THE CYNTHIA WOODS MITCHELL PAVILION

Catch a show by one of your favorite artists at **The Cynthia Woods Mitchell Pavilion**. Consistently ranked one of world's top-ranked outdoor amphitheaters by *Pollstar* Magazine, The Pavilion hosts an impressive annual lineup of concerts from April through October. You can also enjoy performances by the Houston Symphony, Houston Ballet and Houston Grand Opera from April through December.

LIVE MUSIC

Enjoy live music every Thursday through Saturday at **Como Social Club Poolside Terrace + Bar** and every Friday and Saturday at **The Refuge Bar & Bistro**. Let your hair down at local pubs with weekly live music at **Mahoney's Texish Bar & Restaurant** or **The Goose's Acre**. Other favorites in Waterway Square are **Bar Louie** and **Baker Street Pub & Grill**. For an intimate concert experience, check **Glade Gallery'**s calendar for upcoming performances.

WATERWAY SQUARE

The Fountains at Waterway

Square feature synchronized water choreography set to music, which perform family-friendly musical selections at random every 15 minutes, seven days a week. The one-acre public plaza also has a variety of outdoor art as well as a host of restaurants with spacious patios. Nearby, **The Woodlands Waterway Marriott** and **The Westin** provide stunning views of The Woodlands Waterway.

From light-up-the-sky, jubilant summer festivals to kicking off the holiday season in a big way, here are the biggest parties to plan your visit around:

SPRING

FALL

Taking place each April, **The Woodlands Waterway Arts**

Festival is one of The Woodlands' most popular annual events and includes original artwork by over 200 artists, live music, performing arts, family-friendly activities and food stations. Spring is also the perfect time to enjoy a show at one of the many **free concerts series** held around town (see page 9 for more info). If you're a sports enthusiast, make plans to participate in **The Woodlands Marathon**, held every March.

SUMMER

Celebrate military servicemen and women with the annual **Memorial Day Celebration** held at Town Green Park. The festival kicks off with the National Anthem, and continues into the evening with live music, children's activities and a fireworks display. Make Independence Day a party to remember with the annual **Red**, **Hot & Blue Festival**, featuring a full day of events and multiple fireworks shows in and around town. Enjoy family fun at The Woodlands' annual **Labor Day Celebration** at Waterway Square, which includes children's activities, live music and a fireworks show. Fall is also a great time to catch a concert or performing arts show at The Cynthia Woods Mitchell Pavilion. Each October, enjoy **Hocus Pocus Pops** featuring the Houston Symphony with an evening of Halloween-themed music. Kids can even come in costume!

WINTER

Enjoy the most magical time of the year in The Woodlands. The Lighting of the Doves Festival kicks off the holiday season with a visit from Santa on The Woodlands Waterway, children's activities and more. Lace up your skates and hit the ice at The Woodlands Ice Rink, open daily mid-November through mid-January.

Outdoors & Recreation

STEP OUTSIDE, AND IMMERSE YOURSELF IN NATURAL BEAUTY AND ADVENTURE.

The Woodlands was uniquely built as a metropolitan area surrounded by thousands of acres of protected pine forests and two scenic bodies of water. Whether you want to lay in the shade of a tall pine or get active with some outdoor sports, a visit here is far from complete without experiencing the outdoor attractions and beautifully preserved Texas nature.



WATER RECREATION

One of the more adventurous ways to explore during your stay is by water. **Riva Row Boat House**, along The Woodlands Waterway, and **Lakes Edge Boat House**, at Hughes Landing, both offer single or tandem kayaks and stand-up paddleboards for rent so you can spend an afternoon gliding leisurely around **Lake Woodlands**. You can also rent a swan boat, water bikes and more from Riva Row for a fun vessel to explore **The Waterway**.

THE WOODLANDS WATERWAY

The Woodlands Waterway

winds throughout the Town Center area with scenic walkways connecting Town Green Park and The Cynthia Woods Mitchell Pavilion with Waterway Square, and The Woodlands Mall. There are public art installations, water features, waterside eateries and green spaces. **The Woodlands Waterway Trolley** also provides free transportation with several stops along The Waterway.



TEXAS TREEVENTURES

Climb to new heights at **Texas TreeVentures**, a gravity-defying ropes obstacle course through the treetops. This unique course is both mentally and physically challenging, offering a great activity for families, friends and groups to enjoy as they attempt to traverse a series of poles, cables and other elements. Ground school & gearup are included, along with nearly three hours of climbing time.

GEORGE MITCHELL NATURE PRESERVE

The 1,700-acre **George Mitchell Nature Preserve** includes a two-mile hiking trail loop and three miles of bike trails. The Woodlands is on two migratory bird flyways, Central and Mississippi, so be sure to keep an eye peeled for migrating birds and other wildlife. The preserve branches out to Spring Creek Greenway, which encompasses more than 7,000 acres of protected forests.

GOLF & DISC GOLF

Home to over 300 holes of golf on pristine courses, some of which are designed by PGA champions, you'll find the perfect setting to spend a day hitting the links. Two of the most popular courses, **Panther Trail** and **The Oaks**, are conveniently located within the grounds of The Woodlands Resort. **Bear Branch Sportsfield** and **Terramont Park** are both popular locations for disc golf which offer varied terrain and elevation.

The Woodlands has more than 220 miles of trails to explore and 140 parks to relax or run around in. Northshore Park along Lake Woodlands has a playground, picnic spots, large field spaces and volleyball courts. Town Green Park offers plenty of green space and is home to many annual events. Located along The Woodlands Waterway, the park features several art benches, sculptures and even a children's literary labyrinth with lifesized Aesop's Fables characters.

POOLS & SPLASHPADS

If you're looking for a place for the kids to run and play while cooling off, you're in luck. You'll find free splashpads at Central Park in **Market Street** and Village Green in **Creekside Park**. Let the kids enjoy a scavenger hunt & a splashpad at the same time when they explore Grandma's Purse at **Waterway Square**. For one of the most popular, kid-friendly hotel pools, head to **The Woodlands Resort**, which features a waterpark and lazy river.
