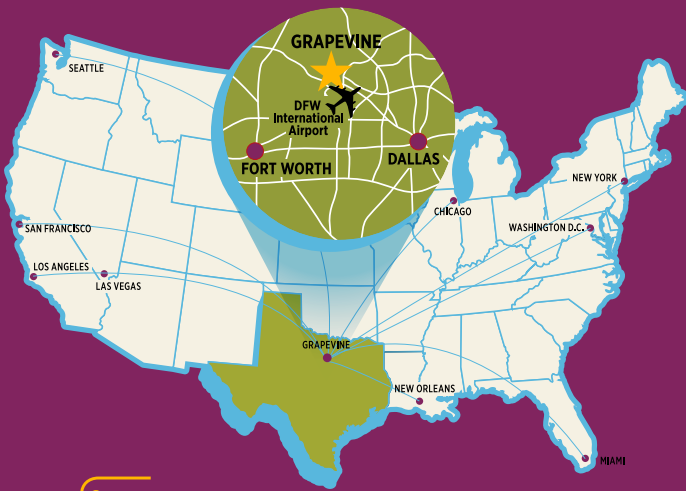

SAMPLE ITINERARY

Day 1

Meet Grapevine Tour Guide at Grapevine Convention & Visitors Bureau, 636 S. Main Street, for Step-On Guided Tour of **Historic Main Street District**.

Take in the magnificent 360-degree view of the Dallas Fort Worth Metroplex area with the **Grapevine Observation Tower Tour** at Grapevine Main Station.

Enjoy lunch at **Harvest Hall**, a European-style food hall designed after the grand train stations of the 19th century.

Depart Harvest Hall for **Gaylord Texan Resort**. Explore this resort on your own, where you'll find highlights from across Texas all under a glass atrium.

Check into your Grapevine hotel and take time to refresh before your evening dinner.

Day 2

Explore the **Settlement to City Museums** as it traces the history of Grapevine from the earliest settlers to current day. Groups can also print their own postcard on a 19th century printing press for an additional \$5.

Experience an old-fashioned social or interactive craft program at **Historic Nash Farm**, the oldest operating Farmstead in Tarrant County.

Enjoy lunch and shopping in the Historic Main Street District, with more than 80 local shops, bistros and cafés, galleries, winery tasting rooms and much more.

Sip and savor fine Texas wines at one of **Grapevine's Winery Tasting Rooms**.

Return to host hotel to relax and refresh.

This evening, enjoy dinner with an entertaining, comical "whodunit" show at the **Texas Star Dinner Theater** or take a nighttime excursion on Historic Main Street with the **Grapevine Ghost Tour** (*dinner not included with tour*).

Day 3

Take in the natural beauty and tranquil surroundings of nature at **Grapevine Botanical Gardens**.

Dine in Grapevine's original filling station at **Willhoite's Restaurant**, complete with the original gas pump and a Model T Ford hanging over the Texas-sized buffet.

Board **Grapevine Vintage Railroad** at the Historic Cotton Belt Depot for the Historic Stockyards. If time allows, pop into **Vetro Glassblowing Studio & Gallery** or **Holder Dane Gallery**.

Explore the Historic Stockyards with shopping, dining and western heritage attractions including a live cattle drive as the Fort Worth Herd makes its way through the Historic Stockyards.

Savor the local flavor at any number of Grapevine's group-friendly restaurants followed by a wide selection of live entertainment up and down Main Street.

Day 4

Enjoy lunch and shopping at **Grapevine Mills**, the largest outlet mall in North Texas and a top 10 mall in America according to USA Today readers, with more than 180 shops, restaurants and attractions. Looking for more than just shopping? Schedule a tour of SEA LIFE Grapevine Aquarium or Meow Wolf Grapevine - The Real Unreal, both located at Grapevine Mills, with Bass Pro Shops located nearby.

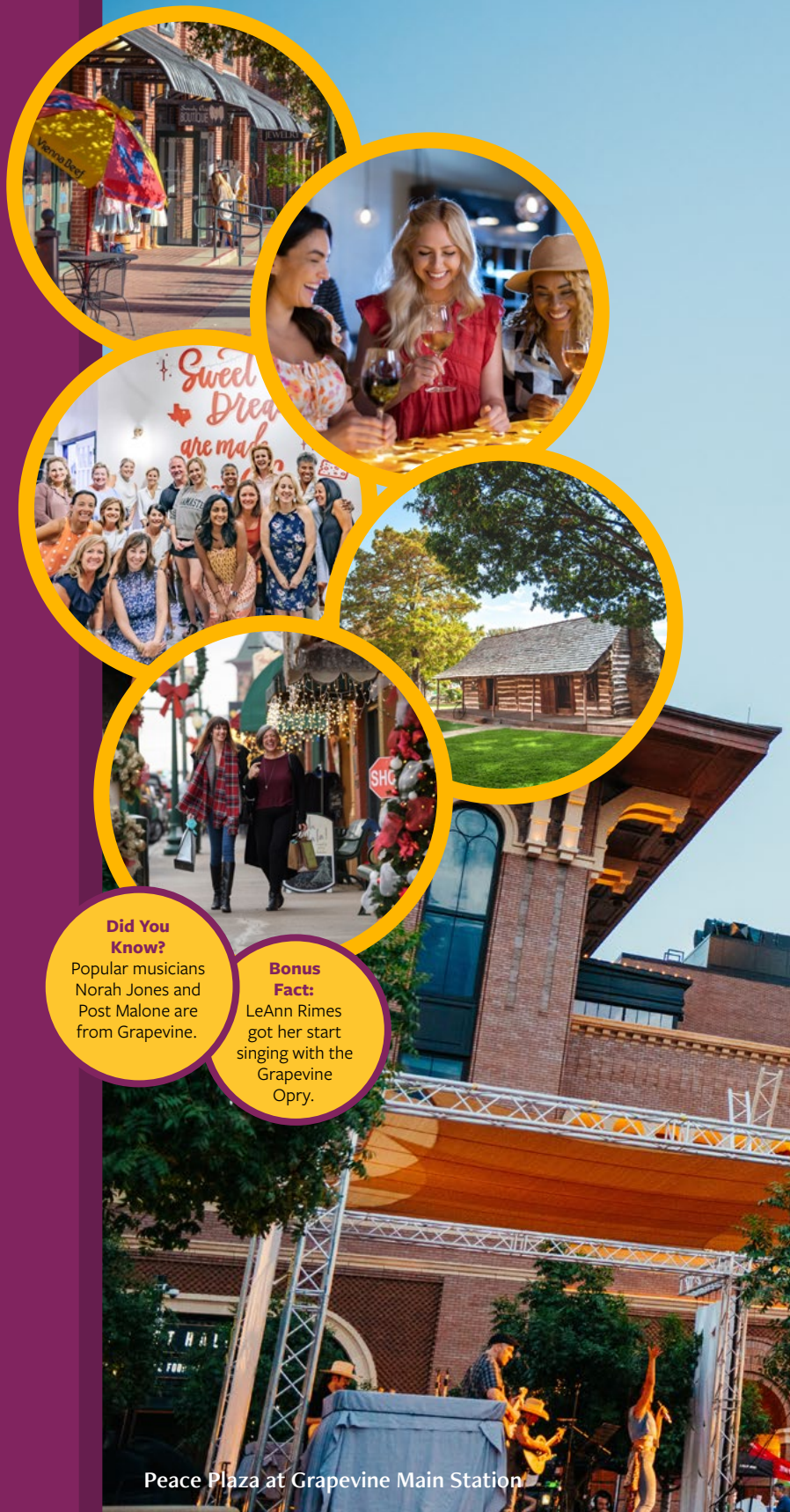
