Bethlehem Gazebo – *Bethlehem*

Grassy area along Main Street offering benches & a gazebo where the town's summer concert series is held. No picnic tables & no restrooms.

Eisenhower Memorial Wayside Park – *Bretton Woods*

Views of Presidential Range with picnic tables. No restrooms.

Dow Park – *Franconia*

Gazebo, pavilion, playground, walking path, & playing fields located along banks of Gale River. Access to Franconia Artwalk self-directed walking trail. Portable toilets available.

Iron Furnace Wayside – *Franconia*

Picnic tables and interpretive area with access from Main Street (NH Route 18). Access to Franconia Artwalk self-directed walking tour. No restrooms.

Fay Wayside Picnic Area – *Lincoln*

Picnic tables are located along the Pemigewasset River on NH Route 3. No restrooms.

Loon Mountain Resort – *Lincoln*

Picnic area located at entrance to resort along banks of Each Branch of Pemigewasset River on NH Route 112. Access to 2-mile paved bike path that runs into town. No river access. No restrooms.

The Dells – *Littleton*

Picnic tables, fireplaces, & handicapped deck available with fishing for children only. Easy walking trails follow the edge of the pond. Access from Dells Road or NH Route 18. No restrooms.

Littleton River District – *Littleton*

Picnic tables above Ammonoosuc River near Harmony Park which includes 6 percussion sculptures. Located behind Main Street along the Mill Street walkway. No restrooms.

Remich Park – *Littleton*

Picnic tables and benches plus relaxing green space, playing fields, tennis courts, town pool, gazebo, & playground. Access via Pine Hill Road or Oak Hill Ave from Main Street.


Beaver Pond – *North Woodstock*

One picnic table available at west end of pond. Vault toilet available at east end of pond at trailhead parking. Located in Kinsman Notch at the height of the land about 6 miles from town.

Cascade Park – *North Woodstock*

Park anywhere on Main Street. Entrance is across from the Woodstock Brewery. Well-manicured lawn with picnic tables & access to swimming in the Pemigewasset River. No restrooms.

White Mountains Visitor Center – *N. Woodstock*

Picnic tables available on main grounds. Restrooms, visitor services & gift shop available 8:30am-5pm daily.  

Woodstock Family Park – *N. Woodstock*

Picnic tables and pedestal mounted fire-grates. No restrooms & dogs are not permitted. Park behind Woodstock Fire Station.

New Hampshire State Parks Facilities

Willey House – *Crawford Notch*

Check out the Visitor Center & Gift Shop plus picnic tables, views, & short walk on Pond Loop Trail. Restrooms available.

Forest Lake – *Dalton*

Picnic tables along edge of lake, playground, & sandy beach for swimming. Restrooms available.

Basin Pull-Off – *Franconia Notch*

Features walking paths to the Basin, picnic tables, access to Rec Path, & vault toilets.

Boise Rock Pull-Off – *Franconia Notch*

Amazing views of Cannon Cliffs with picnic tables & vault toilets available.



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New Hampshire State Parks Continued...

Echo Lake Beach – Franconia Notch

**Fee & reservation necessary to access*

Picnic tables, pedestal mounted fire-grates, restrooms plus swimming, fishing, & boat rentals.

Livermore Falls Recreation Area - Holderness

**Fee & reservation necessary to access*

Picnic tables, canoe & kayak boat launch, & swimming from river beach. Vault toilets.

Weeks State Park - Lancaster

**Fee plus reservation necessary for historic tour*

House & grounds at the top of Mt. Prospect plus stone fire tower, trails, & picnic tables. Restrooms available.

White Mountain National Forest Facilities

Beaver Brook Picnic Area

The site includes several picnic tables, pedestal-mounted fire-grates and a vault toilet.

Closest Town: *Twin Mountain*

Directions: Located 5 miles east of Interstate 93 Exit 35 on NH Route 3.

Campton Day Use Area

Fire grates for grilling, picnic tables, a large grassy area, & a newly installed trail to a restroom.

Closest Town: *Campton*

Directions: Take Interstate 93 Exit 28 onto NH Route 49 toward Waterville Valley. Day use area is less than 2 miles on the right.

The Eddy Day Use Area

A popular place to cool off and relax with a picnic on a hot summer day. The site has picnic tables and access to a large pool on the Mad River. No restrooms.

Closest Town: *Campton*

Directions: Take Exit 28 off Interstate 93 onto NH Route 49 toward Waterville Valley. Day use area is 3.75 miles on your right.

Long Pond Day Use Area

Offers picnicking, fishing, and boating. It provides picnic tables, pedestal-mounted fire grates, a vault toilet, and boat launch ramp for small non-motorized watercraft.

Closest Town: *North Woodstock*

Directions: Take NH Route 112 west from North Woodstock to its junction with NH Route 116W. Turn left and follow 116 for 1.5 miles. Go left onto Long Pond Road (North South Road). Day use area is on a spur road 2.5 miles on right.

Otter Rocks Day Use Area

Located along the Hancock Branch of the Pemigewasset River, this site is a beautiful spot for a picnic. It has picnic tables overlooking cascades and a small pool. Vault toilet available.

Closest Town: *Lincoln*

Directions: Located on the Kancamagus Highway (NH Route 112) 11 miles east of Lincoln.

Wildwood Picnic Area

A Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC)-built site featuring pedestal-mounted grills, picnic tables, a vault toilet, and a beautiful pavilion shelter.

Closest Town: *North Woodstock*

Directions: Located on NH Route 112W 2.5 miles northwest of the height of land in Kinsman Notch (Lost River Reservation).

Zealand Picnic Area

Offers picnic tables, pedestal mounted grills, and a vault toilet along the Ammonoosuc River.

Closest Town: *Twin Mountain*

Directions: Located at the junction of Zealand Road and NH Route 302. It is adjacent to Zealand Campground.
