

Old Town Rock Hill



Since it's opening in 1994, the 1,550-seat Proscenium Theatre has been fulfilling its mission of educating, enlightening, enriching, and entertaining the entire community. The auditorium hosts a wide variety of events by local groups and is also home to community events including theatre, concerts, dance recitals, civic, and church events.

With the Clover School District Auditorium's three seating levels – orchestra, mezzanine, and balcony – and professional quality audio-visual equipment, there is not a bad seat in the house. Equipment includes a 48 channel digital mixer, computerized lighting controls with 120 control channels and 48 channel digital mixer. A green room and dressing rooms are conveniently located backstage.
