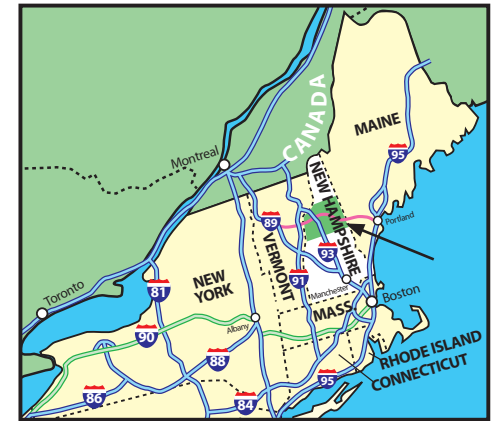


WELCOME TO NEW HAMPSHIRE'S WHITE MOUNTAINS
