




# WHERE THE HUDSON VALLEY BEGINS

Lyndhurst is a 67-acre historic estate on the Hudson River in Tarrytown, New York, only 30 miles from midtown Manhattan. This National Historic Landmark features park-like grounds, historic buildings, and the majestic Gothic Revival mansion.
