Drones

White Mountain National Forest –

Recreational use is allowed as long as the landing of the drone does not occur within 1/4 mile of a Forest Protection Area, alpine zone, wilderness area or area otherwise listed in Exhibit B of [Forest Order R9-22-19-01](#). Flying drones is prohibited anywhere along the 161-mile long ribbon of land known as the Appalachian Trail (AT). Commercial drone use requires a Special Use permit.

State Parks –

Use of drones for filming, photography, or recording is prohibited. Commercial use authorization in the form of a Special Use Permit must be obtained prior to operating a drone within State Park boundaries. Permits are subject to approval based on intended use.
