- **Dine before the show.** Waterway Square and Market Street offer a wide selection of restaurants within walking distance of The Cynthia Woods Mitchell Pavilion.
- **Find free parking.** Free parking is available in the Yellow, Orange, Green, Blue, and White Lots. Accessible parking is also free on a first-come, first-served basis in the Gold Lot.
- Check the bag policy. Be sure to review The Pavilion's bag and purse policy before arrival. If you'd rather not leave valuables in your car, the nearby Hyatt Centric The Woodlands offers a bag check for a small fee.
- **Bring a card, not cash.** The Pavilion is a cashless venue. All transactions including box office sales, concessions, and parking require card payment.
- Beat the heat in The Lounge. This air-conditioned bar opens one hour before the gates at most Live Nation events and stays open an hour after the show.






