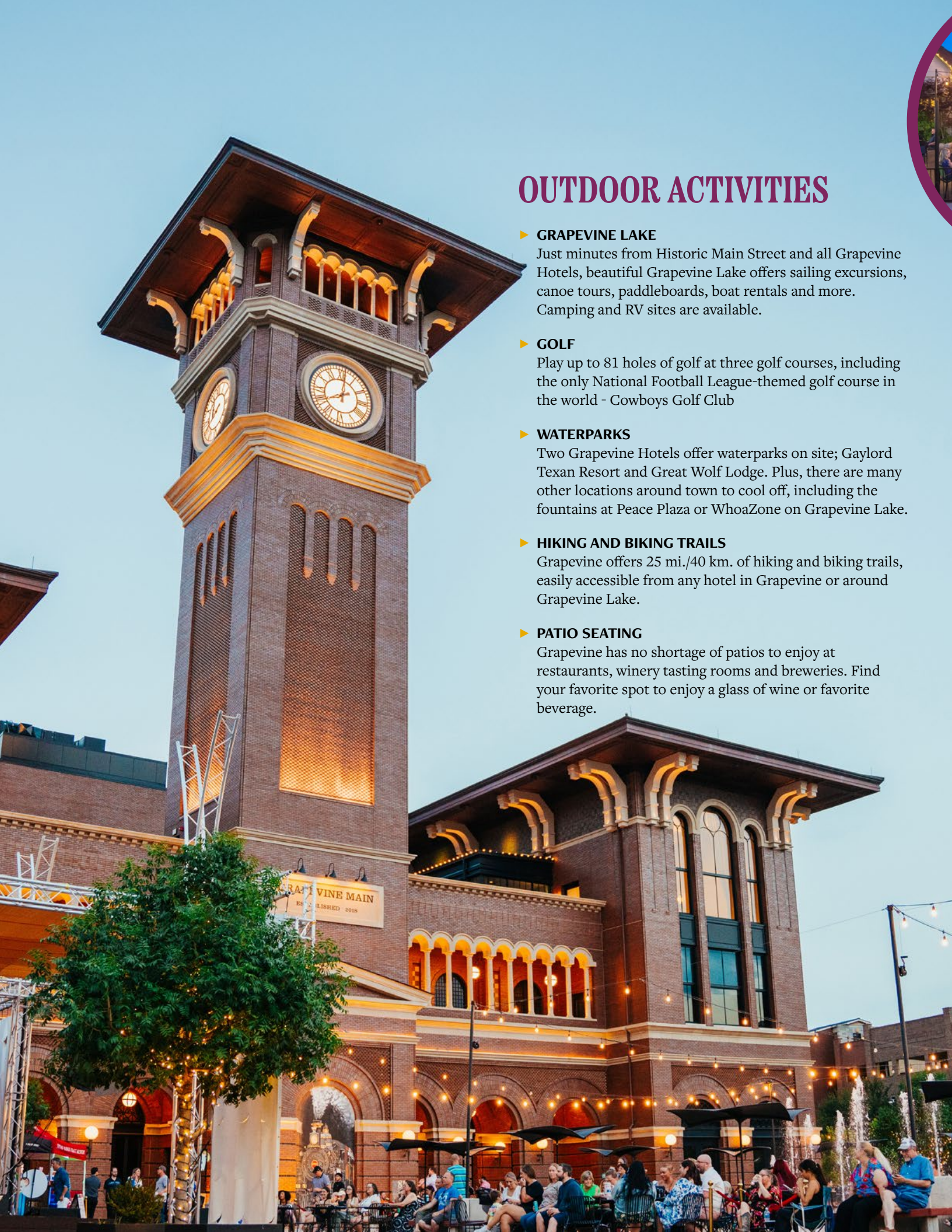

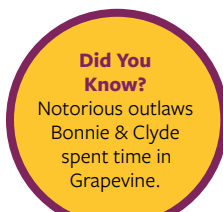
# SAMPLE ITINERARY

## Day 1 – Welcome to Grapevine!

- ▶ **DFW INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT** – It's easy to get to Grapevine from DFW Airport. Average wait time at customs is just 23 minutes!
- ▶ **GRAPEVINE HOTEL CHECK-IN** – Grapevine has 20 hotels all within 10-minutes of DFW Airport, and most offer complimentary airport transportation.
- ▶ **CHEERS TO YOUR HOLIDAY!** – In no time, you can be enjoying your favorite beverage, or discovering a new favorite beverage, along Grapevine's Historic Main Street District. Here you'll find a wide assortment of local restaurants and live music to kick off your holiday.

## Day 2 – A Day in Grapevine's Historic Main Street District

- ▶ **BREAKFAST DOWNTOWN** – Enjoy a cup of coffee or tea at one of Grapevine's many local Main Street cafés.
- ▶ **GRAPEVINE OBSERVATION TOWER** – Take in the 360-degree view of the surrounding Grapevine area, including the skylines of both Dallas and Fort Worth, DFW Airport and beautiful Lake Grapevine, from 45-meters up.

Explore the western shops, saloons and museums and don't miss the live cattle drive! \*Grapevine Vintage Railroad operates most weekends. \*\*TEXRail offers transportation daily, also from Grapevine.
- ▶ **TEXAS STAR DINNER THEATER** – Enjoy a comical, western, "who-dunnit" murder mystery and dinner show in the Historic Main Street District. \*Friday & Saturday evenings only.
