Visit The Rocks for a garden tour



Visit **The Rocks**, the North Country Conservation & Education Center for the Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests. The 1,400-acre property is best known for its Christmas Tree Farm, but also offers an extensive trail system and educational experiences. Receive a personalized guided tour of the terraced gardens which were designed by noted landscape architect Frederick Law Olmsted. The **garden tour** is followed by a **horse drawn wagon ride** through the Christmas tree fields.

Littleton for shopping & lunch on own



Nestled along the banks of the mighty Ammonoosuc River is **one of America's Best Main Streets** (ranked by Reader's Digest as "One of the 10 nicest places in America" in 2021 and named a "Top Ten Dream Town" by Outside Magazine). The walkable, charming town of **Littleton** features **local eateries and breweries, beloved boutiques, several art galleries, and plenty of history.**

Explore the fields of lupine in Sugar Hill



Explore the Fields of Lupine in Sugar Hill. Suggested scenic photo opportunities include **St. Matthew's Chapel** and **Sunset Hill Road** (Lupine Field protected by Ammonoosuc Conservation Trust). Additional stops may include **Harman's Cheese & Country Store** and the **Sugar Hill Historical Museum.**

3:30 pm

Ride the Cannon Mountain Aerial Tramway



Enjoy an eight-minute scenic ride in one of two enclosed cable cars (Ketchup or Mustard) that whisk you to the 4,080-foot summit of **Cannon Mountain** which offers panoramic views of the distant valleys and mountains. On a clear day, visitors will enjoy views of the mountains of New Hampshire, Maine, Vermont, Canada, and New York. Amenities available at the summit include **walking paths, an observation tower, cafeteria,** and restrooms.

Other Options



- Ride the world's first mountain climbing railway, the **Mt. Washington Cog Railway**, to the summit of New England's highest peak.
- Take a self-guided tour of the historic **Omni Mt. Washington Hotel & Resort** followed by an elegant buffet lunch.
- Add an evening excursion – enjoy a unique dining experience aboard the **Café Lafayette Dinner Train** or take a 3-hour guided moose safari with **Pemi Valley Moose Tours.**
