Passengers with pre-booked tickets for **Titanic Belfast** can take the shuttle bus to the City Centre, then the G2 Titanic Quarter bus from Wellington Place (outside Tim Horton's) on Donegall Square North. A taxi from the ship to Titanic Belfast costs about £12. A freephone is available in the Cruise Hub and Visit Belfast Welcome Centre.
