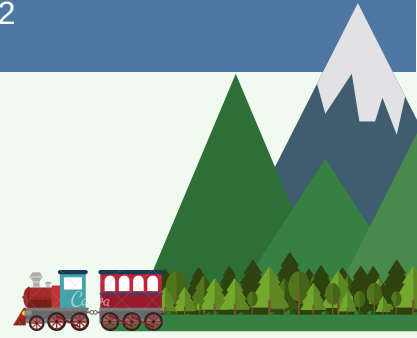


# White Mountains Rail Tour

### Full Day Tour



9:00 am

### Explore the Flume Gorge Visitor Center



Located in **Franconia Notch State Park**, the **Flume Gorge** is a two-mile self-guided nature walk that includes an 800-ft long gorge with sheer rock walls plus a glacial pool, gigantic boulders, and two covered bridges. The Visitor Center is the perfect place to learn about the region as it offers **historical displays, a 22-minute free movie, gift shop, and full restroom facilities.**

### Ride the White Mountain Central Railroad at Clark's Bears



Take a steam-powered ride through history on the **White Mountain Central Railroad**. Enjoy a 2.5-mile, 30-minute narrated excursion along the beautiful Pemigewasset River through an authentic railroad covered bridge into Wolfman Territory. Experience a 30-minute **Bear Show**, explore **five museums**, and browse through **gift and specialty shops**. Dine at one of the multiple food service offerings.

### Ride the Hobo Railroad



The family-owned and operated **Hobo Railroad** offers an 80-minute round-trip, **old-fashioned train ride** from Lincoln to Woodstock and back. Departing **Hobo Junction Station** in restored vintage coaches, guests travel south along the banks of the Pemigewasset River on the historic rail system that dates to the late 1800's when logging was the area's primary industry.

### Explore Main Street in North Woodstock



**Fadden's General Store** offers an on-site maple sugar house and museum, groceries, souvenirs, and maple products. Feel the Christmas spirit while you browse New England's largest selection of ornaments at **The Christmas Loft** or shop for White Mountains souvenirs at **Kancamagus Collectables**. **Cascade Park** is a tranquil place to relax on the rocks and take photos of the scenic Pemigewasset River, or view granite monuments on the grassy common honoring veterans at **Soldier's Park**.

### Dine at the Woodstock Inn Brewery

Housed in an original late 1800's train depot, the restaurant offers a cozy home-style menu with a New England flair featuring locally sourced ingredients plus the use of recycled grains from the brewery in the bakery.
