THE WINE

Nestled in the rolling foothills of the Yamhill-Carlton AVA, Block 15 is the unique child rooted in Soléna's biodynamic vineyard. It doesn't look south; it looks east toward the rising sun. Laurent Montalieu planted this block to a field blend of Pommard and Dijon 114 as an experiment, hoping to bring structure to future blends. However, these vines had a different idea. They thrive in the cool morning rays and are always the last block to be picked, giving them the full growing season to build their personality. Let's raise a glass to marching to a different beat, facing a different direction, and growing amazing wine.

THE WINERY

After successful careers in the Oregon wine industry, Laurent Montalieu and Danielle Andrus-Montalieu purchased an 80-acre estate to commemorate their marriage in 2000. In May 2002, they launched Soléna by bottling their first vintage of Domaine Danielle Laurent Pinot noir and opening a tasting room in Carlton. Soléna is the combination of the Spanish and French words *Solana* and *Soleil*, celebrating the sun and the moon, and the name that Laurent and Danielle gave to their daughter. In May 2007, Danielle and Laurent added the spectacular 100-acre Hyland Vineyard in the McMinnville AVA to their estate vineyard holdings.

THE WINE

Gothic's single-vineyard Pinot noirs bear the Middle English title "Eldritch," or "otherworldly." This bottling is from the historic Hyland Vineyard, planted in 1971, just five years after Pinot noir was introduced to the Willamette Valley. The vineyard still has prephylloxera, own-rooted, old-vine Pinot noir vines, and lies exposed to cool maritime winds and coastal influences via the Van Duzer. Elevations of 600 to 800 feet and the volcanic soils of the McMinnville sub-AVA provide ideal growing conditions for this special cool-climate wine.

THE WINERY

Inspired by Gothic tales of the 18th century, Gothic is a collection of cool-climate wines from Oregon's Willamette Valley. They are individual wines, driven by the terroir of their remote vineyards. Ripe and balanced, they remain indicative of the regions in which they are grown. The palate and structure of the wines are vibrant and food-driven, modeled on classic, oldworld styles of non-interventionist winemaking.

This vineyard has been farmed biodynamically for 18 years, and this is a Pommard clone selection fermented with 100% whole clusters. Les Griottes shows the power and the grace that the Dundee Hills is known for as well as the style that I have been pursuing for 21 years as an Oregonian winemaker.

Bergström Wines is a family–owned and operated exploration of Pinot noir and Chardonnay in Oregon's Northern Willamette Valley, with 85 acres of biodynamically farmed vineyards spread across five distinct vineyard sites on four different AVAs. The wine highlights the dark fruit typical of the Eola-Amity Hills and has structure and tannin that suggest aging potential. The two vineyards are roughly five miles apart on the eastern side of the AVA, and these blocks are over 20 years old. This wine was in 30% new French oak for 15 months. The wine was bottled unfined and unfiltered.

THE WINERY

Established in 1983 by winegrower and Oregon native Jim Bernau, Willamette Valley Vineyards has gone from an idea to one of the region's leading wineries, earning the title "One of America's Great Pinot noir Producers" from *Wine Enthusiast* magazine. THE WINE

Our Road Blocks Pinot noir comes from our favorite section of Calkins Lane Vineyard, the 52-acre property surrounding our winery. Planted in 1995 on ancient marine sedimentary soils, this vineyard was the third Pinot noir site planted by the Adelsheims. The two one-acre clonal blocks that make up this wine run right next to Calkins Lane and consistently produce the most exciting wines from the property. Block 1 is clone 115; Block 7 is 667. Of the dozen "Dijon" clones brought to Oregon from Burgundy in the 1980s, these two have adapted best to Willamette Valley vineyard soils and climates.

THE WINERY

Adelsheim Vineyard was founded in 1971 and is still family-owned. We create remarkable Pinot noir and Chardonnay wines with most of the grapes now coming from our ten estate vineyards in the Chehalem Mountains. THE WINE

This singular selection represents the Antica Terra Vineyard in its purest form. Our inspiration came from Burgundy, where small producers would have often only one barrel from a small plot of Grand Cru vines and couldn't bear to top it up with village-level wine. They would drop small rocks into the barrel to displace the wine and eliminate the headspace. We waded through Alder Creek and picked buckets of rocks from the clear, newly-melted glacial runoff. This barrel was topped with these rocks and thus remains the only wine made purely and wholly from our estate.

THE WINERY

Antica Terra is an 11-acre vineyard located on a rocky hillside in the Eola-Amity Hills AVA. The first vines were planted here in 1989 in a clearing within the oak savannah. The geology of the site is extremely unusual; in this place, the remains of a far older prehistoric seabed rise to the surface, leaving the vines to struggle, without topsoil, amongst a fractured mixture of sandstone sown with fossilized oyster shells.

Aged for 16 months in a single French oak barrel, this unique wine delivers a combination of the richness from the Yamhill-Carlton sedimentary soil with the elegance and brightness of small-cluster Pinot noir grapes grown in our cool climate Valley.

THE WINERY

Divio refers to the ancient name of the town of Dijon, the capital of Burgundy—where Bruno Corneaux grew up—and to the origin of most Pinot noir clones grown in the Willamette Valley. Bruno, a fourth-generation Burgundian vintner, fell in love with Oregon while working internship at Domaine Drouhin in 1996. In 2012 he created his own winery, Domaine Divio, and started to make premium wines from Burgundian varietal grapes sourced in the Willamette Valley. Domaine Divio is farming the estate vineyard that was planted in Ribbon Ridge in 2014 through biodynamic practices and producing elegant wines using minimal intervention in a traditional Burgundian style.

We fermented this wine using native yeasts and then aged it in French oak, of which 25% was new. While it is tempting to drink now, we believe it has aging potential of 10 years or more. A wonderful wine to have in your cellar or wine list. – Paul de Lancellotti

Rikolto Du reflects the deft hand of winemaking team Thomas Savre and Dominique Lafon. They paid close attention to the balance between ripeness and freshness, resulting in an expressive, well-defined wine true to its terroir.

THE WINERY

Lingua Franca is the partnership between Burgundy legend Dominique Lafon, sommelier Larry Stone and business partner David Honig. They were quickly joined by the young and talented winemaker Thomas Savre, who has work experience at some of the finest wineries in Burgundy, including Domaine Dujac and Domaine de la Romanée-Conti. The winery is based upon two exemplary estate vineyard sites in the Willamette Valley: Lingua Franca Estate Vineyard in the Eola-Amity Hills and Bunker Hill Estate in Salem. Our philosophy is to respect the flavors of the place where the grapes are grown, making well-defined and differentiated wine from expressive vineyard sites.

As our home vineyard evolves, the Flat Block is the immutable center of the wheel, the steady voice that can always translate what we love about our place into wine. Our Auction lot is a micro blend of small amounts of our favorite barrels from the 2016 Flat Block.

THE WINERY

Bethel Heights Vineyard was established in 1977 in the Eola-Amity Hills by Ted Casteel, Terry Casteel, Pat Dudley and Marilyn Webb. In 2006, Ben Casteel took over from his father as winemaker. Over the last forty years Bethel Heights has grown and evolved, but the original fifty acres of own-rooted Pinot noir and Chardonnay vines planted in the 1970s continue to provide the backbone of Bethel Heights estate-grown wines. Gnarly old vines, geologically complex hillside soils and direct impact from Æolian winds—all conspire to create highly energized wines with depth of character and distinctive personalities.

THE WINE

Helioterra Pinot noirs are a study in elegance, balance and grace. This single barrel from Lias Vineyard was the best barrel of our cellar. It exemplifies beautiful red fruit notes, layered with dusty sandalwood and a touch of bergamot and black tea, finishing with a lingering of red raspberry and graham. Lias Vineyard is on a bench that has a gentle southeast slope. This is a transitional section with some volcanic Jory, but predominantly sedimentary soils. There are many rocks and boulders in this block. The variability of soils and exposure lends complexity to this single clonal selection.

THE WINERY

Helioterra Wines is a small artisan producer of Northwest wines that are pretty, elegant and graceful in style. All our Pinot noirs are fermented with native yeasts and aged for a year, unracked, before bottling. Helioterra's production focuses on three pillars: aromatic white wines, Pinot noir and Rhône red wines. As an undergraduate, Anne Hubatch studied geology at the UW–Madison. The name Helioterra draws on geological inspirations, symbolizing Heliolite, the Oregon state gemstone (more commonly known as Sun Stone). Helio and Terra combine the Greek words for sun and earth, natural partners for grape growing.

Deux Vignerons ("Two Vintners") is also about harmony. Bruno and Laurent believe that a wine should evoke emotions—their search for purity, elegance, mineral complexity, almost ethereal texture that they believe Chardonnay must achieve.

THE WINERIES

Laurent Montalieu and Bruno Corneaux, both French natives, have been friends since they met in the Willamette Valley 22 years ago. Laurent and Bruno worked together for the last eight years and share all viticulture and winemaking decisions at Laurent's production facility, Northwest Wine Company. They both have a passion for geology and share the idea that greatness in a wine has a lot to do with the roots of the vines, the respect of the land and the sense of place reflected in their wines.

THE WINE

Our favorite single barrel from 2016 was Musigny-clone Pinot noir grown at our Twelve Oaks Estate Vineyard in the Chehalem Mountains AVA. The story of Gary Andrus smuggling this clone back to the United States, combined with the uniqueness of this barrel, convinced us to select this as our auction wine. It is a dark, brooding wine, with great acidity and flavors of blueberry, violets, lavender and pastilles. While it will certainly age well, gaining increased complexity and nuances, it is still soft and pretty enough to be consumed young. Bottled unfined and unfiltered.

THE WINERY

Anne Amie Vineyards farms our two estate vineyards (Anne Amie Estate in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA and Twelve Oaks Estate in the Chehalem Mountains AVA) sustainably according to LIVE certification. We want each of our wines to express their variety, vineyard and vintage, so winemaker Thomas Houseman employs a light touch in the cellar, using small fermenters and focusing on indigenous yeast, gravity flow, extended lees contact, modest amounts of new oak and bottle age to bring out the personality of our vineyards. Our goal is to produce elegant, terroir-driven wines that emphasize complexity over power.

The barrels are 48-month air-dried "Toasted Blonde Heads" and bring both tension and balance to this cuvée. Enjoy!

Named for a ridge in the Chehalem Mountains, Raptor Ridge is a haven for birds and winery guests alike. THE WINE

Legend has it that in 1947 one of Bill Stoller's uncles found the body of an unknown man leaning against a tree on our property. Some say he was an outlaw; others say he was an adventurer caught with the wrong man's wife. Nevertheless, this wine is composed of our original Pommard plantings located on what is privately called "Dead Man's Hill." Fermented in a two-ton oak tank with 14% whole cluster, "Dead Man's Hill" spent 12 months in barrel and four months in tank. Aromatics of cherry, violet, spice and earth lead to a lively, succulent palate with a plush texture and seamless finish.

THE WINERY

Stoller Family Estate is a 398-acre parcel located on the southern slope of the Dundee Hills. Pioneering Oregonian and founder Bill Stoller purchased his family's second-generation farm in 1993 with the vision of cultivating an enduring legacy for the land and Oregon wine industry. Over the last 20 years, he has patiently transformed the property into the largest contiguous vineyard in the Dundee Hills that has become synonymous with producing exceptional wines. Stoller Family Estate features the world's first LEED Gold–certified winery, three guest homes and a state-of-the-art tasting room with panoramic vineyard views.

In 2013, we were given the opportunity to expand our horizons and buy the Résonance Vineyard, which is located in Oregon's Yamhill-Carlton AVA. Because the Résonance Vineyard is the departure point for our new adventure, we decided to call the project Résonance. In 2014, we acquired a second vineyard called Découverte Vineyard located in the Dundee Hills AVA.

THE WINE

This unique wine represents the lengths our team will go to in the cellar to produce the most profound wines possible. It is a 50/50 blend of Zena East Block 1 Pommard clone, which was fermented as a 100% whole cluster lot and foot trodden for cap management, and Zena East Block 12 Pommard clone destemmed and fermented in small barriques with one head removed. Extremely limited quantities of both of these wines were produced, and the creation of a small auction blend using both components is the only possible way to make a wine such as this available.

THE WINERY

Zena Crown Vineyard, located at the southern end of the Eola-Amity Hills appellation in the Willamette Valley, comprises 115 acres of vines and 48 vineyard blocks. From it, winemaker Shane Moore and consulting winemaker Tony Rynders produce four Pinot noir wines—one for each season, to capture the vineyard's changing moods and expressions just as if it were a living, breathing thing. Volcanic soils help maintain aromatic lift, climate keeps acidity buoyant, and the punishing winds rushing through the adjacent Van Duzer Corridor add an overcoat of structured tannin.

THE WINE

The story of this wine begins before the first vines were planted in the Willamette Valley, in the unlikely Pinot noir region of Alsace. It starts in the hands of a man whose bravado and robust reputation preceded him. This story twists and turns through failed nurseries, broken relationships and lost plantings to Mother Nature's touch, but it ends with the perfect pairing of clone and site. Hyland Vineyard's gentle Jory slopes and long growing season set the stage for elegant tannins and floral aromatics. Self-rooted and unchanged, this wine is history in your glass.

THE WINERY

Hyland has been a part of the Willamette Valley since 1971. You can't discuss the origins of Oregon winemaking without mentioning the gentle giant overlooking the Van Duzer Corridor. Untouched, unmoved and self-rooted, Hyland's gnarly 47-year old vines remain entrenched in red volcanic Jory soil. It wasn't until 2011 when its new owner and winemaker, Laurent Montalieu, decided it was time for this vineyard to have its own wine. Hyland Estates produces around 5,000 cases of clone-specific wines from the most historic blocks in the vineyard.
