A scholarship will be awarded to high school graduate who:

- is currently or previously employed at one of the White Mountains Attractions or a tourism-based business, and left in good standing
- is attending a 2+ year New Hampshire based College or Community/Technical Institution (in-person and/or online classes are allowed)
- is pursuing a career relevant to Travel and Tourism, including but not limited to hospitality, business management, marketing, tradesmanship, etc.
- has demonstrated academic achievement, leadership, and determination to succeed
