FOLLOW THE TRAILS

Sip your way through the Bucks County Wine Trail, Ale Trail or take a distillery tour!

HISTORIC TOWNS AND MAIN STREETS

Explore or stop for a meal in one of Bucks County's towns including New Hope, Doylestown, Bristol, Sellersville, Yardley, Newtown, Perkasie or Quakertown.

UNIQUE SHOPS AND MARKETS

Shopping lovers can discover Peddler's Village, The Square in Dublin, The Shops at Valley Square and tons of antique shops. Food lovers can enjoy locally sourced markets such as the Quakertown Farmer's Market, Ferry Market or the Trolley Barn Public Market.

RIVERSIDE THEATERS

Enjoy performances at Bristol Riverside Theatre and the Bucks County Playhouse, both located along the stunning Delaware River.

HISTORIC SITES & ICONIC LANDMARKS

Go back in time to the American Revolution at Washington Crossing Historic Park or William Penn's summer home, Pennsbury Manor. Be sure to visit the Pearl S. Buck House & Historic Site, New Hope Railroad, Historic Fallsington, Moland House, Michener Art Museum, Summerseat, and The National Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa.

FANTASTIC FACTORIES

Tour the handmade treasures of Byers' Choice, Ltd. and view the skilled artisans in the workshop proudly creating each unique figurine. Tour The Moravian Pottery and Tile Works and watch the craftsman as they turn natural clay into tiles. You can even make your own!

OUTDOOR ADVENTURE

Take a scenic bike ride down the Towpath or grab your group and venture to TreeTrails Adventures, Bucks County Joyrides, Bucks County River Country, Hellerick's Family Farm, Snipes Farm and Shady Brook Farm.

GORGEOUS GARDENS

Take a stroll through the 9-11 Garden of Reflection, Andalusia Historic House, Gardens & Arboretum, Bowman's Hill Wildflower Preserve, Byers' Choice®, Ltd., Terrain Gardens at DelVal, Peace Valley Lavender Farm, Tyler Gardens and various nature centers.

FOLLOW THE MERCER MILE

Day 1

HOLIDAYS AT FONTHILL CASTLE

Throughout the holiday season, enjoy a 60-minute guided tour of Fonthill Castle, showcasing Henry Mercer's home decked for the holidays, and the castle's unique architecture and history.

TILEWORKS OF BUCKS COUNTY

The Moravian Pottery and Tile Works is a 'working history' museum, built by Henry Mercer during the American Arts and Crafts Movement. Book a tour to see the tiles being made using Mercer's historic methods.

PEDDLER'S VILLAGE

Stroll through a dazzling winter wonderland with colorful lights, 60+ unique shops, delicious food, 125 gingerbread displays and the famous 'tunnel of lights'!

MARGARET R GRUNDY MEMORIAL MUSEUM VICTORIAN HOLIDAY HOUSE

Stop by The Grundy Museum, featuring Victorian-inspired decorations. Local designers and florists transform the space, offering festive stories and a special gift to take home.

PENNSBURY MANOR HOLLY NIGHT OR CANDLELIGHT TOUR

Experience Pennsbury Manor by candlelight with bonfires, carolers, colonial crafts, and a visit from Father Christmas. Holly Night takes place the 1st or 2nd Thursday and Friday in December.

WASHINGTON CROSSING HISTORIC PARK FIRST CROSSING REENACTMENT

Witness the reenactment of George Washington's 1776 Christmas night river crossing with reenactors in Continental military dress rowing replica Durham boats along the Delaware River.

This event takes place each year on the second Sunday in December and on Christmas Day

Day 1

WASHINGTON CROSSING HISTORIC PARK & CROSSING THE DELAWARE TOUR

Celebrate history with events including the Christmas Day Crossing, General Washington's Birthday, and the Fourth of July. Explore Taylorsville Village and outdoor recreation areas.

PENNSBURY MANOR

Pennsbury Manor is William Penn's 17th century country estate along the Delaware River. The reconstructed, 43-acre plantation features a manor house with period furnishings, outbuildings, livestock, gardens, special programs, workshops and demonstrations throughout the year.

SHOPPING IN BRISTOL

Explore the charming shops of historic Bristol Borough, offering unique boutiques, antiques, artisan goods, and local treasures.

DINNER AT HISTORIC KING GEORGE II INN


Established in 1681, it offers five dining rooms, a historic tavern, and a riverfront patio.

MOLAND HOUSE

The headquarters of General Washington and 11,000 troops camped nearby in August 1777, has been beautifully restored to its original appearance for group and private tours.

LUNCH AT THE HATTERY STOVE & STILL

This revived historic inn blends vintage treasures with antique-industrial décor.

MERCER MUSEUM

Step back in time at a castle showcasing more than 40,000 early American artifacts.

SHOPPING AT PEDDLER'S VILLAGE

A historic village with colonial-style buildings, award-winning gardens, and over 65 unique shops.

DINNER AT PEDDLER'S PUB

Offers a casual setting for delicious pub fare, refreshing beverages, and warm hospitality.

Take a walk through historic Fallsington, a former Quaker town in lower Bucks County.


