Application for Recognition of Exemption Under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRS Code
Form 1023 Part IV - Planned Activities of Applicant.

Applicant will operate exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) by supporting the provision of housing, early child care and education, health, education and advancement, and other charitable services to persons in need throughout the Willamette Valley and engaging in related efforts to enhance the health and wellbeing of the Willamette Valley winemaking community. Applicant's contemplated activities in furtherance of these purposes include:

Enhancing Health and Wellbeing: Facilitating access to health and wellness services by underserved and vulnerable individuals throughout the Willamette Valley winemaking community. Applicant anticipates that, at least initially, this will likely take the form of providing financial support to other established charitable organizations, including Hillsboro Medical Center's ¡Salud! Services and Federally Qualified Health Centers like Virginia Garcia Memorial Health Centers.

Facilitating Housing: Supporting the provision of housing and shelter to underserved and vulnerable individuals within the Willamette Valley winemaking community. Applicant anticipates that, at least initially, this will likely take the form of providing financial support to other established charitable organizations, such as Habitat for Humanity, or existing nonprofit farmworker housing programs, or partnering with such organizations in support of their initiatives.

Supporting Early Child Care and Education: Supporting the provision of early child care and education to low-income and moderate-income families within the Willamette Valley winemaking community. Applicant anticipates that, at least initially, this will likely take the form of providing financial support to other established charitable organizations, such as Oregon Child Development Coalition or existing Oregon Early Head-Start, Oregon Pre-Kindergarten, and Oregon Preschool Promise programs, or partnering with such organizations in support of their initiatives.

Sponsoring Education and Advancement: Supporting education and advancement of vineyard and winery workers in the Willamette Valley. Applicant anticipates that, at least initially, this will take the form of providing financial support to other charitable organizations like the AHIVOY Wine Professional Program and supporting college and university programs that provide scholarships for wine-related education and professional advancement.

Supporting Other Family Services: Facilitating access to other family support services including nutritional support, family intervention, legal representation, and other referral and administrative services. Applicant anticipates that, at least initially, this will take the form of providing support to other charitable programs that provide these services or assist vineyard and winery workers access federal, state, and private resources that provide these services.
