### WILLIAMSBURG TOURISM COUNCIL MEETING

# Williamsburg, Virginia August 8, 2023 Finance Meeting Minutes

A meeting convened at 11:30 a.m. on August 8, 2023, in the 1st-floor conference room at 421 North Boundary Street.

#### I. Call to order

- Doug Pons called the meeting to order
- July 11, 2023, finance meeting minutes were acknowledged

### II. June 2023 Activity

### June Activity - Original Budget

- June 2023 revenues were \$1.5M over budget by \$344K
  - o Sales tax receipts (58.1-603.2) totaled \$1.3M, over budget by \$267K
  - o Transient tax receipts totaled \$153K, over budget by \$78K
  - Maintenance of Effort funds totaled \$25K, under budget by \$1K
  - Other revenue was \$5K, over budget by \$1K
  - June 2023 expenses were \$1.6M over budget by \$179K
    - Destination Marketing expenses were \$1.4M, over budget by \$102K
    - Sales activities were \$79K, over budget by \$76K
      - Membership expenses were over budget in the month by \$35K
      - Cooperative marketing expenses for sports events were over budget by \$20K
      - Trade show and travel expenses were over budget by \$ 16K
    - o Total administrative expenses were \$161K, in line with budget

- Staffing costs were \$105K, \$31K under budget due to the timing of hiring and other staff-related savings
- Other administrative expenses were \$56K, \$32K over budget due to year-end expense accruals for the FY23 audit (\$20K) and an increase in interest expense for the implementation of GASB 96 (capitalization of subscription-based information technology)

## June Activity - Amended Budget

- June 2023 revenues were \$1.5M in-line with budget
  - Sales tax receipts (58.1-603.2) totaled \$1.3M, in line with budget
  - Transient tax receipts totaled \$153K, over budget by \$3K
  - Maintenance of Effort funds totaled \$25K, under budget by \$1K
  - Other revenue was \$5K, under budget by \$3K
- June 2023 expenses were \$1.6M over budget by \$70K
  - Destination Marketing expenses were \$1.4M, over budget by \$48K
  - Sales activities were \$79K, over budget by \$76K on higher-than-planned expenses
     in June for memberships, cooperative marketing, trade shows, and travel
  - o Total administrative expenses were \$161K, under budget by \$53K
    - Staffing costs were \$105K, \$33K under budget due to the timing of hiring and other staff-related savings
    - Other administrative expenses were \$56K, \$20K under budget due to year-end expenses being less than anticipated in training (\$5K), travel (\$3K), and legal and accounting (\$12K)

### Fiscal YTD Activity

- 2023 Fiscal YTD revenues were \$16.6M, over budget by \$8K
  - o Sales tax receipts (58.1-603.2) totaled \$14.5M, over budget by \$3K
  - o Transient tax receipts totaled \$1.6M, in line with budget
  - Maintenance of Effort (MOE) revenue was \$127K, in-line with budget
  - o ARPA Grant receipts totaled \$255K, over the amended budget by \$5K
  - Other revenue was \$98K, in line with budget
- 2023 Fiscal YTD expenses were \$23.8M, under budget by \$200K
  - Destination Marketing expenses were \$16.5M, under budget by \$112K
  - Sales activities were \$580K, under budget by \$16K
  - The product development fund of \$5.2M was paid to the Historic Triangle Recreational Facility Authority (HTRFA) in line with the amended budget
  - Total administrative expenses were \$1.5M, under budget by \$68K

- Staffing costs were \$1.1M, below budget by \$39K
- Other administrative expenses were \$451K, under budget by \$29K

### Cash on Hand Slide

- o The Tourism Council has \$5.5 million in the bank for operations
  - Cash on Hand for Operations on June 30 is over budget by \$1.8M but accounts payable liabilities (payments issued but not cashed) on June 30 are \$1.9M bringing Cash on Hand for Operations in line with budget at \$3.6M

### Tax Slides

<u>Reminder:</u> The tax slides have the month the actual activity took place, not when the payment was received. This month is <u>May</u> – a one-month lag to the financial reports

- Sales Tax (58.1-603.2)
  - May sales tax increased by \$10K or 0.8% year-over-year
    - \$1.21M in 2023 versus \$1.20M in 2022
  - The three-month moving average increased by 2.1% versus the same period in 2022
  - o YTD sales tax receipts are up 2.2% versus the same period in 2022

#### Transient Tax

- o May transient tax decreased by \$9K or -5.4% year-over-year
  - \$167K in 2023 versus \$177K in 2022
- The three-month moving average increased by 2.1% versus the same period in 2022
- o YTD tax receipts are up 1.9% versus the same period in 2022
