Educational Camps:

From July 17 to 21, and July 31 to August 4, young explorers ages 8-12 can work on an actual archeological dig alongside the field team at Jamestown Rediscovery at <u>Historic Jamestowne's</u> Kids Camp. Golf Camps:

Animal Camps:

They work with animals and the land as a farmer, nourish soul and soil as an environmentalist, becoming stewards of both tradition and nature.
