and economy. Along the river sits Bath, North Carolina's first incorporated town and the former home of the infamous pirate Blackbeard. Further upriver, Washington was founded in 1776 as the first town in America named in honor of General George Washington. Today, locals proudly refer to Washington as "The Original" in recognition of its historic distinction.

Beyond its historical legacy, the Pamlico River continues to serve as a vital environmental and economic resource for Beaufort County and the broader Eastern North Carolina region. As part of the expansive Pamlico Sound estuary system, one of the largest estuarine environments in the world. The river provides critical habitat for a wide variety of coastal marine life, including fish, shrimp, blue crabs, and oysters. The Pamlico River remains not only a defining natural landmark, but also an enduring foundation of the area's culture, economy, and way of life.

WAYS TO EXPLORE

AURORA FOSSIL MUSEUM

Prehistoric shark teeth, shells, coral, and even Megalodons are yours for the finding at the fossil pits outside of the Aurora Fossil Museum. Bring your own sand sifter and walk away with a discovery. Inside the museum learn about the unique natural history of the coastal plains of North Carolina. Explore exhibits featuring Native American artifacts, fossils of all shapes and sizes. You may even walk away with your own precious gem.

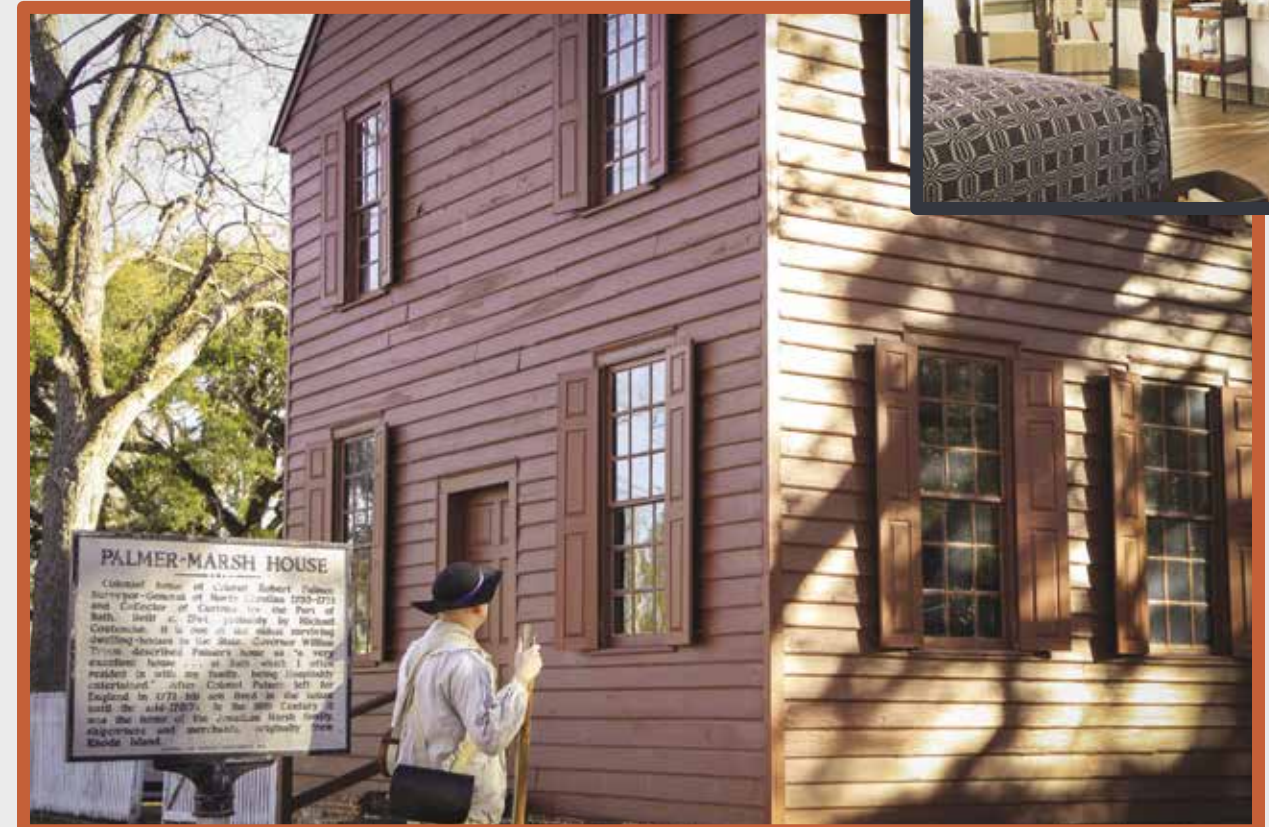


BELHAVEN MEMORIAL MUSEUM

Housed in the former City Hall of Belhaven, North Carolina, this collection features the life-long relics and treasures of local resident Mrs. Eva Blount Way (1869-1962). The museum showcases unique artifacts from across Eastern North Carolina, including farming implements, Civil War and World War-era memorabilia, and one of the region's largest collections of buttons.

HISTORIC BATH SITE

Historic Bath, founded in 1705, was North Carolina's first town to emerge following European settlement in the 1690s. By the early 1700s, it became the state's first port, despite having only about 50 residents and 12 houses. Bath endured years of political rivalries, conflicts with Native tribes, and piracy. Today, visitors can explore historic homes and artifacts, discover how early settlers lived, and learn how Bath nearly became the colony's capital.



NORTH CAROLINA ESTUARIUM

You can't head to Washington without experiencing the Pamlico River in all its glory. One of the best places to do that is at the North Carolina Estuarium. This Estuarium is an interactive center that explores where saltwater and freshwater mix. Washington has more estuarine waters than anywhere else on the East Coast, and these waters create unique habitats for many fish species.

P.S. JONES AFRICAN AMERICAN EDUCATION MUSEUM

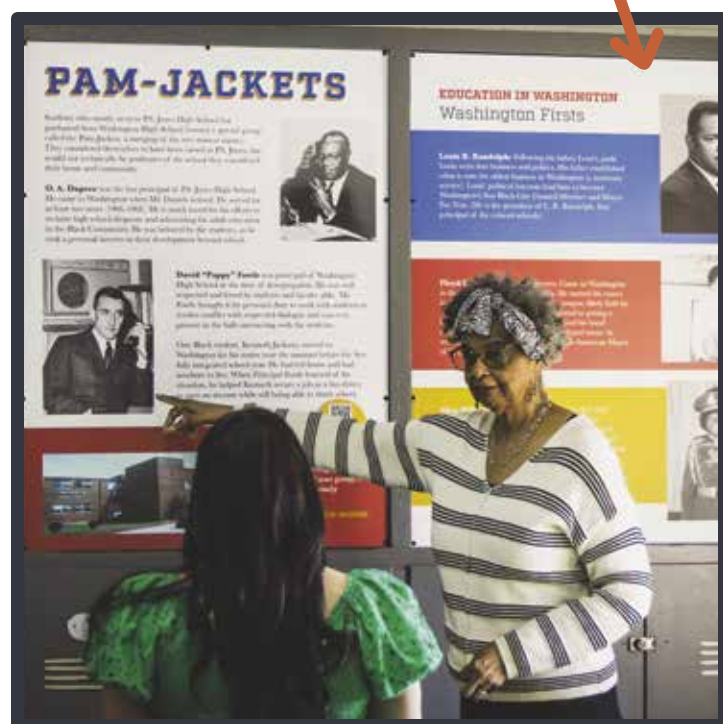
Step inside the P.S. Jones Museum of African American Education to explore the powerful story of African American education in Beaufort County and across North Carolina. This state-of-the-art museum traces more than a century of history, from the era when segregation was codified into law following the Civil War through the hard-fought years of school integration in the 1950s.



TAKE AN AUDIO TOUR

Hosted by passionate local historians, each tour brings the past to life through carefully researched historical documents, firsthand accounts, and rich oral histories passed down through generations. More than simple sightseeing experiences, these tours offer an immersive journey through the people, events, and defining moments that shaped our community and connected it to the broader story of Washington's founding and growth.

Featured experiences include the Washington Haunts Tour, which explores the legends and mysteries of the city's historic waterfront and neighborhoods; the Historic Port of Washington Tour, which highlights the city's role as a thriving river port and commercial center; and the African American History Tour, which honors the stories, achievements, and lasting contributions of African American residents throughout the region's history.



WASHINGTON WATERFRONT UNDERGROUND RAILROAD MUSEUM

The Washington Waterfront Underground Railroad Museum is a National Park Service Underground Railroad Network to Freedom Facility dedicated to telling the story of freedom seekers from the Greater Washington, NC region. Through extensive research of historic documents, narratives of formerly enslaved individuals, and archival materials housed in university libraries across North Carolina and the country, the museum shares powerful accounts of courageous escape attempts. Many of these journeys led to freedom in Northern states, Canada, Florida, the Caribbean Islands, and beyond.



WASHINGTON'S MUSEUM OF THE PAMLICO

Coming soon! This summer, the grand opening of the Museum on the Pamlico in Washington on Friday, July 3, will serve as a major highlight of the 250th celebration. Featuring artifacts from the early colonial period through the Civil War, the museum will be housed in the historic Atlantic Coast Line Terminal, built in 1904 when railroads began rivaling local waterways as vital trade routes. The museum will connect visitors to Washington's commercial growth and its role in America's broader story.



Art All Around

» In this riverside town, it's hard not to be inspired by the natural beauty and convivial community of the locals. Creativity abounds around every corner of Little Washington, you can see it in the flower boxes, the thoughtfully restored historic buildings of downtown, public art, and in the galleries and shops. Discover the art all around in Washington, and perhaps you'll come home with a spark of creativity and a new piece for your home.

GALLERIES GALLORE

Art lovers exploring downtown Washington will find plenty of inspiration in the city's vibrant gallery and creative scene. At Lone Leaf Gallery, every item reflects exceptional craftsmanship and an artist's creative touch. Visitors can browse a thoughtfully curated collection of handmade gifts, including handcrafted bags, hand-forged oyster knives, jewelry, ceramics, letterpress goods, and original artwork. The husband-and-wife owners also offer custom framing services, helping guests find the perfect frame for treasured photos and artwork.

A stroll down Main Street wouldn't be complete without visiting River Walk Gallery and Arts Center, a thriving hub for artistic expression in Beaufort County. Showcasing works from talented North Carolina artists, the gallery features a rotating collection of paintings, pottery, photography, and handcrafted pieces across a variety of mediums. Visitors can also take part in classes and workshops focused on pottery, acrylic painting, and other artistic techniques, making River Walk Gallery both a place to experience art and a place to create it.

For those drawn to history and performance arts, the Historic Turnage Theatre offers a glimpse into Washington's rich cultural past. Step inside the beautifully restored theater and you're instantly transported back to the 1920s, where Art Deco chandeliers illuminate the historic 432-seat venue and a grand stage awaits the next unforgettable performance. Visitors can tour the property by appointment and experience the charm of one of downtown's most treasured landmarks. Even when a show is not taking place, creativity continues to shine through the Arts Council's gallery space located at the front of the theater, featuring works from local artists and craftsmen. From visual arts to live performances, Washington's creative community offers something inspiring around every corner.

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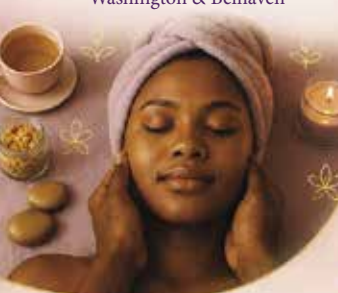

During the warmer months, Goose Creek State Park also offers a sandy swimming beach along the Pamlico River, as well as kayak launches that allow visitors to paddle deeper into the park's peaceful creeks and waterways.

If you're planning to turn your visit into a multi-day getaway, the park offers overnight accommodations for every type of adventurer. Campers can enjoy RV sites with full hookups, traditional and primitive tent camping, and cozy cabins for a more comfortable stay surrounded by nature.

Little Washington Sailing School is a youth sailing program in Washington, NC, founded by local sailing enthusiasts to introduce young people to the fun of recreational sailing on the waterfront and the Pamlico River.

All instructors are U.S. Sailing Certified. Students train in two types of boats: Optimist Prams (Optis) for sailors ages 9-12 and under 100 pounds, and Vanguard 420s, two-person sailboats for students ages 10-18. These boats are used to teach both beginner and advanced sailing skills.

River Vibes

Looking for a fun way to explore downtown Washington? River Vibes offers kayak and bicycle rentals for visitors and residents alike wanting to experience Washington's historic harbor district from both land and water.

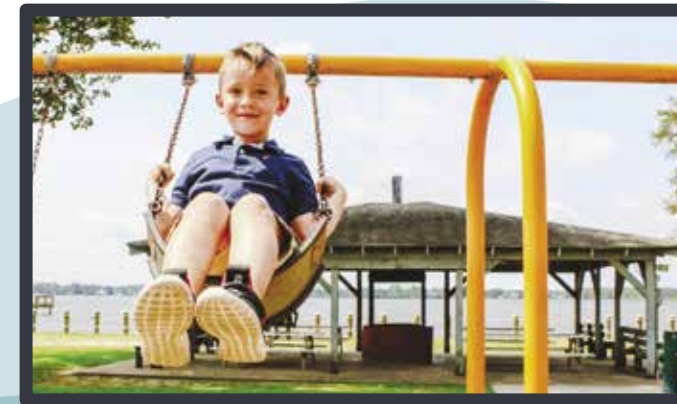

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HIGHWAYS

Supporting the movement of people and things, Highway US 264 East/West is a four-lane divided highway that connects Beaufort County to Greenville and beyond to I-95 and I-40. US 17 North/South is a four lane divided highway through Beaufort County and partially four-lane to parts of Norfolk, VA and Morehead City, NC. The quickest way to Highway 95 is in Wilson, NC which is 65.4 miles away.

PASSENGER AIR



KOCW Washington-Warren Airport (KOCW) exists to be a gateway to the City of Washington and Beaufort County, while being a beacon of premier service and hometown hospitality to the aviation community. This pilot friendly airport caters to General Aviation and is halfway between New York and Miami. They also offer rental car pick up and drop off, a well trained staff, convenient access to popular destinations and safety is a hallmark at KOCW! They also have short and long term hangars for rent.

PGV Pitt-Greenville Airport is located 26 minutes from Beaufort County and offers flights via American Airlines to Charlotte Douglas International Airport.

EWN Coastal Carolina Regional Airport in New Bern, NC is located 45 minutes south of Washington and offers flights via American Airlines to Charlotte Douglas International Airport and Delta Airlines to Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

RDU Raleigh-Durham International Airport is located 120 minutes from Beaufort County and provides over 400 daily flights via major US carriers with international flights to London, Paris, and Toronto.

WATERWAYS & ICW

The Washington Waterfront is along the north shore of the Pamlico River, approximately 25 nautical miles westerly from the Intracoastal Waterway, and 55 nautical miles from Ocracoke Island.

The channel from Red marker 16 in the Pamlico River has a normal depth of 9 to 11 feet to the Coastal Railway swing bridge. Inside the trestle, water depths run from 14 to 24 feet.

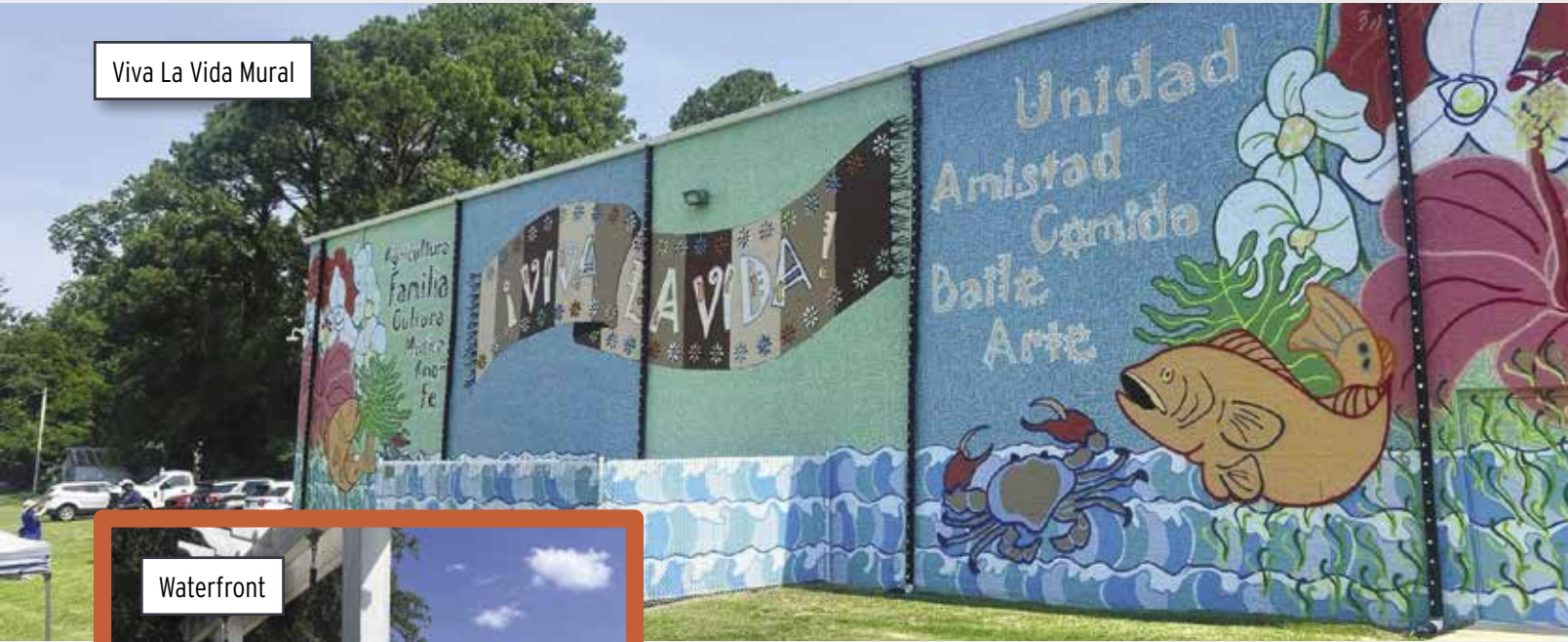

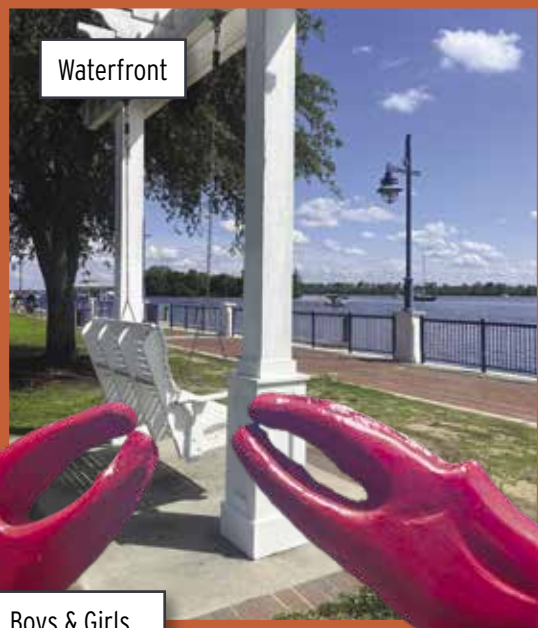

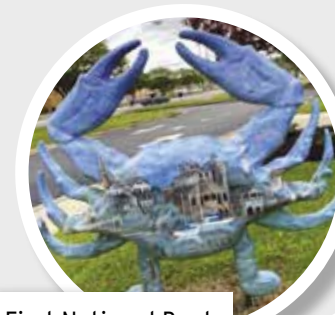

The 'Crabs on the Move' project started in 2006. The Pine Needles Garden Club started this venture as a way to give back to the community in Washington. The crab statues were auctioned off to different organizations and businesses at a 'Crab Ball,' a black tie event that was held at the Washington Civic Center. The money raised went to local charities. The crabs were painted and decorated by local artists, then displayed in town. At that time, the statues would be moved to different parts of town on occasion. Thus the 'Crabs on the Move' became the name of the initiative.

Project objectives

included providing a marketing tool for tourism, raising money for local charities, tying in with the Estuarium's existing logo, providing an icon for tourists and locals in which to identify Beaufort County, and bringing Beaufort County's first outdoor art exhibit to life - a showcase for our local artists.

The project eventually took a new direction when they were bought by various businesses, organizations, and individuals, (many were repainted) and were placed in permanent spots throughout Washington and Beaufort County.

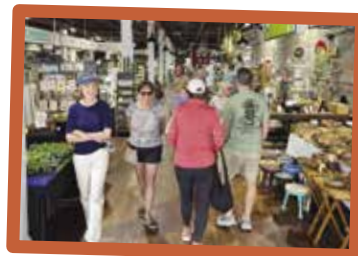
