The Crystal Coast in North Carolina's Southern Outer Banks

Worried about not being able to bring your pup to the beach? Crystal Coast has you covered with 85 miles of pet-friendly beaches just waiting to be explored. If the beach isn't your thing, outdoor adventurers can walk, bike or hike alongside their furry friends at Emerald Isle Woods Park Trail (a 1.7-mile path on the North Carolina Birding Trail) in Fort Macon State Park, a charming landmark with sand dunes, hiking trails and more.
