## **Lambeau Field & Titledown District**

**1265 Lombardi Avenue, Green Bay, WI 54304**

The Titledown green space comes alive in spring with locals enjoying yard games, patio dining and more. The iconic Lambeau Field provides a legendary backdrop. \*Please note that many locations in this area may only be available to media with specific credentials for the Draft.

## **Packers Heritage Trail**

**118 S Washington Street, Green Bay, WI 54301**

A three-mile walk ideal for historical storytelling with a football twist, featuring statues and landmarks.

## **CityDeck on the Fox River**

**301 N Washington Street, Green Bay, WI 54301**

A lively downtown waterfront setting, perfect for capturing people enjoying the riverwalk, outdoor dining and boat activity.

## **Bay Beach Wildlife Sanctuary**

**1660 E Shore Drive, Green Bay, WI 54302**

A beautiful natural backdrop with budding trees, active wildlife and peaceful walking trails.

## **Brown County Courthouse**

**100 S Jefferson Street, Green Bay, WI 54301**

Added to the National Register of Historic Places for its artistic and architectural significance in 1976, the courthouse is a waypoint on the Packers Heritage Trail.

## **Meyer Theatre**

**117 S Washington Street, Green Bay, WI 54301**

A 1929 building constructed in art deco and Spanish Colonial revival architectural styles, home to nearly 200 performances a year.

## **Green Bay Yachting Club**

**100 Bay Beach Road, Green Bay, WI 54302**

Established in 1934 at the mouth of the Fox River, offering waterfront views.

## **Downtown Green Bay Murals & Broadway District**

**Various addresses throughout Downtown**

The city's growing mural scene provides bold, artistic backdrops, including the Green Bay mural and the classic "Breezn" mural. Broadway District's historic brick buildings, charming storefronts and spring blooms make for an inviting urban aesthetic.

## **Green Bay Botanical Garden**

**2600 Larsen Road, Green Bay, WI 54303**

A must-visit in spring, featuring tulips, cherry blossoms and beautifully landscaped garden paths.

## **Heritage Hill State Park**

**2640 S Webster Avenue, Green Bay, WI 54301**

This 50-acre open-air museum includes four distinct areas of the park representing various periods of Northeastern Wisconsin's rich heritage: the Fur Trade, Fort Howard, the Growing Community and the Ethnic Agricultural Area.
