



Prohibition Era Tour Itinerary of the Daytona Beach Area

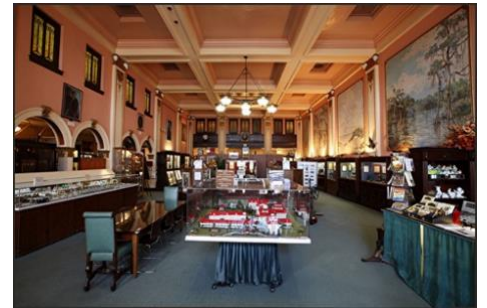

STOP ONE: HALIFAX HISTORICAL MUSEUM

Located in the 1910 Merchants Bank Building on historic Beach Street, the Halifax Historical Museum showcases Daytona Beach area's richest and colorful history. After a welcome from Museum Director Heather Files, learn about the Daytona Beach area as well as sea captain and rum-runner Bill McCoy and his brother, who lived in the area and built yachts. Recommended time: 30-40 minutes.



STOP TWO: CINEMATIQUE THEATER

STOP THREE: RIVERFRONT ESPLANADE

Located between Beach Street and the Intracoastal waterway, enjoy a walking tour of the Riverfront Esplanade, a premier gathering space and botanical garden. Composed of more than 100 newly planted mature shade trees and a mile of waterfront running trail with comfortable benches and swings overlooking the Halifax River, the Riverfront Esplanade also features a dog park with an agility course and a state-of-the-art splash pad. Visitors will discover in the southern end walkways that run through a creek with waterfalls, gardens with flowers, plants and trees and picnic tables that overlook the water. Recommended time: 30 minutes



STOP FOUR: EXPLORE BEACH STREET

Enjoy some free time on Beach Street to explore everything that downtown Daytona Beach has to offer. Step inside the Angell & Phelps Chocolate Factory, which was founded in 1925, and watch the chocolate-making process and enjoy a sample of their goodness. Take a stroll, visit the shops or discover a great lunch spot such as Little Italy's Ristorante, Zen Bistro or the Dancing Avocado Kitchen. Recommended time: 90 minutes



STOP FIVE: WORLD FAMOUS BOAT TOUR

With a tour of the Streamline Hotel, view first-hand the history of this historic and iconic hotel, which has experienced many milestones over the years from the founding of NASCAR to serving as the headquarters of the Women's Auxiliary Army Corp during World War II. More recently the hotel was featured on Travel Channel's Hotel Impossible. Adding to the allure is the Streamline's art deco architecture, Free Mason symbology and mysterious hotel safe. In addition, the hotel was home to moonshine runners. During recent renovations, a sealed tunnel entrance was discovered in the basement that used to lead directly to the beach. The allure behind the tunnel includes stories of racing legends & locals stating drivers, mechanics, team owners, promoters & local elites would be escorted through the tunnel to the Streamline Hotel. Then enjoy a rooftop cocktail and snacks as you take in the scenic views of the Atlantic Ocean and the Halifax River from all sides. Recommended tour time: 90 minutes

The Casements, named for the large hand-cut casement windows that adorn the mansion, is the winter home of the late John D. Rockefeller, an American business magnate and philanthropist. Also known as "The Jewel of Ormond Beach," the Casements has been officially listed on the National Register of Historic Places and has been designated as a Florida Heritage Site. Learn how Rockefeller's influence and residency in Ormond Beach attracted visitors of wealth to visit and reside from New York City and Boston's socialite communities. Recommended tour time: 45 minutes
